**THE TWINS:** Completed their "first half" with a season-long nine-game homestand, going 6-3 (2-1 vs. Tampa Bay, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL and 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh...tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game roadtrip with the first of three games at Coors Field in Denver over the weekend...after this series, the Twins will travel to Los Angeles to play the Dodgers, from Monday-Wednesday.  
✦ Twins have gone 19-29 on the road this season...they went 2-4 on their last roadtrip, from June 27-July 3, going 1-2 in Detroit and 1-2 in Miami...they are seeking their first road series win since taking three of four in Sacramento against the A's, from June 2-5.

**STAR STUDDED EVENTS:** Byron Buxton (2nd) and Joe Ryan (1st) both attended All-Star Week in Atlanta...Buck played in the 2022 ASG at Dodger Stadium.  
✦ Byron Buxton participated in his first Home Run Derby on Monday, hitting 20 home runs in the first round, his longest on the entire night being 466 feet...he hit seven home runs in the final minute, then four more before even making an out in the bonus round...he advanced to the final four where he lost with seven home runs to Junior Caminero's eight...third base/outfield coach Tommy Watkins was his pitcher.  
✦ Buxton entered the game on Tuesday night in the fifth inning to play centerfield...he lined out to leftfield in the seventh inning while facing Randy Rodriguez, and doubled and scored in the ninth inning off Robert Suarez, which started the two-run rally to tie the game for the AL.  
✦ Ryan pitched the fourth inning, retiring all three batters he faced, striking out Manny Machado, inducing a popout to Will Smith and striking out Kyle Tucker, throwing 10 pitches in the outing...Ryan topped out at 97 mph.

**TWINS AND ROX ON THE RECORD:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 14-10 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-4 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 7-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).  
✦ The last series between these two came June 10-12, 2024 at Target Field as the Twins won two of three, outscoring the Rockies 26-14.  
✦ The last series at Coors for the Twins came September 29-October 1, 2023, as the Twins took two of three to close the regular season...Twins homered seven times in that series.  
✦ The Twins' 24 games against the Rockies are tied with Washington for their fewest among any MLB opponent.  
✦ The Twins have hit 22 home runs against the Rockies, tied for their second-fewest among any opponents with Atlanta and trailing their total against Los Angeles-NL (20).  
✦ Dating back to June of 2022, the Twins have gone 6-2 against Colorado in their last eight.  
✦ In eight career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with one double, two triples, two home runs, six RBI, four walks and a 1.203 OPS.

**COORREA, SMOOTH SILVER BULLET:** Carlos Correa has played in 22 career games against the Rockies, hitting .412 (35-for-85) with eight doubles, three home runs, 20 RBI, a .612 slugging percentage and a 1.069 OPS...he has hit safely in 16-straight games against the Rockies with an at-bat, dating back to August 15, 2018.  
✦ He set a single-game career-high with five hits the last time these two played on June 12, 2024 at Target Field — all singles.  
✦ He has hit safely in all six career games at Coors Field, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.159 OPS here.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Twins have gone 13-17 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10) and 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13).

**CREATE-A-PLAYER:** Byron Buxton has 21 home runs, 17 stolen bases and has not been caught stealing...he's the first player in baseball history to have at least 20 homers and 15 steals without a caught stealing at the All-Star break.  
✦ Over his last 29 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .343 (37-for-108) with eight doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 18 RBI, 27 runs scored, 10 walks, a .408 on-base percentage, a .741 slugging percentage and a 1.149 OPS.  
✦ Three more steals and Buck will become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hisle (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

**THIS AND THAT:**  
✦ Harrison Bader is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.218 OPS in his last eight games.  
✦ Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (26-for-78) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and an .827 OPS in his last 21 games.  
✦ Twins starters have allowed two runs in 11.2 innings pitched in their last three games.  
✦ Happy belated to Twins reliever Cole Sands, who celebrated his 28th birthday yesterday.

**HAPII BIRTHDAY:** Happy birthday to Twins Hall of Famer Torii Hunter, who turns 50 today...Hunter played on his birthday 12 times over the course of his 19-year career, hitting .262 (11-for-42) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI and five walks in those games.

⌘ His nine homers allowed to lefties this season are the second most in his career, his high being 12 which he allowed in 2019.

Ⓓ In his last outing on July 10 vs. Chicago-NL, seven of the 11 hits (63.6%) Paddock allowed came on four-seamers, including four singles, two doubles and a home run...prior to the start, 42 of the 92 hits (45.6%) Paddock had allowed this season came off of his four-seam fastball.

- 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unbridled major league season since his rookie year in 2019.
- Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.
- Pitched a career-high 8.0 inning game on May 19, 2024 at Cleveland...previous high of 7.2 innings, May 6, 2019 and July 17, 2019 with San Diego.
- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through the 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
- In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
- As a rookie in 2019, posted career bests in wins (9), ERA (3.33), innings (140.2) and strikeouts (153)...named to *Baseball America's* Major League All-Rookie Team.
- Made major league debut March 31, 2019 vs. San Francisco, yielding one run on two hits and striking out seven in 5.0-inning no-decision.
- Entering 2019, was ranked Padres' No. 4 prospect by ESPN.com, No. 5 by MLB Pipeline and No. 6 by *Baseball America*.
- Missed entire 2017 season rehabbing from first Tommy John surgery in August of 2016.
- Acquired by San Diego from Miami in June 30, 2016 trade that sent Fernando Rodney to Marlins.
- Made professional debut with Marlins in Gulf Coast League in 2015, going 4-3 with a 2.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 11 ER) in 11 games (seven starts), walking seven and striking out 39.
- Selected by Miami in eighth round of 2015 First-Year Player Draft.
