# San Francisco Giants (43-45) at Cleveland Guardians (54-31)

**TODAY'S GAME:** SF aims to continue its trend of solid play as they open a three-game series here in Cleveland tonight.

- ▶ SF is 7-3 in their last 10 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) over the last 11 days.
- ▶ The road, however, has been a tough place for the Giants in 2024 as they are 18-26 (.409) outside of Oracle Park... by winning last night's rubber match in Atlanta, the Giants claimed their first road series win since taking two-of-three in Texas from June 7-9.
- ▶ Even with last night's win, SF is still 6-10 in its last 16 road games since May 26.

**SURVIVE & ADVANCE:** SF is in a stretch leading into the All-Star break where they already played the Dodgers and Braves, winning both series...the Giants now take on the first-place Guardians for three before returning home to face the Blue Jays and second-place Twins.

- ▶ Looking at the Giants strength of schedule for the rest of the season, SF's opponents have a combined .492 win %, eighth-lowest of any team's remaining schedule...in the NL only the Padres (.492), Mets (.488) and Reds (.483) have remaining schedules against teams with a lower combined win % than the Giants.

**ON THE CUYAHOGA RIVER:** The Giants are visiting Cleveland for the first time since 2022 and are only playing just their third series in this ballpark since Interleague play expanded.

- ▶ SF has won both of its previous series at Jacobs/Progressive Field, going 2-1 here in 2008 and sweeping a three-game set here in April of 2022.
- ▶ Last year, the Giants took two-of-three from the Guardians at Oracle Park in mid-September.

**REINFORCEMENTS?:** LHP Robbie Ray (TJ surgery recovery) made his seventh rehab appearance (sixth start) with his outing last night for Triple-A Sacramento at Reno...Ray allowed three runs (earned) on two hits (one homer) with one walk and three strikeouts...he threw 58 pitches, 33 strikes... he could be available to rejoin the Giants around the All-Star break.

- ▶ **LHP Blake Snell** (left groin strain) made a third rehab appearance at Triple-A Sacramento Wednesday night vs. Reno...Snell worked 5.0 scoreless, hitless innings with one walk and nine strikeouts...he threw 67 pitches, 46 for strikes.
- ▶ **Bob Melvin** told reporters yesterday in Atlanta that Snell should slot back into the rotation when the team returns home against the Blue Jays barring any changes.
- ▶ **RHP Alex Cobb** (right shoulder) is scheduled to make his second rehab start tonight, pitching for Single-A San Jose at Stockton.

**IS THIS A RECORD?:** The Giants have gotten 5.0 innings from each of their last four starters in **RHP Spencer Bivens** (Sunday vs. LAD), **RHP Hayden Birdsong** (Tuesday), **RHP Jordan Hicks** (Wednesday) and **RHP Logan Webb** (7.0 innings last night).

- ▶ It's the first time since April 15-18 that SF's has had four consecutive starters pitch 5.0 or more innings...the four that did it then were **LHP Kyle Harrison** (scheduled to come off the IL tomorrow and start), Hicks, **RHP Keaton Winn** (on the IL) and Webb.

**NEXT MAN UP:** LHP Erik Miller is starting tonight's game for the Giants, marking the ninth time this year he's been called upon to start a game.

- ▶ In his previous eight starts, Miller has a 1.13 ERA (1 er, 8.0ip) and has recorded an out in the 2nd inning only once (May 23 at Pittsburgh).
- ▶ SF is 4-4 in the games Miller has "opened" and have gone 6-5 games started by Miller, **RHP Ryan Walker**, **RHP Randy Rodríguez** and **RHP Spencer Bivens**...it should be noted Bivens ended up going 5.0 innings in his start against the Dodgers last Sunday.

**'PEN PALS:** SF's bullpen has pitched 363.2 innings this season, most in MLB...additionally, **SF's RHPs Tyler Rogers** (45 games) and **Ryan Walker** (43 games) are one and two, respectively, in games pitched this season in the Majors.

**WHAT CAN'T HE DO?:** **OF Heliot Ramos** clubbed a game-tying, two-run homer to center yesterday in SF's win down in Atlanta...since his recall, the 24-year-old is slashing .298/.373/.530 for a .904 OPS...he's tied for the team lead in home runs (12) and is second on the team in RBI (40).

- ▶ According to *Sarah Langs*, Ramos' 12 homers are the most by a Giants player under the age of 25 in his first 51 games of a season since Dave Kingman in 1972 (14).
- ▶ Eight of Ramos' 12 homers since joining the Giants have given the team the lead or tied the game...since May 8, that total is second-best in the NL behind only the Dodgers' Shohei Ohtani (nine)...NYY's Aaron Judge leads the Majors in that time with 11 such homers.
- ▶ His 40 RBI since May 8 are tied most in the National League and third-most in MLB behind Judge (62) and CLE's José Ramírez (46).

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE?:** According to *Stats, LLC*, the Giants have taken a total of 53.9% of their total pitches faced this season, trailing only the Yankees (55.5%) and Brewers (55.4%) for the highest rate in MLB.

- ▶ On the flip side the Guardians have taken 50.0% of their total pitches faced in 2024, the lowest rate in the AL.

**This Date in Giants History**

**JULY 5, 1989** - Barry Bonds homered in Pittsburgh's 6-4 loss to the Giants, giving Barry and father Bobby Bonds the Major League father-and-son home run record with 408. The Bells (Gus Bell and Buddy Bell) and the Berras (Yogi Berra and Dale Berra) had shared the record of 407.

### #76 SPENCER BIVENS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper  
**Last Game:** 6/30 vs. LAD; W, 5.0ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3k, 1hr (60 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career start on Sunday vs. LAD, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits on 60 pitches.
- ▶ His 5.0 innings were the most he'd thrown in a game all season...in fact, had reached the 5.0-inning mark just twice in his minor league career (81 games).
- ▶ Selected from Triple-A June 16 and made his MLB debut that day.
- ▶ Was 4-0 with a 2.81 ERA in 21 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento...struck out 36 in 41.2 innings with opponents hitting .220 off him.
- ▶ Named the PCL's Pitcher of the Month for May after going 2-0 with three saves, a 0.49 ERA (1er, 18.1ip), 17 strikeouts, and a 0.98 WHIP.
- ▶ Signed by SF as a minor league free agent on May 13, 2022 after beginning the year in Indy ball with Gastonia.
- ▶ Began professional career with the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020.

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker  
**Last Game:** 7/4 at ATL; S, 1.0ip, h, 2k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Is 16-for-19 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Over his past seven outings, he's 1-0-4 with a 1.29 ERA (1er, 7.0ip), four hits (.167 avg), one walk and 11 strikeouts.
- ▶ Doval allowed nine runs on 13 hits in 10.0 innings (8.10 ERA) in June...he owned a 2.78 ERA through his first 23 games.
- ▶ Has issued 22 BBs in 34.2ip...his 13.9% BB rate is bottom 4% of league.
- ▶ Doval's hard-hit rate of 46.7% this year is in the bottom 5% of the league and a tad more than five percent higher than his hard-hit rate in 2023 (41.3%).
- ▶ Righties are just 14-for-72 (.194) with five extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 17-for-62 (.274) with seven extra-base hits.
- ▶ Has struck out 46 batters over 343.2 innings of work (11.9 SO/9.0).

### #64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve  
**Last Game:** 7/3 at ATL; 2.0ip, h, 4k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a career-high eight runs on Saturday vs. the Dodgers, but bounced back Wednesday and tossed 2.0-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has given up multiple runs three times in his 27 outings.
- ▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 18 of his 28 games w/SF.
- ▶ Has a 63.3% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

### #77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball  
**Last Game:** 7/3 at ATL; 1.0ip, h, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Had a 9.31 ERA (10er, 9.2ip) in 11 games in June.
- ▶ Lefties are 15-for-42 (.357) off him...righties are 15-for-62 (.242).
- ▶ Opposing hitters are hitting .300 and .259 off his slider and four-seamer, respectively, this year...last season they batted .200 off his slider and .174 off his four-seamer.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider  
**Last Game:** 6/29 vs. LAD; GS, 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Will serve as the opener today for the ninth time this season...Miller has a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip) with five walks and nine strikeouts in the eight starts.
- ▶ LHs are 6-for-48 (.125) off him and RHs are 21-for-89 (.236) with six home runs (one inside the park) and 16 RBI.
- ▶ His .189 XBA ranks in the top 4% of MLB.
- ▶ Batters are 10-for-59 (.169) with 15 strikeouts off his changeup.

### #73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 7/2 at ATL; 1.0ip (8 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits over 5.2 innings (1.59 ERA) in his last four appearances as a reliever.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on May 4 at Philadelphia.
- ▶ Has gotten 4+ outs in 12 of his 21 MLB outings...had only pitched more than 1.0ip in two of his 10 Triple-A appearances this season.
- ▶ Seven of his 16 inherited runners with SF have scored.

### 33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker  
**Last Game:** 6/30 vs. LAD; 1.0ip (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed just one earned run in his last 18 games dating to May 18 (19.0ip) for a 0.47 ERA...the only MLB reliever with a lower ERA in that span (min. 15ip) is MIL's Jared Koenig (0.44).
- ▶ Has a 1.13 ERA (3er, 24.0ip) in his last 24 games dating back to May 3...has struck out 29 batters during that stretch (10.9 K/9.0).
- ▶ LH batters are 17-for-54 (.315) off him...righties are 13-for-76 (.171) overall vs. Rogers this season.
- ▶ Has stranded 18 of his 24 inherited runners so far in 2024.

### #71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider  
**Last Game:** 7/4 at ATL; 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ His 45 games pitched this year are the most in MLB.
- ▶ Is on pace to appear in 82 games this year, which would be a career-best...appeared in 80 games in 2021.
- ▶ Has allowed just three walks (and one was intentional) in 41.1 innings pitched...his 1.8 BB% is lowest in MLB (min. 120 BF).
- ▶ Opponents' 84.4 mph average exit velocity off Tyler is second-lowest in the Majors.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (307 games).

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider  
**Last Game:** 7/2 at ATL; 1.0ip (11 pitches)

- ▶ His 43 games this year are second-most in MLB.
- ▶ 36 of Walker's 43 appearances have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has struck out 58 batters over 44.0ip (11.9 K/9.0) w/ just eight walks.
- ▶ His 34.3% strikeout rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ The number 1 & 2 hitters in a lineup are just 2-for-29 against Walker with one walk and 16 strikeouts this year (32 BF).
- ▶ His 26.4% opposing hard hit rate in 2023 was fifth-best in MLB...opponents have a 34.0% hard-hit rate this year.
