YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles clinched the season series against the Rangers following yesterday's 9-1 win to open a three-game set in Arlington...The 0's homered four times to tie a season-high (8x, last 6/27 vs. TEX)...Corbin Burnes became the 11th MLB pitcher and sixth in the AL to 10 wins this year after allowing one run on two hits (1 HR) across 6.0 innings; his 16 quality starts are now tied with Seattle's Logan Gilbert for the most in MLB...Anthony Santander recorded his 15th career multi-homer game...Gunnar Henderson notched his first four-hit outing of the year and third of his career, and notched his 10th game this season with at least three hits.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles were selected to the All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, Anthony Santander, and Jordan Westburg...Head Athletic Trainer Brian Ebel also represented the O's on the AL staff...Burnes (4x) and Rutschman (2x) were repeat All-Stars while Henderson, Santander, and Westburg were first-timers...Burnes (P), Henderson (SS), and Rutschman (C) all started for the first time in their

- Baltimore became the first AL team with at least five All-Stars, all of whom were under 30 years old at the time of the game, since New York-AL in 2017 (also 5); the Braves did so with eight such players last year.

  Burnes and Rutschman became the first pair of teammates to form the starting battery 0
- at the All-Star game since 2016, when San Francisco's Johnny Cueto (P) and Buster Posey (C) did so in San Diego, and the first for the AL since 2006, when Detroit's Kenny Rogers (P) and Iván Rodríguez (C) did so in Pittsburgh.

  Santander scored the game-winning run in the fifth inning after recording a single and later scoring on a two-run homer by Boston's Jarren Duran, who earned MVP.

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 59-38 (.608), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB behind the Guardians (.615, 59-37) and Phillies (.639, 62-35)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 160-99 (.618), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 243-178 (.577) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.587, 247-174), Braves (.616, 258-161), and Dodgers (.635, 268-154).

The Birds became the second team in MLB history to be at least 20 games over .500 at the All-Star break despite two five-game losing streaks, per OptaSTATS; the other was the 1979 0's (59-31)

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 153 home runs, 13 more than the second-place Yankees (140) and 23 more than the Dodgers (130), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most

Westburg (15), Colton Cowser (13), Ryan Mountcastle (12), and Ryan O'Hearn (11), Henderson and Santander are the only teammates in MLB this season with at least 25 home runs; this marks the third time an O's team has had multiple players with 25+

25 home runs; this marks the third time an 0's team has had multiple players with 25+homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining **Brady Anderson** (31) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (25) in 1996, and **Boog Powell** (27) and **Frank Robinson** (25) in 1969. The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996). The 0's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson leads MLB with 81 runs scored, the most through the first 97 team games to begin a season in Orioles history...He scored three runs last night for the eighth time this year, three more than any other player...His 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than anyone else...Henderson is on pace to score 135 runs, which would break the 0's record of 132 set by **Roberto Alomar** in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: Since the start of June, Anthony Santander is slashing .280/.322/.640 (45-for-161) with five doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 24 runs, 34 RBI, and 11 walks across 41 games... His 17 homers and 103 total bases are the most in MLB during that span, while his 23 extra-base hits are tied with teammate **Gunnar Henderson** for the most in the AL in that time.

With his first home run last night, Santander reached 25 home runs; he's the ninth player in 0's history to do so in at least three straight seasons, matching **Frank Robinson** (1969-71), **Lee May** (1976-78), and **Manny Machado** (2015-17), and trailing **Eddie Murray** (1982-85) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, **Chris Davis** (2012-17) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1982-87), who had six, and **Adam Jones** (2011-17), who hit at least 25

and Cal Ripken, Jr. (1982-87), who had six, and Adam Jones (2011-17), who hit at least 25 homers in seven straight years. He now has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind Frank Robinson (16), Brady Anderson (17), Chris Davis and Manny Machado (19), Eddie Murray and Boog Powell (20), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (21); Santander is one of 40 active MLB players with at least 15 games of two or more homers; Machado, currently with San Diego, leads active players with 40 such games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight with the second of three games in Arlington before heading to Miami for the first time since 2021...The Birds went 4-2 on their last road trip against the Mariners (2-1) and Athletics (2-1) from July 2-7...The 0's are a league-best 29-16 (.644) on the road this year and 81-45 (.643) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: The Orioles and Rangers finish a seven-game season series with the second of three matchups tonight in Texas...The O's took three out of four in Baltimore from June 27-30, but lost the series finale...Since the start of 2021, the O's are 17-7 (.708) against the Rangers during the regular season, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022...Baltimore is 278-222-1 all-time against the Rangers since the Washington Senators moved to Texas in 1972; the .556 winning percentage during that time is the best by the Orioles among current AL teams and the second-best against all teams during that time behind the .558 mark against the Brewers (min. 100 G).

O: The Birds are 8-2 (.800) during the regular season at Globe Life Field since the ballpark opened in 2020, the best winning percentage by an AL team in that time.

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...At 6-7 this month, the Birds will need to go 7-5 in their final 12 games in July to extend the streak...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the 0's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 374 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles today reinstated outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** from the 7-day concussion Injured List and optioned outfielder **Kyle Stowers** to Triple-A Norfolk.
