**THE TWINS:** After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2 (2-1 vs. Texas and 3-1 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a win over the Astros in Houston last night...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three at Minute Maid Park...after tomorrow afternoon's game, they will travel to New York for an off-day on Monday, then play the Yankees for three games from Tuesday-Thursday...after New York, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games next weekend.   
 ☞ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 25-12, tied with New York-AL (25-12) for the second-best record in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (26-10).  
 ☞ After a seven-game losing streak from May 14-20, the Twins have gone 8-2 since May 21.

**HOUSTON, WE HAVE A GOATEE:** The Twins beat the Astros last night by a score of 6-1 at Minute Maid Park...Pablo López (5-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Steven Okert (1.0 IP) and Cole Sands (1.0) relieved López as the three combined to retire the final 15 Astros hitters faced...the offense recorded just six hits and walked four times...Trevor Larnach drove in two runs with a two-run homer in the fifth inning, his fifth homer of the season...Carlos Santana also homered, hitting his eighth of the season in the eighth inning.

**SPACEBALLS:** After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 5-2 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023...in that span, they have outscored the 'Stros 35-26...the Twins are 40-44 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 29-35 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.   
 ☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with seven walks, a .531 on-base percentage and a .923 OPS in nine career regular season games vs. Houston.  
 ☞ Former Astro Christian Vázquez is hitting .315 (34-for-108) with 19 RBI and an .804 OPS in 34 career regular season games vs. Houston...the .315 batting average is his highest against any AL opponent.

**TRAVELERS INSURANCE:** After starting the season 5-7 in their first 12 games away from Target Field, the Twins have gone 11-5 in their last 16 road games...over the 16-game stretch, the Twins have scored 6.1 runs-per-game (91 runs) and hit 21 home runs.   
 ☞ Carlos Correa has reached safely in 12 straight road games, posting a .380 on-base percentage, a .535 slugging percentage and a .915 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .361 (22-for-61) with six doubles, three triples, one home run, a .418 on-base percentage, a .607 slugging percentage and a 1.024 OPS in his last 16 road games

**MIRANDA WATCH!** Over his last 29 games, dating back to April 25, Jose Miranda is hitting .300 (30-for-100) with seven doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .330 on-base percentage, a .490 slugging percentage and an .820 OPS.

**DON'T STOP RELIEVIN':** Over the last 10 games, the Twins bullpen has gone 3-0, 1.59 ERA (34.0 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks, 30 strikeouts, a .151 opponent batting average, 11 holds and six saves in six opportunities...their .151 opponent batting average, .218 slugging percentage, .211 on-base percentage and .198 wOBA all lead baseball in that span.

**SOUTHPAW STUFF:** Twins hitters are slashing .265/.312/.432 with a .743 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .221/.303/.385 with a .688 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...the .265 average vs. lefties ranks fourth among AL teams and seventh in all of baseball.   
 ☞ Since April 24, the Twins are hitting .288 vs. lefties, the highest in baseball since that date.  
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with a .994 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 19 games, he is 19-for-38 (.500) with a 1.223 OPS vs. lefties.  
 ☞ The Twins last faced Framber Valdez in Game 2 of the ALDS at Minute Maid Park, their only win of the series...they scored five runs on seven hits and walked three times off the lefty; Correa went 2-for-2 with a double and a walk, while Kyle Farmer hit a two-run homer.

**TWINS TRY MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD) THE 'STROS:** The Twins have gone 10-6-2 in series play this season, going 5-4-0 at home and 5-2-2 on the road...a win today or tomorrow would give them their 10th series win in their last 11 tries...2024 series results to the right.   
 ☞ Twins are looking for their third consecutive regular season series win against the Astros...they have won three-straight series vs. Houston once: 2000, 2001 and 2006 in Interleague Play.

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis is currently on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...he DH'ed last night, going 0-for-4...through five rehab games, Lewis is 3-for-19 with one double, seven strikeouts and one stolen base...St. Paul plays at Rochester again tonight at 5:45 pm (CT)...Lewis sustained a right quad strain on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases.

**TWINS MILB MONTHLYS:** Double-A Wichita infielder Luke Keaschall and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher David Festa have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for May.   
 ☞ Keaschall, 21, played in 27 games between Wichita and High-A Cedar Rapids, slashing .375/.468/.596 (1.065 OPS) with eight doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 25 runs scored and six stolen bases...the Watsonville, CA native was selected by the Twins in the second round (49th overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Arizona State University...he is ranked as the club's ninth-best prospect, per MLB.com — second among infielders.  
 ☞ Festa, 24, went 1-1 with a 3.44 ERA (18.1 IP, 7 ER), seven walks 30 strikeouts, a .224 opponent batting average and a 1.20 WHIP in four starts for the Saints in May...the Verona, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University...he is ranked as the club's fifth-best prospect overall and top pitching prospect, per MLB.com.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched on May 27 against the Kansas City Royals...earned his fourth victory of the season and 30th of his career...improved to 6-0 vs. Kansas City, his most wins against any opponent in his career...allowed just one base runner in the first 5.0 innings before allowing three hits and a run – on a Vinnie Pasquantino single – in the sixth...allowed one run on four hits, no walks and nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings...generated 15 swings and misses on 49 swings (30.6%)...in his last two starts he is 2-0, 0.64 ERA (14.0 IP, 1 ER), seven hits, two walks and 15 strikeouts...lowered his season ERA from 3.15 to 2.96.

- ☞ Threw the hardest pitch of his career at 96.6 mph, a ball to Nelson Velázquez.
- ☞ Ranks fifth among all qualified pitchers with an 8.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio...also ranks third among all qualified pitchers by averaging 1.21 walks-per-9.0 innings.
- ☞ Is 3-1, 2.05 ERA (26.1 IP, 6 ER) with a .196 (19-for-97) opponent batting average in his last four starts, since May 10.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made his 10th start of the season on May 21 against the Nationals; earned his third win of the season, allowing three hits, two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings...matched his season high with 7.0 innings (also May 10 at Toronto)...collected his team-leading seventh quality start of the season.

- ☞ Last start of 7.0-or-more scoreless innings was on June 22, 2023, when he threw a complete-game shutout vs. Boston.
- ☞ Issued two walks for the first time since September 18, 2023 against the Reds.

**VS. HOUSTON:** Facing Houston Astros for the fourth time in his career during regular season...in the previous three regular season starts he is 1-2, 8.36 ERA (14.0 IP, 13 ER), nine walks, 19 strikeouts, a 1.43 WHIP and a .208 (11-for-53) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Started Game 4 of the 2023 ALDS vs. Houston allowing one run (HR - Brantley) on two hits with one strikeout in 2.0 innings of work...was followed by five relievers...Twins lost 3-2 and eliminated.
- ☞ His last regular season start against Houston came on May 30, 2023 at Minute Maid Park...took the loss, allowed five runs on four hits (2 HR), three walks and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings.
- ☞ His only win came on April 8, 2023 at Target Field when he allowed four runs on three hits (1 HR), one walk and 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings of a 9-6 Twins win,

**BACK ON THE ROAD:** Through five starts on the road in 2024, Ryan has gone 2-0 with a 1.44 ERA (31.1 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 33 strikeouts and two home runs compared to 2-3, 4.29 ERA (35.2 IP, 17 ER), four walks, 40 strikeouts and five home runs in six home starts.

- ☞ In 34 career road starts, he is 14-10, 4.00 ERA (186.2 IP, 83 ER), 169 hits, 43 walks and 195 strikeouts...Twins are 21-13 in Ryan's 34 road starts.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 14 road wins...behind him are Griffin Jax and Bailey Ober tied with (9).
- ☞ Has allowed seven home runs this year...two have come on the road.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .195/.237/.495 with six extra-base hits, including one home run, four walks and 38 strikeouts in 128 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .233/.261/.442 with nine doubles, six home runs, five walks and 35 strikeouts in 134 plate appearances.

- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .206 (149-for-725) with 28 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs and a .612 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .241 (191-for-794) with 48 doubles, no triples and, 42 home runs with a .742 OPS.
- ☞ In three regular season games vs. Ryan, Houston left-handed hitters have hit .133 (2-for-15) with one home run, four walks and five strikeouts with a .649 OPS...right-handed hitters have hit .237 (9-for-38) with one double, two home runs, five walks and 14 strikeouts with a .739 OPS.
- ☞ In his last start against Kansas City, right-handed hitters hit went 2-for-17 with no walks and 10 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 11 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 70.2 percent of the time in his last start against the Royals...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ In his last start four starts against Toronto, New York-AL, Washington and Kansas City, hitters have gone 2-for-30 vs. the split finger with seven strikeouts.
- ☞ In his last two starts against the Nationals and Kansas City, hitters went 0-for-22 vs. the 4-seam fastball with 13 strikeouts.
- ☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .200 (11-for-55) with three home runs and 19 strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball in 2024...left-handed hitters are hitting .167 (8-for-48) with two extra-base hits (2B, 3B) and 18 strikeouts.

**RUNNERS ON:** With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .267 (12-for-45) with two home runs, one walk and 12 strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .184 (32-for-174) with four home runs, six walks and 55 strikeouts.

**DAYTIME NUMBERS:** Making his seventh daytime start of the year...has gone 1-3 with a 3.28 ERA (35.2 IP, 13 ER) in his six daytime starts this season, compared to 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (31.1 IP, 9 ER) at night.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Enters today with 451 career strikeouts, 29th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Tyler Duffey in 28th place with 466.

**QUALITY STARTER:** Recorded six quality starts in his last seven starts...leads the Twins with eight quality starts this season...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 of his 11 starts.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 2-0, 2.70 ERA // CAREER: 2-1, 3.44 ERA)**

Right-handed pitcher and Texas native Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the series finale tomorrow afternoon against the Houston Astros...in his last start against the Kansas City Royals on May 28, he tossed 4.0 scoreless innings before giving up two runs in the fifth inning, Garrett Hampson singled, followed by a Kyle Isbel groundout to bring in the second run...allowed two runs on three hits, two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings, earning his second win of the season...is facing the Houston Astros for the first time in his career.
