**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals complete their second homestand of the season with the final game of a three-game series with the Cleveland Guardians this afternoon at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals are 2-3 over their current six-game Interleague homestand against Boston (1-2) and Cleveland (1-1). St. Louis enters today T-3rd in the National League Central one game behind first place Pittsburgh and Cincinnati.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals will travel to Houston following this afternoon's game to start a six-game road trip against the Astros and Marlins on Friday at Daikin Park with the first of a three-game series.

**42:** In honor of Jackie Robinson Day, all of Major League Baseball will be wearing Dodger blue No. 42 jersey numbers today. On April 15, 1947 **Jackie Robinson** broke baseball's color barrier and played his first Major League Baseball game for the Brooklyn Dodgers.



- The Cardinals are 14-6 overall (6-4 at home) on Jackie Robinson Day since the remembrance day was initiated on April 15, 2004.

- The only time St. Louis and Cleveland have played on Jackie Robinson Day was **Aug. 28, 2020**, a 14-2 Cardinals loss on at Busch Stadium. Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, August 28 was chosen due to the anniversary of the 1945 day when **Branch Rickey** met with **Jackie Robinson** to discuss his future in the Major Leagues.

**STAYING ABOVE WATER:** When the Cardinals ended their three-game losing streak last night, they stayed above .500 for the season at 9-8. The Cardinals haven't stayed .500 or above this late into the season since 2022, when they won 93 games en route to the National League Central crown.

**WORKING OVERTIME:** Last night, the Cardinals improved to 4-0 with a walk-off win in the 10th inning as **Nathan Church** hit a sacrifice fly to score **Thomas Saggese** for a 6-5 comeback win. The 4-0 start in extra inning games is the 'Birds best start to a season since 2004 when they won their first six extra inning games en route to the National League pennant. The Cardinals are tied with the Mets for the most extra inning games this season, but the Cardinals have two more extra inning wins than any other team in MLB.

**WETHER OR NOT, HERE I COME:** Rookie **JJ Wetherholt** hit a pair of home runs to lead the Cardinals to a comeback win last night. The left-handed batting second baseman was the first Cardinals rookie to hit a pair of longballs since **Dylan Carlson** vs. Milwaukee (Sept. 30, 2021) and the sixth lead-off second baseman to post a multi-home run game since **Tommy Edman** at Chicago (AL) on May 26, 2021. He also matched **Matt Carpenter** as the first lefty to hit two or more home runs off left-handed pitchers since Carpenter's legendary day at Wrigley Field on July 20, 2018, when he socked three home runs, two off south-paw **Jon Lester** and another of **Brian Duensing**.

**COMEBACK CARDS:** With runs in the 8th, 9th and 10th innings, the Cardinals rallied for their 7th come-from-behind win, T-2nd most in MLB with Arizona and trailing only Los Angeles (NL). The Cardinals have four wins in their final at-bat and three walk-off wins this season.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **Jordan Walker** may not have homered last night, but he extended his hitting streak to 10 games, the 2nd-longest active streak behind **Ildemaro Vargas** of Arizona (11). Walker's double-digit hit streak marks the 4th of his career and first since 2023 when he posted three different streaks of 10 games or more as a rookie and was the only player in MLB to have three different double-digit marks that season. Walker's longest streak was 17 games (June 6-29, 2023).

#### CLEVELAND CONNECTIONS

**José Fermín** signed with Cleveland as an International Free Agent (July 2, 2015)...played six minor league seasons in the Guardians organization before being purchased by St. Louis (Nov. 9, 2022).

**Justin Bruhl** was acquired by St. Louis from the Guardians in exchange for cash considerations on Jan. 6, 2026 after Cleveland had acquired him from Toronto for cash (Dec. 17, 2025).

**Julio Rangel** spent 11 years in the Cleveland system as a Cultural Development Coordinator (2007-08), Mental Skills Coordinator (2009-10), Lower Level Pitching Coordinator (2011-15), and Assistant Field Coordinator (2016-17).

**Shawn Armstrong** made 11 relief appearances for the Cardinals during the 2024 season.

Cardinals Asst. GM **Rob Cerfolio** and Farm Director **Larry Day** both previously worked in the Guardians Player Development department for 10 seasons (2015-24) before joining St. Louis.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** spent the 1991 season in Cleveland's minor league system as a pitching coach and pitcher between Colorado Springs (AAA) and Canton-Akron (AA).

**Dean Kiekhefer** was originally selected by Cleveland in the 37th round of the 2007 MLB Draft out of Oldham High School (Ky.), but did not sign.

**Dustin May** and **Nolan Gorman** were teammates for the NL in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland.

**Jordan Walker** was named Player of the Game at the 2019 MLB High School All-Star Game at Cleveland's Progressive Field.

**Matt Svanson** tallied his first career win on June 28, 2025 at Cleveland after pitching a scoreless inning of relief in a 9-6 victory.

Guardians Manager **Stephen Vogt** notched his first MLB hit on a home run vs. St. Louis on June 28, 2013 while with Oakland.

Guardians Replay Coord. **Gunnar Wilhelmy** attended the Univ. of Missouri, earning two undergraduate degrees (2016) and a Master's of Statistics (2018)...worked for the Mizzou Baseball team for five and a half years as Student Mgr., Graduate Asst., and Mgr. of Advanced Technologies.

Cleveland Sr. VP of Medical Services **Lonnie Soloff** attended St. Louis University...began his baseball career with the Cardinals in 1996 as part of the PBATS internship program.

The Cardinals & Indians played an exhibition at Cleveland's League Park during the 1936 All-Star break, when 17-year-old **Bob Feller** made his unofficial debut with 8 strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

Guardians Sr. VP Hitting **Alex Eckelman** played parts of five seasons in the Cards minor league system (1997-2001).

Cleveland AGM **Eric Binder** pitched part of the 2011 season in the Cardinals minor league system.

**Bill Veeck** was a former owner of both Cleveland (1946-49) and the St. Louis Browns (1951-53).

**Bryan Schapiro** is an Akron, Ohio native...graduated from the University of Akron.

The Cardinals and Cleveland played in MLB's inaugural Civil Rights Game on March 31, 2007 at AutoZone Park in Memphis, Tenn.

Cardinals Baseball Info. & Media Serv. Mgr. **Chris Tunno** graduated from Canfield (Ohio) High School.

The Cleveland Spiders were rivals of the St. Louis Browns in the American Association (1888-89) and National League (1892-99)...before the 1899 season, Spiders owners **Stanley** and **Frank DeHass Robison**, who also owned the St. Louis franchise, transferred Cleveland's best players (future Hall of Famers **Cy Young**, **Bobby Wallace**, & **Jesse Burkett**) to St. Louis and formed the Perfectos...the Spiders endured the worst season in pro baseball history (20-134) and were disbanded as the NL contracted to eight teams.

## TODAY'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 4th career start with the Cardinals this afternoon; It's his 61st career start (75th appearance) and 3rd at Busch Stadium.
- Bested his former team the Red Sox in the homestand opener last Fri. (4/10) in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.
- Three of his first four starts including today have been day games; his career day (5.93 ERA) vs. night (3.68 ERA) are similar so far this season with 1.50 mark in his lone night game and 15.95 in two previous day games.
- Signed as a free-agent deal for 2026 with mutual option for 2027, in December. St. Louis becomes his 3rd team, having previously pitched for the Dodgers (2019-25) & Red Sox (2025).
- Is 6-4 with a 4.01 ERA in 16 career April starts; his most wins in any calendar month. Holding the opposition to a .208 BA; 12th-lowest BA among active pitchers *min. 15 GS*
- Is the 27th Cardinal to wear uniform No. 3, but the first Cardinals pitcher to have worn the number:** notable former Cardinals to wear #3 are **Édgar Rentería**, **Brian Jordan**, **Carlos Beltrán** and most recently **Dylan Carlson**.

**LAST TIME OUT (Friday, April 10 vs. Boston):** W, 3-2; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO, 75 pitches.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**MILESTONE WIN:** Bested his former team the Red Sox in the homestand opener last Fri. (4/10) in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

**LIKE NIGHT & DAY:** Three of his first four starts including today have been day games; his career day (5.93 ERA) vs. night (3.68 ERA) splits are similar so far this season with 1.50 mark in his lone night game and 15.95 in his two previous day games.

**TIGER STRIKE:** Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

**OPENING ACT:** Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

## 2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

**CHANGES IN LATITUDES:** Began the season with the Dodgers before a trade at the deadline sent him to Boston for the remainder of the season.

**THE WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART:** When he made his season debut on April 1 vs. Atlanta, was his first action in a Major League game in 685 days dating back to May 17, 2023.

## CAREER:

- Carries three World Championship rings as a member of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Played in the 2020 World Series at the neutral site at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Was on the Injured List during the 2024 World Series. Was traded before the Dodgers won the World Series in 2025.
- Became the first Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start when he took the mound on July 24, 2020 in place of injured Clayton Kershaw, The last Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981.
- Missed the entire 2024 season recovering from Tommy John surgery repairing a torn flexor tendon in his right arm from July 2023 and an esophageal tear in July.
- Required Tommy John surgery performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, May 11, 2021 following a start at Milwaukee 10 days earlier on May 1 in which he tore his ulnar collateral ligament (UCL).
- Pitched for the National League in the 2019 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland. Pitched a scoreless 3rd inning in the game. Was teammates with current Cardinals infielder Nolan Gorman.
- Led all Major League pitchers averaging 99.1 MPH on his fastball during the 2020 season (min. 250 pitches).

## MAY VS. CLEVELAND:

- Is making his third career appearance (2nd start) against Cleveland as he appears in his 3rd different uniform vs. the Guardians; made a start on 5/27/24 as a member of the Dodgers & pitched in relief on 9/3/25 while with Boston.
- Posted his 1st road win of the 2025 season against the Guardians in a 9-5 win at Progressive Field on 5/27 when he struck out a season-high 9 batters over 5.0 IP
- Made his final appearance of 2025 when he worked 3.0 IP in relief on 9/3 at Fenway Park, allowing one run.
