AROUND THE HORN

TONIGHT, WE CELEBRATE THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF 2001 WORLD SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP: Tonight, the D-backs will celebrate the 25th anniversary of the D-backs' World Series title born from one of the most unforgettable moments in franchise history...over 30 former players and coaches will be honored at the pregame celebration to honor the historic championship team and its enduring legacy.

THROWBACK JERSEY GIVEAWAY: Tonight, the first 25,000 fans will receive a 2001 Throwback Jersey courtesy of Chase.

SCHULTE BACK ON AIR: The D-backs voice of a generation, Greg Schulte, continues on the radio broadcast tonight.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 14-9 (.609) and 7-3 (.700) at home in games following a series-opening loss...have won 7 of their last 9 games following a series-opening loss.

- Brandon Pfaadt** is 7-2 (team is 11-3) with a 2.83 ERA (27 ER in 86.0 IP) in his last 14 starts.
 - Is making his second career start vs. Yankees (previous: Sept. 22, 2023; L, 5 ER in 4.1 IP, 8 H, 0 BB, 8 K).
- Corbin Carroll** has 3 homers in his last 7 games with 8 RBI.
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 13 straight games, batting .356 (16-for-45)/1.186 OPS with 2 doubles, 5 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely multiple times in a season-high-tying 5 straight games... in those 5 games, is hitting .438 (7-for-16)/1.009 OPS with 5 walks.
- Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games, hitting .353 (18-for-51)/1.078 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 9-2 vs. Yankees last night.

- Geraldo Perdomo, Nolan Arenado** and **Corbin Carroll** each logged 2-hit nights.
- Corbin Carroll** homered (22) in the second inning to make it a 5-2 score.
- Zac Gallen** tossed 3.0 innings in his first career relief appearance (2 H, 2 R-1 ER, 2 BB, 2 K).
- Eduardo Rodriguez** took the loss after allowing 7 runs on 5 hits and 4 walks in 5.1 innings with 5 strikeouts.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 5.0 games behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5, 3-game series from Sept. 25-27), Cubs (WC T-1, trail 2-4) and Phillies (WC T-1, tied 3-3).

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT - DOUBLE-A AMARILLO ADVANCES: Last night, Double-A Amarillo claimed the Texas League South Division title with an 8-7 win over Frisco and will face Springfield (Cardinals) in the best-of-3 Championship series starting on Sunday.

ARENADO’S STREAK VS. YANKEES: **Nolan Arenado’s** 16-game hit streak vs. Yankees is the longest among active players and tied for the longest hit streak overall by a MLB third baseman vs. Yankees since 2001 with Shea Hillenbrand/BOS (16 from Sept. 9, 2001-Aug. 27, 2002)...next longest is Paul Molitor’s 21-gamer from 1983-86.

ARENADO NEARING NINTH 25/75 SEASON: **Nolan Arenado (25 HR/74 RBI)** is 1 RBI shy of becoming the fifth third baseman since 1969 [min. 100 GS per year] with 9+ seasons of 25+ homers and 75+ RBI, to join Mike Schmidt/PHI (12 from 1974-87), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10 from 2001-12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10 from 2015-2026) and Adrián Beltré/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9 from 2004-16).

GABI THE EXTRAORDINARY: **Gabriel Moreno**, with his .304 AVG (sixth in MLB), is looking to become the first qualified primary catcher to hit .300+ since Buster Posey/SF in 2017 (.320).

- His .304 AVG, .382 OBP, .863 OPS and 6 stolen bases lead catchers [min. 90 G].

INTERLEAGUE: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely multiple times in 7 straight Interleague games and in 13 straight Interleague games overall...in his last 13 Interleague games, is hitting .356 (16-for-45)/1.215 OPS with 2 doubles, 5 homers, 10 RBI and 9 walks.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 15 Interleague games, hitting .327 (16-for-49)/.838 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 8 walks.

STRONG SEPTEMBER ‘PEN: The D-backs bullpen’s 2.45 ERA (23 R-19 ER in 69.2 IP) in September ranks second in the Majors, behind the Guardians (2.36), ahead of the Red Sox (2.68).

MARTINEZ MOMENTUM: **Justin Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his 10 games this season (2 R-0 ER in 9.2 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .152 AVG (5-for-33)/.512 OPS, 6 walks and 13 strikeouts.

STINGY AT HOME: **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 25 of his 26 home games, going 0-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER in 25.0 IP), opponent .146 AVG (12-for-82)/.391 OPS, 0.64 WHIP, 4 walks and 21 strikeouts.

- Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 13 straight home games (12.1 IP), going 1-0 with 2 saves, an opponent .143 AVG (6-for-42)/.432 OPS, 6 walks and 11 strikeouts.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs’ 45 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (42) and Dodgers (42).

- Their 23 comeback home wins are tied for fourth in the NL with the Brewers, behind the Padres (27), Dodgers (26) and Cubs (24).

1-RUN WINS: 28 of the D-backs’ 80 wins (35 pct.) have been decided by 1 run...their 28 1-run victories are their most in a season since 2017 (29), and are second most in the Majors this season, behind the Dodgers (30) and ahead of the Braves (26).

VS. YANKEES: The D-backs have won or split 4 of their last 6 series (3 wins, 1 split) vs. Yankees.

- The D-backs are hosting the Yankees for the sixth time all-time and first time since April 1-3, 2024.
- The D-backs hosted the Yankees for the first time ever during the 2001 World Series...welcomed for the first time during the regular season in June 2004.
