**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (0-2, 2 to play) and Cubs (3 to play) today at Tropicana Field...have lost back-to-back games following a three-game winning streak...are 6-5 in their last 11 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 6-11 in their last 17 games after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...have fallen a season-high-tying 13.0 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since the conclusion of the 2022 season (13.0 GB)...the Rays are 0-2 thus far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Yesterday, the Rays were held to two hits in a 5-0 setback to the Orioles, their fewest since May 29, 2023 at CHC (1) and fewest at home since April 26, 2023 vs. HOU (2). Tampa Bay was shut out for the fourth time, all at Tropicana Field, and for the third time by an AL East opponent...the four home shutouts are tied for fourth most in the majors behind the Tigers (6), Athletics and White Sox (both 5).

The Rays are 1-8 in their last nine games against AL East opponents after a 9-7 start...they are 3-9 vs. division rivals at Tropicana Field, losing six straight since their last win on May 11 vs. NYY...it marks their longest streak since Sept. 10-26, 2003 (6G)...they have not had a longer home skid vs. AL East clubs since falling in a club-record eight straight from May 3-10, 2002.

The Rays are 5-12 against .500 or better teams compared to 26-21 against clubs with losing records...according to Elias, their remaining opponents have combined for a .537 winning pct., the highest mark in the majors.

Tampa Bay's bullpen owns a 3.06 ERA (129.1IP, 44ER) since May 3, third lowest in the AL behind the Guardians (1.92) and Astros (2.51) and sixth in MLB.

Today, **RHP Zack Littell** looks to become the second Ray to record three straight quality starts this season, joining **RHP Ryan Pepiot** (April 18-29).

**26 UP, 26 DOWN**—**Yandy Díaz** tallied both Rays hits yesterday, singling in the 1st and 9th frames...between the two hits, Orioles pitching retired 26 consecutive Rays batters...per Elias, it marked the fourth time 26 consecutive Rays were retired in a game, joining a trio of perfect games thrown by SEA **Félix Hernández** (Aug. 15, 2012), OAK **Dallas Braden** (May 9, 2010) and CWS **Mark Buehrle** (July 23, 2009)...it marked the second instance of 26+ consecutive batters being retired in the majors this season—HOU **Ronell Blanco** sat down 26 straight Blue Jays sandwiched around a pair of walks during his no-hitter on April 1 vs. TOR.

It marked the fourth time Tampa Bay was held to exactly two hits, both coming from the same player, joining April 26, 2023 vs. HOU (**Manuel Margot**), Aug. 2, 2022 vs. TOR (**Taylor Walls**) and July 25, 2007 at BAL (**B.J. Upton**).

**TROP FLOPS**—The Rays are 4-11 (.267) at home since May 8, the second-worst mark in MLB over that timeframe, better than only the Mets (4-12/.250)...they have been outscored, 74-43 (-31), in those contests, going 4-3 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 0-8 with three runs or fewer...it marks their worst 15-game stretch at Tropicana Field since July 5-23, 2023 (also 4-11).

**HOT HITTERS**—**Yandy Díaz** has a season-high 11-game on-base streak, his longest since Sept. 8-21, 2023 (13)...he has a .320 on-base pct., 7 BB and 6 SO during the streak.

Despite going 0-for-3 yesterday, **Randy Arozarena** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 19 PA...he is batting .333 (6-for-18) with 2 2B, 6 BB, 2 HBP and a .583 on-base pct. over six games in June.

**Jose Siri** is batting .303 (10-for-33) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI over his last 10 games...he has 15 RBI in his last 18 games after collecting seven in his first 34 contests.

**HOMER (UN)HAPPY**—The Rays have been out-homered, 5-1, this series and own a -35 (84-49) home run margin on the season, the worst mark in the majors...they have hit the fewest homers (49) and allowed 84 HR, tied with the Blue Jays for second most in the majors behind the White Sox (85)...they have out-homered the opposition just once in their last 17 games (May 30 vs. OAK), posting a -14 (23-9) HR margin in that span.

The Rays are 8-2 when out-homering their opponent, 16-11 when home runs are even and 7-20 when being out-homered.

**RALLY RAYS**—The Rays 17 comeback wins are tied for fourth most in the majors behind the Yankees (19), Phillies (19) and Orioles (18)...each of their six wins from May 18-June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May 8-18, 2013 (8G), per Elias...overall, 54.8 pct. of their victories (17 of 31) have been comeback wins, tied with the Tigers for the highest percentage in the AL/tied for fourth highest in the majors.

The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 7), seven (1st, 6) and eight (T3rd, 3) frames.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (12-4/.750) and games decided by two runs or fewer (22-9/.710)...their 31 games decided by two or fewer runs are tied for third most in the AL behind the Athletics (34) and Angels (32)...they lead the majors in wins by two runs or fewer (22), but their 24 losses by 3+ runs are second most in the AL behind the White Sox (29).

The Rays have won each of their last six one-run games, their longest single-season streak a seven-game run from Aug. 10-Sept. 2, 2019...they are 13-3 in their last 16 games decided by two runs or fewer.

**BIRDS IN THE BAY**—The Rays and Orioles continue a 13-game season series with the sixth of seven matchups over 11 days from May 31-June 10, with Tampa Bay going 1-4 so far...since 2017, the Rays are 73-47 against the Orioles, their most wins against any opponent over that timeframe...however, the Rays have lost 12 of the last 17 meetings and are 13-21 in the last 34 matchups on the heels of a 27-2 stretch in the previous 29...the Rays are 0-4-1 in their last five series against the Orioles...their last series win over Baltimore came from Aug. 12-14, 2022 at Tropicana Field.

**Randy Arozarena** is a career .332 (70-for-211) hitter with 10 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR and 43 RBI in 55 games vs. Baltimore, his most hits, home runs and RBI against any opponent...min. 150 AB, it marks the fifth-highest career average against the Orioles among active players.

**DOWN ON THE FARM**—Triple-A Durham has won eight of its last 10 games following Saturday's 7-3 victory over Gwinnett...**3B Curtis Mead** and **1B Austin Shenton** went a combined 6-for-8 with 2 2B and 3 RBI...**RHP Shane Baz** (5.0IP, 3H, ER, 2BB, 10SO) recorded his first 10+ SO game since June 5, 2022 vs. Nashville.

Rays No. 10 prospect (MLB.com) **CF Chandler Simpson** swiped a pair of stolen bases in Double-A Montgomery's 5-3 loss to Biloxi...his 47 SB lead the minors.

**1B Xavier Isaac** (No. 3, MLB.com) homered in Class-A Bowling Green's 8-7 win at Asheville...his 11 HR are tied for the Southern League lead.

**RHP Gary Gill Hill** fell one out shy of his third quality start in Class-A Charleston's 2-1 loss to Carolina (5.2IP, 5H, ER, 5SO)...his 2.51 ERA ranks third in the Carolina League.

DSL Tampa Bay **OF Leonardo Pienda**, who received the highest signing bonus of the Rays 2024 international signing class, is 9-for-18 (.500) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB and 2 SO through his first five professional games.

- Rays starter **RHP Zach Eflin** and Orioles INF **Ryan Mountcastle** were teammates at Hagerty High School (Oviedo, FL)...other notable Hagerty alumni include BOS **Vaughn Grissom** and DET **Riley Greene**.
- Rays reliever **RHP Shawn Armstrong** and Orioles INF **Connor Norby** are two of four East Carolina University products in the majors, joining PHI **Alec Burleson** and PHI **Jeff Hoffman**.
- There are a trio of Florida-born players on the Orioles active roster: OF **Austin Hays** (Daytona Beach), INF **Ryan Mountcastle** (Winter Springs) and INF **Ryan O'Hearn** (Dunedin).
- Rays **RHP Shawn Armstrong** spent parts of three seasons with Baltimore from 2019-21, appearing in 85 games.
- Rays **LHP Garrett Cleavinger** was selected by the Orioles in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and remained in the organization until being dealt to the Phillies in 2017 in a trade involving former Ray **RHP Jeremy Hellickson**.
- Rays Hitting Coach **Chad Mottola** appeared in six games for the Orioles in 2004...he was originally drafted by the club in 1989, but opted to attend UCF.
- Rays Asst. Pitching/Rehab Coach **Rick Knapp** is a Baltimore native.
- Rays Head Athletic Trainer **Joseph Bengt** spent 10 seasons as an AT in the Orioles system (2001-10).
- Rays Vice President, Asst. GM **Kevin Ibach** spent seven years with the Orioles as a baseball operations coordinator from 2000-07.
- Rays Director, Amateur Scouting **Chuck Ricci** was drafted by the Orioles in 1987, spending seven seasons in the club's farm system from 1987-93.

**TODAY'S START**—The right-hander will take the mound for his 13th start of the season, including his eighth at home...has recorded a 4.18 ERA (47.1IP, 22ER) in his last 8 GS compared to a 2.14 ERA (21.0IP, 5ER) in his first 4 GS...has thrown 5.0+ IP in nine straight and 11 of his 12 starts overall...is seeking his first victory since May 11 vs. New York-AL.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Did not factor into the decision on June 2 at Baltimore...allowed three runs on a career-high 11 hits and one walk across 6.0 innings...stuck out a season-low two batters after striking out a career-high nine hitters in his previous start on May 28 vs. Oakland.

Allowed his first career lead-off homer to **Gunnar Henderson** to start the outing...an **Anthony Santander** RBI-single gave the Orioles a 2-0 lead in the 3rd inning...a two-out RBI-single by **Adley Rutschman** in the 4th frame gave Baltimore a 3-0 advantage.

**BIRDS FLY SOUTH**—Littell is set to face the Orioles for the second time in as many starts...has made four career appearances (2GS) opposite Baltimore, posting a 3.29 ERA (13.2IP, 5ER)...owns a 3.38 ERA (10.2IP, 4ER) in the two starts.

Since officially joining the Rays rotation on July 19, 2023 Littell is 3-0 with a 3.56 ERA (48.0IP, 19ER) in eight starts against the AL East, including 2-0 with a 3.49 ERA (28.1IP, 11ER) in five starts this year.

**MIXED BAG**—In his last start on June 2 at Baltimore, Littell allowed a career-high 11 hits, yet earned his second straight quality start...he is the only pitcher in the majors this season to allow three runs or fewer while conceding 11+ hits and the first Ray to do so since **Doug Waechter** on May 25, 2006 at Boston (5.1IP, 11H, 3ER, 2BB, 3SO).

He is the first pitcher in MLB to earn a quality start while allowing 11+ hits since **KC Zack Greinke** on June 29, 2023 vs. Cleveland (6.0IP, 11H, 2ER, 2BB, 0SO)...he became the ninth pitcher in Tampa Bay franchise history to accomplish the feat, including the first since **James Shields** on May 9, 2010 at Oakland (6.0IP, 11H, 4R, 2ER, 1BB, 6SO).

Became the eighth pitcher in franchise history to allow 11+ hits to the Orioles, including the first since **Jalen Beeks** on Aug. 25, 2019 (5.0IP, 11H, 7ER, 2BB, 6SO).

**UP AND AT 'EM**—In six daytime starts, Littell is 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA (33.0IP, 9ER)...min 30.0 IP, it is the fifth-lowest daytime ERA in the AL behind **KC Cole Ragans** (1.02), **BAL Cole Irvin** (1.48), **KC Seth Lugo** (1.62) and **KC Brady Singer** (1.95).

In 22 daytime appearances (12GS) dating back to Sept. 9, 2022, Littell has allowed two runs or fewer in 21 of the 23 outings, posting a 2.96 ERA (73.0IP, 24ER) during that span.

**PINPOINT PRECISION**—Littell's 3.8 pct. walk rate is sixth lowest in the majors behind teammate **Zach Eflin** (1.5%), **SEA George Kirby** (2.3%), **CIN Nick Martinez** (2.8%), **DET Jack Flaherty** (3.6%) and **ATL Chris Sale** (3.7%).

According to **Elias**, his free pass to **NY Yankees Anthony Rizzo** on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, third longest in Rays history behind **Corey Kluber** (150, 2022) and **David Price** (124, 2013)...five of his 11 walks have come in a total of two frames: the 1st inning on April 10 at LAA (3BB) and the 2nd on May 11 vs. NYY (2BB)...excluding his statistics in those two frames, he has produced a 2.3 pct. walk rate (6BB/257BF) in all other innings.

From April 17-May 4, he recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...the four such starts are tied for second most in the majors behind **PIT Jared Jones** (5).

**BEND, DON'T BREAK**—Littell has yielded 10.14 hits/9.0 IP, the fifth-highest mark in the majors behind **WSH Patrick Corbin** (11.55), **COL Ryan Feltner** (10.83), **MIN Chris Paddack** (10.80) and **CLE Logan Allen** (10.44).

His success has stemmed from his lack of walks coupled with a career-best 35.2 pct. hard-hit rate, which has dropped 6.7 pct. compared to his 41.9 pct. hard-hit rate last season.

Littell has thrown 54.3 pct. of his pitches in the strike zone, the sixth-highest percentage in the AL/11th highest in MLB...opponents have swung at 53.5 pct. of his total pitches, fourth in the majors behind **CHC Shota Imanaga** (56.5%), **PIT Jared Jones** (55.1%), and **SEA George Kirby** (53.9%).

**ODDS AND ENDS**—His 3.29 runs of support per start are sixth lowest in the AL and ninth lowest in the majors...opponents are batting .311 (28-for-90) with two outs against Littell...lead-off hitters have posted a .361/.378/.611 (13-for-36) line against him.
