THE TWINS: Began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive losses to the Dodgers on Monday and Tuesday night...tonight, they will play the three-game series finale against Los Angeles...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then host the Rockies for three games over the weekend.
☞ Twins have won six of their last nine and eight of their last 13.

GAME UNRAVELS LATE ON TWINS: The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night at Target Field by a score of 12-3, snapping their run of series wins at three...Kendry Rojas was the starter, allowing one run on one hit in 2.0 innings pitched...Austin Voth pitched 4.0 innings in relief of Rojas and was dealt the loss...the offense recorded seven hits and struck out just five times...they recorded three extra-base hits, a double from Byron Buxton (14) and home runs from Brooks Lee (13) and Victor Caratini (6).

TWINS-DODGERS: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 31st time in their history today...the Twins are 9-21 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 3-11 all-time at Dodger Stadium (3-14 counting the 0-3 record during the 1965 World Series), 3-10 at Target Field and 3-0 at the Metrodome.

☞ The Twins' .300 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20).

☞ Byron Buxton has reached base safely in 12-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .358 on-base percentage, a .612 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS.

☞ Josh Bell has reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games against the Dodgers (dating back to August of 2023), hitting .313 (20-for-64) with a .778 OPS in that span.

☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in all five career games against the Dodgers...in those games, he has gone 8-for-18 with two doubles, one home run, two walks and four RBI.

FRESH PRINCE OF BAXLEY, GA: Updated voting for the MLB All-Stars were released on Monday and Byron Buxton ranked third among AL outfielders with 1,106,264 votes, trailing Aaron Judge (1,788,499) and Mike Trout (1,735,051)...phase one voting ends at 11 am (CT) tomorrow and the top six outfielders will be revealed on MLB Network at 5 pm (CT) on Thursday; that group will then advance to the second phase of voting...below are Byron Buxton's rankings among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY...he ranks tied for second among that same group in RBI (41) with Jo Adell, trailing Bellinger (49).

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk and right-handed pitcher Marco Raya from Triple-A St. Paul.

☞ Funderburk, who will be making his third stint with the Twins this season, appeared in six games for the Saints during his most recent stint there, pitching 7.0 innings, while allowing five runs (4 earned) on 10 hits with one walk and six strikeouts.

☞ Raya has appeared in six games for the Saints this month, throwing 8.0 scoreless innings of relief, with four hits allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts...the 23-year-old right-hander has appeared in 25 games (1 start) for St. Paul this season, going 4-4, 5.54 ERA (39.0 IP, 24 ER), two saves, 12 walks and 39 strikeouts...the Laredo, Texas native was selected by Minnesota in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of United South High School in Laredo, Texas and is ranked as the club's 16th-best prospect, per MLB.com.

☞ To make room for Funderburk and Raya on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas to St. Paul and designated right-handed pitcher Austin Voth for release or assignment.

MAKING CONNECTIONS: Twins have struck out just 136 times this month, the second-fewest in baseball, trailing Arizona (135)...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279).

☞ Notable individuals this month (minimum of 70 plate appearances): Brooks Lee (8.0%) ranks first in the AL, Luke Keaschall (14.3%) ranks 10th and Kody Clemens (16.5%) ranks 17th.

☞ On the season, Keaschall (15.3%) ranks eighth in the AL and Lee (15.4%) ranks ninth.

UNITY IS STRENGTH: Through 21 games this month, the Twins are slugging .481, which ranks third-best in baseball, trailing Colorado (.489) and Detroit (.487)...on the season, they rank ninth in baseball (.409)...they slugged .381 in March/April and .389 in May.

☞ Twins have homered in all but two of their last 18 games since June 4, hitting 35 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (40).

JOSHIN' AROUND: Josh Bell has reached safely in nine-straight games...over his last 22 games, he is hitting .342 (26-for-76) with five doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, a .398 on-base percentage, a .566 slugging percentage and a .963 OPS.

☞ Since June 14, he has reached base safely in 18 of 37 plate appearances (.486 OBP).

☞ He leads the club with 49 RBI...17 of those RBI have come in his last 17 games...one RBI and he will reach the 50-RBI mark for the ninth time in his career.

TREVOR LARNACH, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Over his last seven games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .481 (13-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, a .500 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and 1.278 OPS.

☞ In 17 games this month, he is hitting .352 (19-for-54) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, five walks and a .954 OPS...his batting average ranks tied for fifth-best in baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances this month.

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fourth time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati in three games at Target Field, April 24-26 in three games at Tampa Bay and May 29-31 at Pittsburgh in three games.

☞ Twins are looking to avoid being swept by the Dodgers for the first time since August 9-10, 2022 in two games at Dodger Stadium.

☞ Twins have entered a finale five times this season attempting to avoid the sweep and have gone 2-3 in such instances...their two times avoiding the sweep were April 2 at Kansas City and May 17 vs. Milwaukee.

BRING 'EM OUT: Twins have drawn 65,361 through two games against the Dodgers this week (32,680 avg)...their high for a series in 2026 was 82,799 for the three-game series vs. Milwaukee, from May 15-17.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1964, the Twins signed an 18-year-old from Gatun, Panama, future MLB Hall of Famer Rod Carew.

- Will be his second career start against Los Angeles-NL; took the loss on August 9, 2022, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts at Dodger Stadium.
- In his last start on June 18 at Texas, Ryan earned the win, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts, helping the Twins defeat the Rangers 9-3 at Globe Life Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his 16th start of the season on June 18 at Texas opposite right-hander Jack Leiter...earned his fifth win of the season, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts in a 9-3 Twins victory at Globe Life Field.

- The start was his second true scoreless start this season (excluding his start on May 3 vs. Toronto in which he was removed from the game with right elbow soreness after throwing just nine pitches), with the other coming on March 26 in his Opening Day start at Baltimore (5.1 IP, 0 runs).
- Lowered his season ERA to 2.99, becoming the first Twins starter to own a sub-3.00 ERA through his first 16 starts in back-to-back seasons (2.60 ERA in 2025) since Johan Santana did so through his first 16 starts in 2006 (2.75 ERA) and 2007 (2.83 ERA).
- Has avoided the loss in nine straight starts since April 28 vs. Seattle (3 wins, 6 no-decisions), one shy of his career-high streak of 10 games without a loss from September 13, 2022-May 2, 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his 15th start of the season on June 12 vs. St. Louis opposite right-hander Kyle Leahy...made his team-leading ninth quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits – including a solo home run by Alec Burleson – with no walks and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched, as the Twins erased four different deficits to defeat the Cardinals 9-8 at Target Field.

- Allowed a home run in four consecutive starts dating back to May 26 at Chicago-AL, his longest such streak since doing so in four straight from September 6-26, 2025.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': This will mark Ryan's second career start against Los Angeles-NL and first since 2022...took the loss on August 9, 2022, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits – including a solo homer from Max Muncy – with one walk and four strikeouts in a 10-3 Twins loss at Dodger Stadium.

- Ryan, a San Francisco native, has made 15 career starts against teams from his home state of California; is 8-4 with a 4.97 ERA (83.1 IP, 46 ER), 25 walks and 101 strikeouts in those outings.
- Current Dodgers hitters (including Injured List) are hitting .282 (11-for-39) with one double (Will Smith), three home runs (Kiké Hernández, Kyle Tucker, Max Muncy), five walks and nine strikeouts in their career against Ryan.

NATIONAL NEWS: Ryan is set to make his 37th start vs. a National League opponent, the most Interleague starts in Twins history since the beginning of Interleague Play in 1997...below are some more of his numbers against the National League, compared to other pitchers in Twins history since 1997:

- Joe is looking for his first win against a National League opponent since August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego...in five Interleague starts since, Ryan is 0-2 with a 3.21 ERA (28.0 IP, 10 ER), four walks and 35 strikeouts; the Twins are 1-4 in those contests.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 63 career road starts, Ryan is 22-20 with a 3.84 ERA (349.1 IP, 149 ER), 79 walks and 370 strikeouts, compared to 29-19 with a 3.56 ERA (379.1 IP, 150 ER), 87 walks and 448 strikeouts in 68 home appearances (67 starts).

- In nine starts at Target Field this season, Ryan is 3-2 with a 2.85 ERA (47.1 IP, 15 ER), eight walks, 58 strikeouts, a 1.01 WHIP and a .220 (40-for-182) BAA.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .203/.254/.354 (39-for-192) with eight doubles, seven home runs, eight walks and 57 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .222/.272/.304 (30-for-135) with eight doubles, one home run, 10 walks and 42 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .214/.273/.382 (292-for-1,363) with 91 walks and 350 strikeouts (3.85 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.274/.411 (311-for-1,371) with 75 walks and 468 strikeouts (6.24 K/BB).

- Ryan's 6.24 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- Opponents are hitting .094 (3-for-32) against Joe's split finger, which ranks as the second lowest opponent batting average against the split finger in Major League Baseball, only behind San Diego's Jeremiah Estrada, whose split finger has generated a .087 BAA (min. 100 pitches).

- Joe has an overall pitching run value of 16, which falls within the league's 98th percentile, and is tied for the fourth highest in the American League.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP TAJ BRADLEY (2026: 6-3, 4.11 ERA // CAREER: 25-30, 4.73 ERA)

Right-hander Taj Bradley is slated to make his 15th start of the season in Friday's series opener against the Colorado Rockies...in his last start on June 20 at Arizona, Taj earned his team-leading sixth win of the season, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in a 16-8 Twins win at Chase Field...Taj is looking for his first win at Target Field since April 7 vs. Detroit; is 0-1 with a 4.44 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in four home starts since...in his lone start vs. Colorado on March 30, 2025, earned the win in a quality start effort, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts.
