LHP Zac Thornton (2-2, 2.88 ERA) vs. RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (6-3, 3.15 ERA)

THE PIRATES: are starting a brief, three-game homestand vs. New York-NL (Friday-Sunday) with tonight's series opener at PNC Park (it marks their only three-game homestand of the season and their first three-game homestand since June 20-22, 2025 vs. Texas)...Won two of eight games on their recent road trip to Cincinnati (1-3, July 30-August 2) and Milwaukee (1-3, Monday-Thursday)...Will embark on a three-game road trip to Miami (August 11-13) following this homestand (it will mark their first three-game road trip against a non-National League Central opponent since they ended the 2024 season with a three-game series from September 27-29 at Yankee Stadium)...Are in the 15th day of a stretch of 17 consecutive days with a game (their last off day was on July 23, while their next off day is scheduled for August 10)...Have hit 143 home runs (they hit 117 home runs in 2025)...Have the most hits (1036) in all of Major League Baseball...Have scored the third-most runs (588) in Major League Baseball, behind Washington (623) and Chicago-NL (595), after scoring 583 runs all of last year...Have struck out the third-most batters (1087) in Major League Baseball, behind Philadelphia (1133) and Milwaukee (1128).

MEET THE METS: The Pirates are hosting the Mets for a three-game series (Friday-Sunday) this weekend at PNC Park...Pittsburgh dropped two of three games in its season-opening series against New York at Citi Field (March 26-29)...The Pirates have won or split each of their last three series against the Mets at PNC Park...They won two of three games from June 9-11, 2023, split a four-game series from July 5-8, 2024 and swept a three-game series from June 27-29, 2025...Pittsburgh has won or split at least four straight home series against the Mets only five times in series history (since 1962), coming from April 21, 1962-June 6 (G2), 1965 (10 straight series), September 20, 1965-August 11, 1966 (four straight series), September 19, 1980-August 16, 1983 (eight straight series), April 15, 1991-June 20, 1993 (seven straight series) and July 12, 2013-June 8, 2016 (four straight series).

J-HAY: Josh Harrison, who was a two-time All-Star with the Pirates (2014 and 2017), will officially retire as a member of the organization today...He batted .270 (1080-for-3997) over his 1209 Major League games with Pittsburgh (2011-18), Detroit (2019), Washington (2020-21), Oakland (2021), Chicago-AL (2022) and Philadelphia (2023)...Harrison went 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored in his Major League debut on May 31, 2011 at Citi Field (he picked up two singles off New York starter R.A. Dickey in the Pirates' 5-1 win)...He is also remembered for his elusive escape of a rundown during the 10th inning of Pittsburgh's 3-2, 11-inning win over the Mets on June 27, 2014, a game that he ended via a walkoff double (off Vic Black) that scored Clint Barmes...Harrison will be honored with a special pregame ceremony and a ceremonial first pitch prior to Saturday night's game.

LOWE OR NEVER: Brandon Lowe connected for his 24th home run of the season with his solo blast (off Dustin May) in the fourth inning on Thursday at Milwaukee...He is batting .294 (35-for-119) with six doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, a .786 OPS and 19 runs scored across his last 29 games, dating back to July 1 at Philadelphia...Lowe's 50 extra-base hits this season (25 doubles, one triple and 24 home runs) are tied for the 10th-most in all of Major League Baseball...The only Pirates hitters during the 21st century with at least 25 doubles and 25 home runs while batting left-handed in a single season were Brian Giles (three straight seasons, 2000-02), Adam LaRoche (2008), Nate McLouth (2008), Pedro Álvarez (2012), Garrett Jones (2012) and Josh Bell (2019).

END(Y) IN SIGHT: Endy Rodríguez, who was originally signed by New York (NL) as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2018, before being dealt to Pittsburgh on January 19, 2021, singled on Thursday at Milwaukee...He is 26-for-88 (.295) with four doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks, four stolen bases and a .919 OPS over his last 26 games (since June 12 vs. Miami).

'BURGH PROUD: Jake Mangum, who was recognized by the MLB Players Alumni Association as the Bucs' nominee for the 2026 Heart and Hustle Award today, doubled and walked on Thursday at Milwaukee...Mangum, who was selected by New York (NL) in the 2018 (32nd round, did not sign) and 2019 (fourth round, signed) First-Year Player Drafts, is 67-for-208 (.322) with 14 extra-base hits and 14 stolen bases in 55 games since May 30 vs. Minnesota...He is one of four Major Leaguers with at least 14 extra-base hits/14 stolen bases in that time...The other players are the Yankees' Jazz Chisholm Jr., the Cubs' Pete Crow-Armstrong and Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance-A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

WELCOME BACK: Mlodzinski will make his 10th start of the season tonight vs. New York (NL)...He is 2-3 with a 4.30 ERA (44.0ip/21er) in his first nine starts...Mlodzinski has a 1.69 ERA (16.0ip/3er) over his last three starts, coming on May 8 at San Francisco (6.0ip/2er), May 20 at St. Louis (5.0ip/0er) and May 25 vs. Chicago-NL (5.0ip/1er)...He has gone 3-8 with a 4.40 ERA (100.1ip/49er) across his 26 career Major League starts.

SIX PACK: Mlodzinski struck out four batters over 3.0 scoreless innings of relief in Pittsburgh's 4-1 win on August 1 at Cincinnati (Braxton Ashcraft earned the win)...It was his sixth relief outing of at least 3.0 scoreless innings this season and his second in a row (also July 29 vs. Arizona)...Mlodzinski became the first Pirates reliever with six such outings in a single season since Jeff Robinson also had six during the 1988 season.

AGAINST THE METS: Mlodzinski has a 2.00 ERA (9.0ip/2er) and 11 strikeouts (no walks) in three career games (one start) against New York (NL)...He pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief on July 7, 2024 at PNC Park...Mlodzinski earned the win after pitching 3.2 scoreless innings in the Pirates' 12-1 win on June 29, 2025 at PNC Park...He had a no-decision after allowing two runs in 4.1 innings in his 2026 debut, which came as a starter in Pittsburgh's 4-3, 10-inning win on March 29 at Citi Field...He became the second Pirates pitcher (first starter) during the Modern Era (since 1901) to have at least eight strikeouts while issuing zero walks in an outing of 4.1 or fewer innings, along with Rich Gossage, who did it in 3.0 innings of relief on May 19, 1977 vs. Los Angeles.

RIGHT AT HOME: Mlodzinski has gone 4-0 with a 3.20 ERA (45.0ip/16er) in 12 appearances (three starts) at PNC Park this season...The Pirates have won in 11 of those 12 games, with the only loss coming in his last home game (July 29 vs. Arizona).

WHAT A RELIEF: Mlodzinski is 4-0 with two saves (June 4 at Houston and June 24 vs. Seattle) and a 2.15 ERA (50.1ip/12er) in 16 relief appearances...He became the first Pirate with multiple saves of at least 3.0 innings in a season since Bob Patterson (1992)...Mlodzinski had a 1.42 ERA (31.2ip/5er) in his last 12 relief outings from June 15-August 1...He was one of only two Major League relievers with at least 25.0 innings and a sub-2.00 ERA during that time, along with New York (AL)'s Paul Blackburn (0.98).

GIMME FIVE: Mlodzinski won a 7-2 decision after allowing two runs over 5.0 innings of relief on May 14 vs. Colorado...He became the first Pirate to have multiple relief outings of at least 5.0 innings where he earned the win in both outings (also April 15 vs. Washington) since Bob Johnson also did that two times during the 1972 campaign.

AND THE WHIFF: Mlodzinski won a 17-7 decision after allowing five runs and striking out a career-high 10 batters over 5.2 innings on May 2 vs. Cincinnati...His only other 10-strikeout game in his professional career came on May 23, 2025 with Triple-A Indianapolis at Toledo...His 101 pitches were his most in any professional outing, surpassing the previous high of 96 (September 10, 2022 w/Double-A Altoona at Erie).

HISTORIC OUTING: Mlodzinski allowed two hits and struck out five batters over 6.0 scoreless innings of relief on April 15 vs. Washington...He became one of nine Pirates relievers during the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch at least 6.0 scoreless innings while allowing two or fewer hits and striking out at least five batters...He joined Mike Lynch (1906), Erv Kantlehner (1915), Bill Swift (1935), Mace Brown (1937), Dick Littlefield (1954), Harvey Haddix (1961), Al McBean (1963) and Bob Johnson (1972) on that list.
