Today's Headlines

T.J. Rumfield (NYY) went 3-for-3 with the Mesa Solar Sox on Monday afternoon, recording three doubles and two RBI. Rumfield lifted his AFL batting slash from a .364/.500/.364 to a .500/.579/.714 after four games of action (7-for-14).

Drew Millas (WSH) posted a 3-for-4 showing with the Peoria Javelinas on Monday afternoon, driving in four of his team's 11 runs in a three-run victory over the Mesa Solar Sox. Millas now holds a .462/.462/.1.077 slash this fall (6-for-13) with eight RBI.

Jeferson Quero (MIL) had a 4-for-5 afternoon with the Glendale Desert Dogs on Monday, posting two doubles and two RBI in an 8-3 victory over the Salt River Rafters. Quero now holds a .333/.529/.500 slash in the Fall League, recording four hits in a combined 12 at-bats.

Emmet Sheehan (LAD) pitched three scoreless innings for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Monday, allowing two hits and striking out four. His AFL campaign has begun with six scoreless innings, two hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts in a combined two starts.

Connor Thomas (STL) tossed five scoreless innings for the Salt River Rafters on Monday, striking out five. The left-hander worked around six hits and one walk allowed, lowering his Fall League ERA to 1.04 through two combined starts (8 2/3 IP).

The Surprise Saguaros remain atop the AFL standings and have now won five consecutive games. Surprise retains a league-best run differential (+16) and fewest runs allowed (32), while the second-best run differential belongs to the Glendale Desert Dogs (+9).

In-N-Out Double-Double Batter - Week 1 Update



On Friday afternoon at Camelback Ranch, **Matt McLain (Cincinnati Reds)** became the second successful "In-N-Out Double-Double Batter" in AFL history. Named the Double-Double Batter prior to first pitch, McLain's third-inning double awarded all fans a free In-N-Out Double-Double hamburger card upon exiting the ballpark.

Introduced for the 2022 season, all AFL regular-season games on Tuesdays and Fridays feature the In-N-Out Double-Double Batter promotion. One hitter from each home team's starting lineup is selected prior to first pitch. If they hit a double that day, all spectators receive a complementary coupon card. Double-Double Batters hold a 33.3% double success rate in six games featuring the promotion.

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Roy Halladay (Grand Canyon Rafters, 1998) was the 17th-overall selection in the 1995 MLB Draft out of Arvada West High School (CO). The right-handed pitcher made his MLB debut with the Toronto Blue Jays in 1998, posting a 1.93 ERA in 14 innings before making his way to the Fall League. Halladay pitched a combined 16 years between the Blue Jays and Phillies, collecting two Cy Young Awards and eight All-Star selections. He tossed the 20th perfect game in MLB history on May 29, 2010 and the second-ever postseason no-hitter on October 6, 2010. Halladay was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 2019.
