RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude their final homestand of the season against the Red Sox (2-1) and Blue Jays (2-0, 1 to play) today at Tropicana Field...have won four of five and six of their last nine games...have not won or lost more than three consecutive games since being swept by Baltimore from June 7-10, going 46-43 since that series...are 23-26 since the July 30 trade deadline and 29-30 since the All-Star break...hold sole possession of third place in the AL East for the first time since entering play on May 21 (25-24)—spent 94 consecutive days in fourth from June 20 (entering play) through Sept. 20...with seven games remaining, they are 4.5 games behind the Twins for the ALs third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...need to win at least four of their final seven games to finish at .500+.

★ The Rays have won three straight games for the first time since Aug. 16-18 vs. AZ...today, they seek their first four-game winning streak since May 15-18 (4G) and first at home since April 24-May 7 (6G)...they are attempting to win each of their final four home games in a season for the fourth time (2021, 2017, 2013, 2011).

★ Tampa Bay pitching saw a season-high streak of 23 consecutive scoreless innings come to an end in the 5th inning last night, tied for the ninth-longest run in club history and its longest since a franchise-record 32-inning streak from April 8-11, 2023. Tampa Bay's 3.13 ERA since the All-Star break leads the majors...the Rays are attempting to post the majors' best second-half ERA for the first time since 2012 (2.60)...the club has yielded only 5 ER across its last 43.0 innings (1.05 ERA).

★ The Rays (32) are one of seven teams in MLB history to hold a .500 record at least 32 times (excl. 0-0), including the first since the 2011 Blue Jays (33), but they have not been at the mark since holding a 65-65 record entering play on Aug. 26.

★ Tampa Bay is seeking its first sweep over Toronto since May 21-24, 2021 at Rogers Centre...its last home sweep over the Jays came from Sept. 5-7, 2019...it would mark the Rays fourth sweep overall this season (last: Aug. 16-18 vs. AZ) and their first over an AL opponent since Sept. 26-27, 2023 at BOS.

★ **Shane Baz has completed 5.0+ IP while yielding three hits or fewer in a franchise-record five consecutive starts...**it is tied for the longest streak in MLB this season (4x)...the last longer streak belongs to SD **Blake Snell** (6GS, May 31-June 28, 2023).

ARANDA WORLD—Jonathan Aranda has homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his career...he has 4 HR in his last 10 games, going 11-for-32 (.344) with 5 XBH, 6 RBI, 3 BB, 3 SO and a 1.139 OPS...the 4 HR match his total from his previous 79 games (Sept. 14, 2022-Sept. 10, 2024)...five of his 9 HR in his career have come against Toronto.

PITCHING IN—The Rays have permitted two runs or fewer in a season-high-tying four straight games (also Sept. 6-9)...their last longer streak came from June 3 (G2)-8, 2023 (6G)...Tampa Bay has yielded three runs or fewer in a season-high six straight contests and 13 of its last 15 since Sept. 6, ranking fourth in the majors with a 2.29 ERA (129.2IP, 33ER) in that span...excluding games on Sept. 10 at PHI (8) and Sept. 14 at CLE (6) in which they yielded a combined 14 ER, the Rays have turned in a 1.50 ERA (113.2IP, 19ER) in the other 13 games...they have allowed three runs or fewer 35 times since the All-Star break, tied for most in the (AL) and tied for third in the majors behind the Mets (38) and Braves (36).

★ Tampa Bay's rotation has permitted two runs or fewer in a season-high 10 straight and 14 of their last 15 starts, their longest streak since Aug. 13-26, 2022 (14G)...the rotation leads the AL with a 1.84 ERA (49.0IP, 10ER) during the current run.

★ Rays starters own a 1.30 ERA (41.2IP, 6ER) and 0.55 WHIP in their last eight games, holding opponents to a .145/.195/.228 (21-for-145) line with 48 SO and seven walks.

★ The bullpen's 2.73 ERA (243.2IP, 74ER) since the Midsummer Classic ranks second in the majors behind the Guardians (2.58).

UNTOUCHABLE—Kevin Kelly (22.0IP) and Zack Littell (20.0IP) own two of the four longest active scoreless inning streaks in the majors...according to STATS LLC, it marks the third time in franchise history two Rays have had concurrent scoreless streaks of 20.0+ innings...the last instance involved **Pete Fairbanks** (29.2) and **Yonny Chirinos** (21.2) on April 29, 2023, when Chirinos extended his streak beyond the 20-inning mark, but saw it snapped in the same game vs. the White Sox...the other occurrence came on Aug. 7, 2012, when **Fernando Rodney** (22.0) and **J.P. Howell** (20.0) had active streaks.

★ Kelly has not permitted an earned run in 23 straight outings, the longest active streak in the majors and tied with **Fernando Rodney** (2012) for the third-longest streak in club history behind **Pete Fairbanks** (30, 2022-23) and **J.P. Howell** (24, 2012).

LOCK IT DOWN—The Rays have won 32 consecutive games when holding a lead through six innings, the third-longest streak in club history behind runs of 36 (April 14-July 12, 2019) and 33 games (Aug. 1, 2010-April 20, 2011), according to STATS LLC...they are 52-4 when leading through six frames, tying the Yankees for the second-fewest such losses in MLB behind the Guardians (2)...the Rays also own the majors' second-highest winning pct. when leading through seven innings (58-2/.967) behind the Guardians (75-2/.974).

★ **Drew Rasmussen** became the 13th Ray to record a save yesterday, surpassing the Brewers and Dodgers (both 12) for the most in the majors...it marks the second-highest total in franchise history behind 2021 (14)...since saves became an official statistic in 1969, the Rays are the only major league club to have at least 13 different players tally at least one save in a season, accomplishing the feat twice.

★ Since **Pete Fairbanks** was placed on the 15-day IL (right lat strain) on Aug. 19, the Rays have converted 11 straight save opportunities, with six players earning saves in that span, led by **Garrett Cleavinger** and **Edwin Uceta** (both 3).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays are an MLB-best 52-32 (.619) in games decided by two runs or fewer...their 84 such games lead MLB and are tied for fourth most in a season in club history...their 28-20 (.583) mark in one-run games ranks fourth in MLB, while the 28 wins are tied for the most (DET/STL)...of the Rays 20 games in September, 14 have been decided by two runs or fewer...seven of 10 home games have been one-run games.

★ The Rays have recorded back-to-back one-run wins for the first time since June 19-20...a third straight one-run win today would tie the longest streak in franchise history (14x, last: Sept. 18-21, 2019).

RACE TO THE FINISH—The Rays need to go at least 4-3 over their final seven games to finish with a .500+ record for a seventh consecutive season...they were last under the mark in 2017 (80-82)...it would surpass 2008-2013 (6) for the longest streak in franchise history...the Rays are one of four teams to post a .500+ record each season from 2018-23, joining the Braves, Dodgers and Yankees...yesterday's 3-2 win ensured the Rays eighth consecutive winning season at home...their last losing record at Tropicana Field came in 2016 (36-45)...the Rays, Brewers, Dodgers and Yankees are the only clubs to finish above .500 at home in each of the last seven seasons from 2017-23.

★ Since becoming the Rays in 2008, the club has finished with a winning record in 12 of 16 seasons, second most in MLB behind the Yankees (16) and Dodgers (15).

RAYS AND JAYS—The Rays and Blue Jays wrap up a 13-game season series this afternoon...the Rays have secured a club-record seventh straight season series win over the Jays dating back to 2018, surpassing 2008-13 (6)...their .613 (68-43) mark in that timeframe is the best by any AL club over Toronto...the Rays are 10-4 in their last 14 and 15-8 in their previous 23 games against the Jays...winners of three straight matchups for the first time since Sept. 15-23, 2022, the Rays are seeking a fourth consecutive win over the Blue Jays for the first time since a four-game sweep from May 21-24, 2021.

★ Tampa Bay has homered in 11 of 12 games vs. Toronto this season and 23 of 25 meetings since the start of 2023...the club has homered in nine straight home games vs. the Jays, the second-longest streak in franchise history (12G, 2015-16).

- ★ RHP **Shane Baz** made his MLB debut against Toronto on Sept. 20, 2021 at Tropicana Field.
- ★ Rays Manager **Kevin Cash** began his MLB playing career with the Blue Jays from 2002-04...he was also a major league advance scout for Toronto in 2012.
- ★ Blue Jays VP, Baseball Strategy **James Click** spent 14 seasons with the Rays from 2005-19, including three as VP, baseball operations.
- ★ Rays Hitting Coach **Chad Mottola** held the same position with Toronto in 2013 after five seasons as a Blue Jays minor league coach...during his playing career, he was signed by the Jays three times and was a teammate of **Kevin Cash** with Triple-A Syracuse in 2002.
- ★ Bally Sports Sun announcer **Brian Anderson** made his MLB debut at Rogers Centre (then SkyDome) on Sept. 10, 1993 in relief for the Angels...the first batter he faced was Hall of Famer **Paul Molitor**.
- ★ **Richie Palacios'** brother, **Joshua**, was drafted by Toronto in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his debut with the Blue Jays in 2021 at Rogers Centre.
- ★ Blue Jays OF **Kevin Kiermaier** spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth club history.
- ★ Toronto LHP **Ryan Yarbrough** pitched for the Rays from 2018-22...he was acquired from the Dodgers in exchange for **Kiermaier** at the trade deadline.
- ★ Blue Jays LHP **Génesis Cabrera** spent nearly five seasons in the Rays system before being dealt to the Cardinals in 2018.
- ★ Toronto INF **Bo Bichette** (Orlando) and RHP **Bowden Francis** (Tallahassee) hail from the Sunshine State...the latter was a teammate of **José Caballero** at Chipola College (2016-17), located in Florida's panhandle...the duo won an NJCAA National Championship in 2017.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will take the ball for his 13th start of the campaign and sixth at Tropicana Field...has recorded a 2.03 ERA (31.0IP, 7ER) in his last five starts...min. 50.0 IP, his 2.84 ERA (57.0IP, 18ER) since the All-Star break ranks 11th in the AL...missed the 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022...has a 3.51 ERA (107.2IP, 42ER) in 20 career MLB starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned the win on Sept. 17 vs. Boston after tossing 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits and one walk with six strikeouts...his lone damage allowed was a two-run homer by **Triston Casas** in the 2nd inning...became the second Ray this season to throw 7.0+ innings while allowing two hits or fewer, joining **Taj Bradley** on July 20 at New York-AL (7.0IP, 1H, 0R, 2BB, 5SO)...Baz became the first Ray to do so against the Red Sox since **Yonny Chirinos** on June 7, 2019 (8.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 6SO).

CLIPPED WINGS—Is set to make his third career start opposite Toronto...last faced the Blue Jays on July 3, 2022 at Rogers Centre (W, 6.0IP, 7H, 1ER, 2BB, 7SO)...made his MLB debut on Sept. 20, 2021 vs. Toronto at Tropicana Field (W, 5.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 0BB, 5SO).
 ✨ In nine career starts vs. the AL East, Baz is 3-1 with a 2.20 ERA (45.0IP, 11ER).

THE WIZARD OF BAZ—Baz has completed 5.0+ IP while yielding three hits or fewer in a franchise-record five consecutive starts, surpassing four-start stretches from **Shane McClanahan** (July 2 [G1]-26, 2022) and **Blake Snell** (Sept. 12-29, 2018)...he is one of four MLB pitchers to accomplish the feat this season, joining **TOR Bowden Francis** (Aug. 7-29), **CIN Hunter Greene** (July 6-Aug. 3) and **CWS Drew Thorpe** (June 22-July 21)...the pitcher in MLB to do so in six straight starts was **Snell** (6GS, May 31-June 28, 2023) after joining the Padres.

✨ Baz has limited opponents to a .119/.204/.238 (12-for-101) clip since the streak began on Aug. 20 at OAK...opposing hitters are 3-for-39 (.077) against his four-seam fastball during the streak.
 ✨ On the season, he has yielded three runs or fewer in 11 of 12 starts, including eight with two runs or fewer.

TROP TALK—Baz is 4-1 with a 2.86 ERA (50.1IP, 16ER), 0.89 WHIP and .172 (31-for-180) opp. average in nine career home starts, permitting three runs or fewer in each of them...it marks the third-lowest ERA through a pitcher's first nine career home starts in club history (excl. openers), trailing **Drew Rasmussen** (1.77, 2021-22) and **Jeremy Hellickson** (2.76, 2010-11)...Rasmussen (2.09) holds the lowest mark through 10 career starts.

NO RISP, NO REWARD—Opponents are just 1-for-8 (.125) against Baz with runners in scoring position over his last five starts, with the lone hit coming on Aug. 13 vs. HOU (**Yainer Diaz** RBI-single)...nine of the 11 runs against him in that span have come on home runs by **BOS Triston Casas** (2-run), **HOU Alex Bregman** (solo), **HOU Jeremy Peña** (solo), **SD Jake Cronenworth** (2-run), **BAL Gunnar Henderson** (solo) and **PHI Nick Castellanos** (2-run).

✨ During the six-start run (since Aug. 13), opposing hitters are 5-for-40 (.125) with runners on base and 14-for-88 (.159) with the bases empty...they have hit .261 (6-for-23) vs. his slider compared to a combined 13-for-105 (.124) in at-bats ending with his four-seamer (7-for-52), curveball (6-for-39) and changeup (0-for-14).

LEFT BEHIND—In his last six starts since Aug. 13, Baz has limited left-handed hitters to a 5-for-62 (.081) clip, but three of the hits were homers...min. 60 AB, it marks the lowest opp. average vs. LHH in the majors over that span, ahead of **SD Joe Musgrove** (.117)...southpaws are 1-for-25 (.040) against his fastball, 0-for-12 off his changeup and 2-for-19 (.105) off his curveball in that span.

KEEPING COUNT—Baz is holding opponents to a .135 (13-for-96) clip when ahead in the count compared to .328 (19-for-58) when behind...opponents are 15-for-128 (.117) against him in two-strike counts, fourth lowest among AL starters (min. 10GS) behind **TOR Bowden Francis** (.108), **DET Tarik Skubal** (.113) and **NYY Luis Gil** (.113).

✨ He has limited opponents to a combined .069 (4-for-58) average against his curveball (4-for-46) and changeup (0-for-12) in two-strike counts.

LIKE FINE WINE—He has posted a .227 (22-for-97) opp. average the first time through the lineup and .213 (20-for-94) the second time...however, the third time through and beyond, opponents are 8-for-53 (.151) against him...of the 25 runs against him, 18 (72.0%) have come in the first three innings...he has a 4.50 ERA (36.0IP, 18ER) in innings 1-3 compared to a 1.72 ERA (31.1IP, 6ER) from the 4th frame on.
