AROUND THE HORN

MERCURY NIGHT: Tonight, the D-backs will celebrate Mercury Night featuring a ceremonial first pitch thrown by Phoenix Mercury's Kahleah Copper and Alyssa Thomas...fans can enjoy a Mercury-themed gameday experience throughout the ballpark, featuring appearances by mascot Scorch, Mercury game entertainment, music, in-game features and themed activations...Copper and Thomas will be joined on the field by several of their Mercury teammates for the ceremonial first pitch.

D-BACKS USA250 PACKAGE: There is no better place to celebrate Independence Day weekend than Chase Field as the D-backs host a 2-night must-see Fireworks Spectacular presented by Bar-5 on Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4...in recognition of America's 250th anniversary celebration, the D-backs are offering a special USA250 ticket package for the July 3 and July 4 games...fans can purchase 4 lower-level or club-level tickets for \$250 by using offer code USA250.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' current 6 straight wins vs. Giants are their most in a season against them all-time (prev: 5, 2x - last: Aug. 25-Sept. 16, 2017) and second most overall, behind their 9 straight from Sept. 3, 2011-May 11, 2012.

- The D-backs are 13-4 in their last 17 NL West matchups (2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers).
- Ketel Marte** (1,181) is 1 hit away from tying Paul Goldschmidt (1,182) for second most hits in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,337).
- Ketel Marte** has homered in each of his last 2 games and 3 of his last 4...has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, hitting .317 (20-for-63)/.973 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 9 RBI and 5 walks, including reaching base 2+ times in 9 of those.
- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 19 straight starts, hitting .324 (22-for-68)/.948 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 12 walks.
- The D-backs are 12-2 in **Eduardo Rodriguez's** last 14 starts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-1 @ Rays yesterday.

- Ketel Marte** homered (15) in a second consecutive game in the eighth inning to plate the lone run.
- Geraldo Perdomo** (1-for-3, BB) hit safely in his fourth straight game.
- Jonathan Loaisiga** (1.0 IP) and **Drey Jameson** (1.0 IP) combined for 2.0 scoreless frames (2 H, 2 K).

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT: Yesterday, Tucson native and Double-A Amarillo INF **Demetrio Crisantes** recorded a cycle vs. Frisco (HR, 2B, 3B, 1B), the Sod Poodles' second of the season, while OF **Drew Jones** also highlighted the game with a 480-foot homer.

GIANT SWEEP: Entering this series, the D-backs have logged multiple sweeps vs. Giants in a season (in 3 or 4 game series) for the second time all-time (also: July 25-27, 2008 and Sept. 15-18, 2008)...the D-backs last swept the Padres twice in a season (Sept. 2-4, 2019 and Sept. 27-29, 2019).

- The D-backs are looking to sweep the same opponent 3 straight times in a single season for the first time in franchise history.

GABI ON A TEAR: Since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno** ranks among catchers [min. 25 GS] in OBP (1st, .415), walks (T-1st, 18, with Liam Hicks/MIA), stolen bases (T-1st, 4, with Hunter Goodman/COL), AVG (2nd, .325, behind Keibert Ruiz/WSH .337) and OPS (2nd, .915, behind Dillon Dingler/DET .929).

- Has reached base safely in 30 of his last 34 games, batting .325 (39-for-120)/.915 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 17 RBI, 18 walks and 4 stolen bases...has reached 2+ times in 19 of those games.

GLOVEWORK: The D-backs' defense ranks among the Majors in fielding pct. (3rd, .990) and fewest errors (3rd, 28), behind the Dodgers (1st, .991/1st, 26) and Padres (2nd, .991/2nd, 27).

- The D-backs' 25 Outs Above Average rank tied for second in the Majors, with the Dodgers and behind the Cubs (39).

MILESTONE WATCH: **Ketel Marte** (1,181) is 1 hit away from tying Paul Goldschmidt (1,182) for second most hits in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,337).

THE GIANT SLAYER: **Nolan Arenado's** 35 homers, 85 extra-base hits, 119 RBI and 182 hits (T-1st with Paul Goldschmidt) vs. Giants are the most among active MLB players.

- Since 1985, only 4 other players have hit 30+ homers vs. Giants: Gary Sheffield (34), Paul Goldschmidt (32), Jeff Bagwell (32) and Larry Walker (32).

CORBIN'S WAR RANKS: **Corbin Carroll's** 3.5 fWAR ranks fifth among position players, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (4.7), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4.3), Dillon Dingler/DET (3.7) and Yordan Alvarez/HOU (3.6).

POWER TRIO: Since May 13, the D-backs are the only team in the Majors with 3 players (min. 30 G) carrying a .915 OPS or higher, with **Ketel Marte** (.939), **Corbin Carroll** (.919) and **Gabriel Moreno** (.915).

CONTROLLING THE ZONE: D-backs batters' 77.4 pct. contact pct. and 602 strikeouts rank second in the Majors, behind the Rays (80.1 pct., 580).

MAKING THEM CHASE: The D-backs 31.8 pct. pitcher chase pct. ranks third in the NL, behind the Phillies (32.7 pct.) and Dodgers (32.2 pct.).

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: **Kevin Ginkel** is scoreless in 10 of his last 11 games, going 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER in 10.0 IP), 10 hits, 4 walks and 9 strikeouts.

- Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 21 of his last 24 games, going 1-1 with a 1.19 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 22.2 IP), 12 H, 8 walks and 14 strikeouts.

SAVE SITUATION SEWALD: **Paul Sewald** is 18-for-19 in save opportunities with a 2.41 ERA (5 ER in 18.2 IP), opponent .097 AVG (6-for-62)/.393 OPS, 0.48 WHIP, 3 walks and 22 strikeouts.

UP FOR THE CHALLENGE: The D-backs' 61.0 pct. challenge win pct. ranks second in the Majors, behind the Reds (63.0 pct.).

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have swept both of their 3-game series this season (vs. Giants May 18-20 and @ Giants May 25-27).

- Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).
