THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

MAY 18, 2024:

The Giants downed the visiting Rockies 14-4 at home behind a six-RBI day by **Luis Matos**...it marked the second straight game of 5+ RBI for Matos, making him just the fourth player in franchise history with back-to-back games of 5+ RBI (since RBI became an official stat in 1920).

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants won yesterday's rubber match in West Sacramento with a 10-1 win over the host Athletics...SF has won six of its last 10 games.

- ▶ SF is 8-7 (.533) in series openers this season.
- ▶ The Giants are 6-4 in road games in the state of California (Padres, Dodgers, A's) compared to 4-11 vs. all out-of-state hosts (Orioles, Reds, Nationals, Phillies, Rays).

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP **Robbie Ray** returns to Chase Field to take on his former team...the southpaw pitched six seasons for the Diamondbacks (2015-2020), going 47-46 with a 4.11 ERA and 998 strikeouts in 147 starts.

- ▶ Ray has made one start at Chase Field as an opponent (July 3, 2025 with SF), earning the win in a complete game with two runs allowed on three hits (two homers) while striking out seven.
- ▶ The lefty received the loss in his last start, allowing four runs (three earned) on two homers while striking out two over 4.2 innings at Dodger Stadium on May 13.
- ▶ Ray heavily relies on his four-seam fastball (47.5% usage rate) and slider (28.7% usage rate)...the Diamondbacks have a .793 OPS vs. four-seamers (ninth in MLB) and a .537 OPS vs. sliders (29th in MLB) this season.

AZ LIVIN': Tonight's series opener is the first game between the Giants and Diamondbacks this season...SF went 6-7 vs. Arizona in 2025, 3-4 here at Chase Field.

- ▶ Arizona starter Zac Gallen has an 81.5% contact rate against him this year (11th highest in MLB, min. 40.0ip)...the Giants have a 76.1% contact rate, seventh-highest in MLB.
- ▶ Notable matchups vs. Gallen include **IF Willy Adames** (3-for-27, .111, two homers), **IF Luis Arraez** (6-for-18, .333), **IF Matt Chapman** (1-for-15, .067) and **IF Casey Schmitt** (4-for-7, .571, one homer).

LOOK AT LUIS: **IF Luis Arraez** reached base 11 times in this past series vs. the A's (eight hits and three walks)...he is batting .371 (23x62) with 10 runs, six doubles, two homers, seven RBI and a .999 OPS over his last 15 games.

- ▶ The last Giant to reach base 11+ times in a three-game series was **OF Heliot Ramos** (11 times) from June 3-5, 2024 at Arizona.
- ▶ The last Giants left-handed hitter to reach base 11+ in a three-game series was **Joe Panik** (12 times) from September 4-6, 2017 at Colorado.
- ▶ Arraez has 57 hits through his first 44 games with the Giants...the last Giants batter to have as many hits through his first 44 games of a season was **Marco Scutaro** with 58 hits through 44 games to start the 2013 season.

HOMER HAPPY: Both **IF Luis Arraez** and **OF Harrison Bader** homered in yesterday's win...SF has now homered at least once in 12 of its last 13 games (dating to the first game of the last homestand on May 4 vs. San Diego).

- ▶ In this 13-game span, SF has 59 runs (4.5 per game), 24 doubles, two triples, 18 home runs and a .425 slugging percentage with nine different Giants logging a homer.
- ▶ Bader, whose homer yesterday was a grand slam, became the first Giants leadoff batter to hit a grand slam since **Andrés Torres** did so on May 30, 2011 at St. Louis (**Darin Ruf** had one as a pinch hitter in the first spot of the lineup on July 21, 2022 at LAD).

HEATING UP: The SF offense had 10+ hits in all three games this past weekend.

- ▶ SF's eight runs scored in the top of the 8th yesterday were its most since scoring nine runs in the 11th inning at Chicago-NL on May 6, 2025...the +9 run differential was the Giants' largest win margin since August 31, 2025 vs. Baltimore (+11).
- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** is slashing .328/.386/.574 with 10 runs, six doubles, three homers, nine RBI and a .959 OPS over his last 17 games...**IF Willy Adames** is slashing .389/.405/.472 with three doubles and seven RBI over his last eight games.

DEFENSE: The Giants' infield has a combined +4 outs above average in 2026 (10th in MLB).

- ▶ SF's 50 double plays turned this season are most in MLB (second is St. Louis with 48).
- ▶ Per *Sports Info Solutions*, the Giants are best in the Majors at turning ground balls and bunts into outs (78%)...in their two wins vs. the A's, 20 of 23 ground balls and bunts were converted into outs.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Suffered the loss in his last start against the Dodgers on May 13...only lasted 4.2 innings and allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits (two homers) and struck out a season-low two batters...LA batters were 5-for-10 with a double and two homers off his fastball.

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received one or zero runs of support in six of his nine outings...despite his 3.04 ERA, the Giants are just 4-5 over his nine starts...his 2.50 run support average is the fourth-lowest figure in the Majors and the lowest he's received in his career.

AGAINST THE DIAMONDBACKS: Played for the Diamondbacks from 2015-2020 and posted a 48-47 record with a 4.13 ERA over 152 career games...has faced Arizona just three times in his career, all of which came last season, and posted a 3-0 record with a 3.15 ERA (7er, 20.0ip) and a 0.95 WHIP...has made just one appearance against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field and tossed a complete game, allowing two runs on three hits with seven strikeouts in the Giants 7-2 victory over Arizona on July 3, 2025.

HOME VS. ROAD: Has pitched better in his five starts at home, going 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA and a .190 opponents average, compared to a 0-4 record with a 4.50 ERA in four starts on the road...has allowed just two runs over his last 17.2 innings at Oracle Park, covering his last three appearances...SF has won each of his last four starts at home and dropped all four of his starts on the road...last season Ray posted virtually equally stats at home vs. the road.

LEFT ON READ: Has held lefties to a .167 average (6-for-36) so far this year, however, left-handers are 5-for-13 (.385) with two doubles over his last three starts...lefties were just 4-for-28 (.200) with no extra base hits off him to start the year.

STARTING STRONG: Has pitched at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in eight of his nine starts this season...he threw just 4.2 innings in his last start against the Dodgers and allowed a season-high four runs.

RUNNERS ON: Opponents are hitting .364 off him with no one on base and no one out, compared to a .143 average with runners on base...opponents are just 6-for-30 (.200) off him with runners in scoring position and have just one hit in 14 at-bats (.071) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

- ▶ Allowed four runs on six hits and two walks while striking out seven across 5.1 innings at Dodger Stadium his last time out on May 14.
- ▶ Is slated to make his fourth career appearance (second start) vs. the Diamondbacks...has a 4.66 ERA (5er, 9.2ip), 10 strikeouts and a 1.76 WHIP over three games.
- ▶ Has been excellent on the road this season, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA (9er, 27.2ip) and 30 strikeouts over five starts.
- ▶ Struck out 27 batters with his curveball this season with opponents batting .207 (12x58) with a 36.0% whiff rate.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/15 at ATH; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has now allowed a run over his last three games (4.1ip).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 17 appearances (4.41 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) in his last 11 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-33 (.152) with four walks and nine strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (72-for-402) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-28 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 1.0ip, bb, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ In his last six outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (5er, 8.1ip) and .313 BAA (10x32)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 10.1 scoreless innings in eight appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 15 contests (5.49 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-44 (.295) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; SV, 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first career save on Saturday with 1.0 perfect inning.
- ▶ Gage's 23 appearances this year are tied for second-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered four runs (three ER) in 19.1ip this year (1.40 ERA).
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA is the eighth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.9% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ His 14.1% walk rate is in the bottom 10% of MLB (11 BBs in 19.1ip).
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has made four appearances with SF, logging 3.1-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and three walks with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is returning to the Majors for the first time since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, h, r, er, hr (9 pitches)

- ▶ Last 6 games: 6.0ip, 5h, 4r, 3er, 2hr, 5bb, 1bb, 5k (4.50 ERA)...had a 0.64 ERA (1er, 14.0ip) with a .111 BAA and 16 K's in 13 games prior.
- ▶ Owns a 25.6% strikeout rate and .147 BAA (10x68) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.40 BB/9ip...his 14.6% BB rate ranks in the bottom 8% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-40 (.125) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 5-for-28 (.179) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, 2r, 2er, 2bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on Saturday after missing 14 games with a low back strain...pitched in two rehab games (May 10 and 13), striking out three over 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Had not allowed a run in his last eight appearances prior to injury dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (8.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0er, 4bb, 13k).
- ▶ Right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) off him with two doubles.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 57.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the second-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 6.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in six games so far.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 43.6% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
