TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: As a team, the Mats are batting .286/.348/.460 against left-handed pitchers this year...Their . 286 average is fourth in the major leagues, while their . 460 SLG ranks third...This compares to a .227/.321/.346 slashline against nighties.

HEY BABY: Harrison Bader has safely hit in nine of his last 11 games...Bader is batting 13-40 (.325) over that span with eight runs, one double, one home run, five RBI, two walks, three steals with a . 372 OBP.

SWING AND NO MISS: Mets batters have struck out 132 times this year... That is the fewest in the major leagues...Overall, the team has posted an 19.0 strikeout percentage, which is tied for fourth in the majors and tied for second in the National League...Francisco Lindor ranks ninth in the majors, striking out only $10.6 \%$ of the time, while Jeff McNeil places 10th at $10.8 \%$.

WHAT A MIGHTY GOOD MANAEA: In his first career start with the Mets, April 1 vs. Detroit, Manaea did not allow a hit through his first 5.2 innings...It was the longest no-hit bid by a Mets pitcher in their team debut and the secondlongest no-hit bid by a Mets pitcher in their first career start with team...Tracy Stallard threw 6.0 no-hit in his first career start with the Mets on June 2, 1963 vs. Pittsburgh after making 13 relief appearances to begin his career with New York...He joined Kenny Rogers (7/28/99) as the only Mets pitcher to allow one hit and throw 6.0 or more innings in their team debut.... He recorded eight strikeouts, which tied Johan Santana (3/31/08) for the most punch outs by a Mets lefthanded pitcher in their team debut and were tied for the seventh-most by any Mets pitcher int their team debut....Credit Elias.
SUCCESSFUL SEAN: In his first two starts as a Met, Manaea allowed one run over 11.0 innings....He joined Harry Parker, Masato Yoshii, Dillon Gee and Chris Bassitt as the only starters in franchise history to allow one or zero runs through their first two career starts with the Mets....Manaea allowed only four hits in his first two start with the club, tied with Rick Reed, Bruce Chen and Kazuhisa Ishii for the fewest hits allowed by a Met in their first two games with the club (Min. 10.0 IP).... His 14 strikeouts are tied with Bassitt, Steven Matz and Kodai Senga for the fifth-most in franchise history by a pitcher through in their first two games with the club...Only Pedro Martínez (21), Aaron Harang (18), Matt Harvey (18) and Pedro Astacio (16) had more strikeouts through their first two games as a Met.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Appeared in 37 games ( 10 starts) with the San Francisco Giants...Made his first start of the season vs. Kansas City on Aprill 8 and allowed one run over 6.0 innings while tallying eight strikeouts...Was a starter in six of his first eight games of the season before becoming a full-time reliever on May 16...Tied a season-high eight strikeouts in just 3.2 innings of relief on May 22 at Minnesota... Became the first MLB left-hander to throw at least 80 pitches and strike out eight+ batters in a scoreless relief outing since Randy Johnson struck out 16 in 7.0 innings on July 19, 2001...Courtesy of OptaSTATS... Did not allow a home run in a 53.2 inning stretch from May 22 through his first inning of work on August 21at Philadelphia...Rejoined the rotation on September 12 and started his final four games of the season, going 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (6 ER/24.0 IP)...Pitched to a 2.61ERA ( $15 \mathrm{ER} / 51.2 \mathrm{IP}$ ), the third-best mark in the NL and ninth-best in the majors (Min. 50.0 IP).

SWEEPIN SAMOAN: At the end of May 2023, Manaea introduced a sweeper to his arsenal... Last season,the pitch generated a 35.1 percent whiff rate and kept batters to a .140 average and .163 slugging percentage...The southpaw allowed just six hits (five singles and a double) in 49 plate appearances ending with the offering...Through his first three starts of the 2024 season, opposing batters are 1-5 with four strikeouts in at-bats ending with the pitch.

SUPERB SOUTHPAW: Since his debut season, 2016, Manaea ranks in the top10 among left-handed pitchers in several categories including innings (1017.1, seventh), wins ( 66, ninth) and strikeouts (943, eighth)...In 2021, Manaea was tied for the AL lead with 32 games started and ranked eight in the AL with a careerhigh 194 strikeouts...In 2018, Manaea ranked sixth in the AL in WHIP with a 1.08 clip (Min. 150.0 IP).

NO HITS FOR YOU: On April 20, 2018, Manaea threw a no-hiitter against the Red Sox in Oakland...The southpaw walked two and struck out 10 ....It was the 12th no-hitter in Athletics history and the first since Dallas Braden's perfect game on May 9, 2010 vs. Oakland....According to Elias, the Red Sox . 895 winning percentage entering the game was the highest in major league history by a team that was no-hit at least five games into the season.

- Became the first Met to reach the 30+ stolen base mark since Eric Young Jr. (30 in 2014).

- Is batting . 306 (15-49) with a 358 OBP over his last 11 games.
- Went 2-4 with a run, a walk and two stolen bases on April 6 vs. Cincinnati...Was his 40 th career game with multiple stolen bases, the third-most such games in the majors since 2012.
- Lined a solo home run in his first at-bat of the season on March 29 vs . Milwaukee...Has homered in each of his three home openers as a Met
- Appeared in 86 games, his fewest since 2017 when he played in 77 contests...Only appeared in four games after the All-Star Game, including his final contest on August 5....Was on the IL from July 20-August 4 with migraines and again from August 7 (retroactive to August 6) - end of season with a right groins strain
