THE PIRATES:...had the day off yesterday...Have lost a season-high three straight games...Went 2-5 on their road trip against the Phillies (2-2) and Mets ( $0-3$ )...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening four-game series on the road for the first time since doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati...Are tied for the fourth-best record (11-8) in the National League along with the Phillies (also tied for the eighth-best record in MLB).
ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Quinn Priester will make his 2024 Pirates debut tonight after being recalled from Triple-A Indianapolis today...The 23 -year-old Priester went $1-1$ with a 3.95 ERA ( 13.2 ip/ $6 e r$ ), 20 strikeouts and .226 batting average against in three starts this season with Indianapolis...In his last start on April 13 against Toledo, Priester struck out eight batters in 4.0 innings while throwing a total of 81 pitches ( 54 strikes)...Priester will wear uniform №. 46 .

ON Q: Quinn Priester entered this season rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 8 prospect...He was also tabbed among Baseball America's top 100 prospects in both 2022 (No. 88) and 2021 (No. 58)...The Pirates drafted Priester out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School with the 18th overall selection in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft...He made his big league debut last year on July 17 against Cleveland and suffered the loss before winning each of his next two starts.

TAKING A STAND: The Pirates went 3-2 on their first homestand of the season against Baltimore (2-1) and Detroit (1-1)...The Bucs walked off Baltimore in back-to-back games on April 6-7 and ended their homestand with a last at-bat loss against the Tigers on April
