TSince April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (13-2), ahead of the Dodgers (12-2) and
玉 Twins have gone 7-2 in their last nine home games after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight at Target Field.
THINGS UNRAVEL LATE ON TWINS: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of $10-6$, suffering just their second loss in their last 16 days...elght of the 10 runs allowed by Twins pitchers came arter the sixth inning...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one
walk and seven strikeouts...Jay Jackson, Steven Okert and Jorge Alcala combined to allow eight runs on seven hits and four aiks in 3.0 inings i rei e... shot in the third inning, while Kepler doubled twice.

JOSHIN' AROUND: The Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala to Triple-A St. Paul...Alcala, who was recalled by Minnesota on Friday, appeared in two games during his
most recent stint, allowing four runs on six hits in 2.2 innings pitched, with three walks and one strikeout....ver eight appearances with the Twins this season overall, he has gone 1-1, 3.27 ERA (11.0 $1 \mathrm{P}, 4 \mathrm{ER}$ ), six walks and 10 strikeouts...to replace Alcala on the 26 -man roster,
the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Josh Staumont from St. Paul...Staumont, who was signed by the winns on December 2, began the season on Minnesota, 1 , 15 -day Injured List with a left calf strain ...he was reinstated on April 19 and optioned to St. Paul, where he
appeared in five games ffom Aprin $20-\mathrm{May} 5$, going $0-1,2.5 \mathrm{ERA}(7.0 \mathrm{P}, 2 \mathrm{ER}$ ), two walks, 1 strikeouts and a 200 opponent batting average..the 30 -year-old appeared in 21 games
