THE TWINS: Completed their "first half" with a season-long nine-game homestand, going 6-3 (2-1 vs. Tampa Bay, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL and 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh...tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game roadtrip with the first of three games at Coors Field in Denver over the weekend...after this series, the Twins will travel to Los Angeles to play the Dodgers, from Monday-Wednesday.

◆ Twins have gone 19-29 on the road this season...they went 2-4 on their last roadtrip, from June 27-July 3, going 1-2 in Detroit and 1-2 in Miami...they are seeking their first road series win since taking three of four in Sacramento against the A's, from June 2-5.

STAR STUDDED EVENTS: Byron Buxton (2nd) and Joe Ryan (1st) both attended All-Star Week in Atlanta...Buck played in the 2022 ASG at Dodger Stadium.

♣ Byron Buxton participated in his first Home Run Derby on Monday, hitting 20 home runs in the first round, his longest on the entire night being 466 feet...he hit seven home runs in the final minute, then four more before even making an out in the bonus round...he advanced to the final four where he lost with seven home runs to Junior Caminero's eight... third base/outfield coach Tommy Watkins was his pitcher.

♣ Buxton entered the game on Tuesday night in the fifth inning to play centerfield...he lined out to leftfield in the seventh inning while facing Randy Rodriguez, and doubled and scored in the ninth inning off Robert Suarez, which started the two-run rally to tie the game for the AL.

♣ Ryan pitched the fourth inning, retiring all three batters he faced, striking out Manny Machado, inducing a popout to Will Smith and striking out Kyle Tucker, throwing 10 pitches in the outing...Ryan topped out at 97 mph.

TWINS AND ROX ON THE RECORD: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 14-10 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-4 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 7-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).

♣ The last series between these two came June 10-12, 2024 at Target Field as the Twins won two of three, outscoring the Rockies 26-14.

♣ The last series at Coors for the Twins came September 29-October 1, 2023, as the Twins took two of three to close the regular season... Iwins homered seven times in that series.

♣ The Twins '24 games against the Rockies are tied with Washington for their fewest among any MLB opponent.

♣ The Twins have hit 22 home runs against the Rockies, tied for their second-fewest among any opponents with Atlanta and trailing their total against Los Angeles-NL (20).

♣ Dating back to June of 2022, the Twins have gone 6-2 against Colorado in their last eight.

♣ In eight career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting 346 (9-for-26) with one double, two triples, two home runs, six RBI, four walks and a 1.203 OPS.

COORREA, SMOOTH SILVER BULLET: Carlos Correa has played in 22 career games against the Rockies, hitting .412 (35-for-85) with eight doubles, three home runs, 20 RBI, a .612 slugging percentage and a 1.069 OPS...he has hit safely in 16-straight games against the Rockies with an at-bat, dating back to August 15, 2018.

◆ He set a single-game career-play with five hits the last time these two played on June 12, 2024 at Target Field — all singles.

◆ He has hit safely in all six career games at Coors Field, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.159 OPS here.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 13-17 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10) and 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13).

CREATE-A-PLAYER: Byron Buxton has 21 home runs, 17 stolen bases and has not been caught stealing...he's the first player in baseball history to have at least 20 homers and 15 steals without a caught stealing at the All-Star break.

♣ Over his last 29 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .343 (37-for-108) with eight doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 18 RBI, 27 runs scored, 10 walks, a .408 on-base percentage, a .741 slugging percentage and a 1.149 OPS.

♣ Three more steals and Buck will become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hisle (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his career-high eighth loss of the year on July 10 vs. the Cubs, opposite former teammate Colin Rea...allowed six runs on 11 hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts over 5.0 innings...first four runs allowed came with two-outs in their respective innings: an RBI single by Nico Hoerner in the second, a two-run home run by Pete Crow-Armstrong in the third and a sacrifice fly by Matt Shaw in the fourth...allowed five-straight one-out base runners in the fifth, including RBI singles by Michael Busch and Dansby Swanson; with two outs, retired Matt Shaw on a popfly to escape the bases-loaded iam.

 ₱ Brought season innings pitched total to 100.0 for the third time in his career and the first time since 2021 (108.1 lP)...career high is 140.2 lP, done in 2019 with San Diego.

 ₱ Has allowed 19 two-out RBI this season, his career-high being 23 done in 2024 and 2021... Bailey Ober leads the team with 20 two-out RBI this season.

 ₱ Crow-Armstrong scored in the fifth inning after reaching on a one-out walk...marked the 12th time this season that a runner has scored after being walked by Paddack (3x on 3/31; 2x on 5/21; 1x on 4/6, 4/12, 4/24, 5/4, 6/13, 6/24).

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his 100th career start on July 4 vs. Tampa Bay at Target Field opposite Zack Littell...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 walk-off win...allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...retired the first 11 batters he faced in order... exited the game with no outs in the sixth after giving up a single to Josh Lowe and an RBI double to Yandy Díaz; Díaz scored on Junior Caminero's RBI single with Danny Coulombe pitching in relief.

This season, relievers have inherited 12 runners from Paddack and have allowed six of them to score (50.0%)...since joining the Twins in 2022, relievers have inherited 27 of his runners and allowed 14 of them to score (51.8%).

- ♣ Did not walk a batter in back-to-back games for the sixth time in his career and the first time since May 19-25, 2024.

FACING THE ROCKIES: In five career appearances against Colorado (3 starts), is 3-0 with a 1.54 ERA (23.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs, two walks and 27 strikeouts...last faced the Rockies on June 10, 2024 at Target Field, earning the win in Minnesota's 5-0 shutout victory; allowed six hits over 6.1 scoreless innings, with no walks and six strikeouts...is facing Colorado for the third time as a Twin.

WELL HELLO, OLD FOE: The former San Diego Padre is facing the National League West for the seventh time (6th start) since becoming a Twin in 2022 and the 32nd time in his career...here are some of his numbers against the NL West with San Diego, Minnesota and overall in his career:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 10 road start this season, is 2-4 with a 5.50 ERA (52.1 IP, 32 ER), 10 home runs, 11 walks and 37 strikeouts, compared to 1-4 with a 4.34 ERA (47.2 IP, 23 ER), four home runs, 14 walks and 33 strikeouts in nine home starts...since 2022, is 5-7 with a 5.48 ERA (106.2 IP, 65 ER), 16 HR, 24 walks and 79 strikeouts in 21 games (20 starts) away from Target Field; Twins are 8-13.
♣ This season, Paddack has a .266 (54-for-203) opponent batting average with a .306 on-base percentage, a .794 OPS and a 3.36 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the road.

♣ Is making his third career appearance (2nd start) at Coors Field...in two career games at Coors (1 start), is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 0 ER), one walk, 12 strikeouts and a .206 (7-for-34) BAA.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, lefties are batting .244 (48-for-197) with nine home runs allowed, 23 RBI, 12 walks and 30 strikeouts, while righties are batting .286 (55-for-192) with five home runs, 30 RBI, 13 walks and 40 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .245/.291/.424 with 42 home runs and a 3.41 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties are slashing .263/.300/.438 with 39 home runs and a 5.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

₱ In his last outing on July 10 vs. Chicago-NL, seven of the 11 hits (63.6%) Paddack allowed

came on four-seamers, including four singles, two doubles and a home run...prior to the start, 42 of the 92 hits (45.6%) Paddack had allowed this season came off of his four-seam fastball.
