THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their current seven-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Boston over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games against Seattle on Monday and Tuesday nights...tonight, the Twins will play the third of four against the Mariners...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale with Seattle, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a short roadtrip with three at Rogers Centre over the weekend.
 ☞ Since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (13-2), ahead of the Dodgers (12-2) and Phillies (12-3).
 ☞ Twins have gone 7-2 in their last nine home games after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight at Target Field.

THINGS UNRAVEL LATE ON TWINS: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 10-6, suffering just their second loss in their last 16 days...eight of the 10 runs allowed by Twins pitchers came after the sixth inning...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Jay Jackson, Steven Okert and Jorge Alcala combined to allow eight runs on seven hits and four walks in 3.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Ryan Jeffers and Max Kepler...Jeffers hit his seventh home run, a three-run shot in the third inning, while Kepler doubled twice.

JOSHIN' AROUND: The Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala to Triple-A St. Paul. Alcala, who was recalled by Minnesota on Friday, appeared in two games during his most recent stint, allowing four runs on six hits in 2.2 innings pitched, with three walks and one strikeout...over eight appearances with the Twins this season overall, he has gone 1-1, 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), six walks and 10 strikeouts...to replace Alcala on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Josh Staumont from St. Paul...Staumont, who was signed by the Twins on December 27, began the season on Minnesota's 15-day Injured List with a left calf strain...he was reinstated on April 19 and optioned to St. Paul, where he appeared in five games from April 20-May 5, going 0-1, 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks, 11 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average...the 30-year-old appeared in 21 games (1 start) for the Kansas City Royals in 2023, posting a 5.40 ERA (20.0 IP, 12 ER) with 13 walks, 24 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP, while averaging 10.80 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings.

TWINS AND MS: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the third of seven games this season...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from June 28-30.
 ☞ The Twins are 8-6 in their last 14 vs. Seattle, dating back to April 10, 2022.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with five walks, a .426 on-base percentage, a .537 slugging percentage and a .962 OPS in 14 career games against Seattle.
 ☞ Carlos Correa has 111 career hits and 112 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...both his 111 hits and 112 games are sixth-most among actives.
 ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with seven doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, an .824 SLG and a 1.283 OPS in his last nine games vs. Seattle, dating back to July of 2023.

MAXING OUT: Max Kepler enters tonight with a season-long nine-game hitting streak, one short of his career-high of 10, done twice in 2019...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .444 (20-for-45) with seven doubles, two home runs, seven walks, 11 RBI, a .509 on-base percentage and a 1.243 OPS in 14 games.
 ☞ A hit tonight and Kepler will be the second Twin this season to reach a double-digit hitting streak, joining Willi Castro, who hit in 10 straight from April 24-May 4.
 ☞ Kepler's nine-game hitting streak is tied with Cody Bellinger for third-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Jake Cronenworth (11) and Michael Massey (10).

KEPING UP WITH THE JONES': Max Kepler hit two more doubles last night, giving him five in his last three games...he passed Jacque Jones and moved into sole possession of 14th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...he needs two to tie César Tovar for 13th:

C4, EXP-LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa ranks in the 98th percentile in baseball in sweet spot percentage (46.0%), in the 95th percentile in walk percentage (15.4%), in the 87th percentile in xwOBA (.374) and in the 79th percentile in expected batting average (.274).
 ☞ On the season, he is hitting .357 (10-for-28) against breaking pitches, eighth highest in the AL.

MIR-AND-A ANOTHER ONE: Jose Miranda is hitting .394 (13-for-33) with five doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .429 on-base percentage, a .636 slugging percentage and a 1.065 OPS in his last nine games...since being recalled from St. Paul on April 8, he is hitting .294 (20-for-68) with six doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and an .804 OPS in 22 games.

 ☞ Edouard Julien is slugging .721 on fastballs this season — third best in MLB...George Kirby has thrown fastballs 62% of the time this season — fifth highest among qualified starting pitchers.
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is batting .354 this season — second best in MLB among hitters with at least 49 total plate appearances.
 ☞ Alex Kirilloff is slugging .609 on fastballs against right-handed pitchers this season — 10th best in MLB.
 ☞ Willi Castro is batting .365 on pitches 95 mph or greater since last season — best in MLB among hitters with at least 292 total PA's.
 ☞ Twins hitters are slugging .684 with the pitcher behind in the count this season — second best in AL; League Avg.: .562.
 ☞ The Twins have won 79% of games in which they have scored first this season — fifth highest in MLB; League Avg.: 67%.
 ☞ Twins hitters have an on-base percentage of .339 (310 PA's) when leading off an inning this season — best in AL; League Avg.: .299.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1984, Twins rookie Kirby Puckett hit four singles in his first major league game, becoming the ninth player in history to collect four hits in his first 9-inning game...the Twins ended up winning 5-0 over the Angels, getting a homer from current Bally Sports North analyst Tim Laudner.

- ⚡ Making seventh start of season and 72nd of career...last pitched May 3 vs. Boston, earning his third-straight win...threw 6.0 shutout, two-hit innings with one walk and six strikeouts, in Minnesota's 5-2 victory.
- ⚡ Owns a 1.02 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER) through three home starts this season, compared to 9.42 (14.1 IP, 15 ER) in three road outings.
- ⚡ Facing Seattle for the fifth time in his career...has gone 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (24.0 IP, 7 ER), six walks and 25 strikeouts vs. the Mariners...most recently faced them May 21, 2023.

STIFLING THE SOX: Last pitched May 3 vs. Boston, opposite Tanner Houck, earning his third-straight win and second quality start of the season in Minnesota's 5-2 victory...threw 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and one walk with six strikeouts...escaped no-out, second-and-third jam in the first...only hit allowed after the first was a third-inning leadoff single by Ceddanne Rafaela; Rafaela was then caught stealing...retired 12 of his last 13 hitters, including three strikeouts in the sixth.

- ⚡ Induced 12 whiffs on 39 swings (30.8%)...improved 2024 whiff rate to 22.8 percent, which ranks in MLB's 32nd percentile.
- ⚡ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Boston's only hit on those swings was Rafael Devers' 111.9 mph double – the second-hardest hit ball off Paddack this season (Jo Adell single, 113.3 mph)...ranks in MLB's 42nd percentile with a 40.2 percent hard-hit rate.
- ⚡ Has won three-straight starts for the third time in his career (last: July 16-27, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Started April 27 at Los Angeles-AL, opposite José Soriano, and earned his second-straight win in a 16-5 Twins victory...allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...surrendered second-inning, two-run home run to Jo Adell...two more runs scored in the third on RBI singles by Aaron Hicks and Adell...stranded a runner in scoring position to end the second and third innings.

- ⚡ Induced nine whiffs on 48 swings (18.8%).
- ⚡ Angels had seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph) off Paddack...went 6-for-7 with a double and a home run on those swings.

QUICK DRAW: Paddack is currently riding a career-long three-game winning streak...in fact, his win on April 22 was the first start of a 12-game winning streak the Twins carried until May 4, as Paddack's three wins during the streak led all Twins pitchers...during Paddack's personal winning streak, he has posted a 2.00 ERA, the ninth best in the AL since that date (minimum of 15.0 innings pitched).

LONG TIME, NO SEA: Has made four career starts vs. Seattle, most recently May 21, 2021...has gone 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (24.0 IP, 7 ER), six walks and 25 strikeouts...three of the four outings were quality starts...threw 7.0 shutout innings vs. Seattle on April 24, 2019 in his fifth career start...faced Seattle twice in the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season, when his Padres only faced western division opponents...six active Mariners hitters have faced Paddack, combining to hit .191 (4-for-21) with three strikeouts.

HAPPY HOME: Has made three starts each at home and on the road this season...has gone 2-0 at home with a 1.02 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and 21 strikeouts, compared to 1-1 on the road with a 9.42 ERA (14.1 IP, 15 ER), four walks and six strikeouts...has allowed 0.51 home-runs-per-9.0-innings at home, compared to 2.51 on the road...both of his quality starts have come at Target Field...here are some more home-road splits for Paddack this season:

PLATOON SPLITS: On May 3, Boston's left-handed hitters went 1-for-11 with a double, a walk and three strikeouts, while its righties went 1-for-9 with three strikeouts...through six games vs. Paddack, left-handed hitters have hit .343 (23-for-67) with an .840 OPS and 13.5 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .258 (17-for-66) with a .719 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚡ Facing right-handed pitching this season, Seattle has hit .221 (193-for-875) with a .663 OPS and (20th in baseball) and 28.9 percent strikeout rate.

THE ARSENAL: Has thrown a four-pitch mix through six starts, per Baseball Savant...here are his pitch usage and results thus far in 2024:

- ⚡ May 3 vs. Boston, threw a career-high 29 sliders...Red Sox hitters went 1-for-6 with two strikeouts against the pitch...was his first career start in which the 4-seamer wasn't his most-used pitch.
- ⚡ Boston swung at 12 4-seamers and whiffed six times (50%)...the pitch has a career-high 24.3 percent whiff rate this season (excl. 2023).
- ⚡ Hasn't allowed a home run on his 4-seamer since September 5, 2021 vs. Houston (HRs by Carlos Correa and Yuli Gurriel).

IN CONTROL: Ranks in baseball's 86th percentile this season with a 4.9 percent walk rate...has issued two-or-fewer walks in 35-straight appearances (32 starts); last three-walk outing came April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona...has issued 1.8 walks-per-9.0-innings in his career (2019-present), the ninth lowest in baseball during that span (min. 350.0 IP); tonight's opponent George Kirby ranks first with 1.1 walks-per-9.0 innings.

MAY POWERS: Has a 2.98 career ERA (60.1 IP, 20 ER), .217 opponent batting average and 6.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio in May, his best numbers of any month (excl. March)...numbers compare to a career 4.21 ERA (92.0 IP, 43 ER), .252 BAA and 3.82 K/BB in April.

2023 NOTES:

- ⚡ Signed three-year contract extension on January 18.
- ⚡ On 60-day Injured List from February 23 to September 24, rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in May 2022.
- ⚡ Allowed four earned runs in 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts in three-game rehab assignment.
- ⚡ Returned September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL...exited the bullpen and as he was approaching the infield dirt, umpires called for the tarp...didn't return after 50-minute rain delay.
- ⚡ Made official return to major league mound on September 25 vs. Oakland...first major league appearance in 507 days...threw fastest pitch of career, a 99 mph four-seam fastball to Zack Gelof in the top of the sixth inning.
- ⚡ Included on American League Wild Card Series roster but didn't appear in two-game sweep of Toronto.
- ⚡ Made relief appearances in Games 1 and 4 of American League Division Series vs. Houston, allowing one baserunner and striking out six in 3.2 total innings...both no-decisions in Twins losses.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (3-2, 4.30 ERA // CAREER: 42-41, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale vs. Seattle...last pitched May 4 vs. Boston, earning his second-straight win and third of the season in Minnesota's 3-1 victory...allowed one run on five hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and eight strikeouts, recording his third quality start of 2024...owns a 3.03 ERA (29.2 IP, 10 ER) in five daytime starts this season, compared to a 9.00 ERA (8.0 IP, 8 ER) in two night starts...has made two career starts vs. Seattle, both in 2023; went 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER), three home runs allowed, three walks and 15 strikeouts.
