RHP Keider Montero (9-7, 3.22 ERA) vs. RHP Braxton Ashcraft (12-5, 3.82 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have split the first four games of this six-game homestand vs. Boston (2-1, Friday-Sunday) and Detroit (0-1, Monday-Wednesday), including an 8-5 loss on Monday vs. the Tigers at PNC Park...Will embark on a nine-game, 11-day road trip to Los Angeles-NL (August 21-23), San Diego (August 24-26) and St. Louis (August 28-30) following Wednesday's game vs. Detroit (it will mark their longest road trip since another nine-game trip from July 4-13, 2025 to Seattle, Kansas City and Minnesota and their longest against National League teams since a nine-game trip from September 19-28, 2023 to Chicago, Cincinnati and Philadelphia)...Have hit 151 home runs (they hit 117 home runs all of last year)...Have the most hits (1122) in all of Major League Baseball...Have struck out the third-most batters (1179) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Philadelphia (1240) and Milwaukee (1211)...Have stolen the eighth-most bases (107) in all of Major League Baseball.

WE'VE GOT THE RUNS: Pittsburgh has scored the third-most runs (638) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Washington (670) and Chicago-NL (652), after scoring a Major League-low 583 runs last season...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, they would become one of four teams in Major League history to finish in the top three of the league in runs after finishing last in runs in the prior year, joining the 1891 Baltimore Orioles (third), the 1903 New York Giants (third) and the 1915 Chicago White Sox (second).

AMERICAN SPIRIT: Pittsburgh has won a record eight straight home series vs. American League teams (interleague play began in 1997)...The Pirates swept a three-game series from July 21-23, 2025 vs. Detroit, won two of three games from August 18-20, 2025 vs. Toronto, won two of three games last year from September 19-21 vs. the A's, swept a three-game series from April 3-5 vs. Baltimore, won two of three games from April 17-19 vs. Tampa Bay, swept a three-game series from May 29-31 vs. Minnesota, won two of three games from June 23-25 vs. Seattle and won two of three games from Friday-Sunday vs. Boston...Their .618 interleague winning percentage this year is fourth in MLB, trailing Los Angeles-NL (.644), Milwaukee (.641) & Cincinnati (.622).

SLICK NICK: Nick Yorke hit a three-run double (off Framber Valdez) in the sixth inning on Monday vs. Detroit...He has become the first Pittsburgh right-handed hitter with at least two hits and three RBI in back-to-back games (also Sunday vs. Boston) since Andrew McCutchen (two games, August 7-11, 2024)...Yorke is looking to become the 10th Pirate (11th instance) to post at least two hits and three RBI in at least three straight games (RBI official in 1920), the first since Ke'Bryan Hayes (three games, August 8-10, 2023)...He is 15-for-54 (.278) with four doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and an .846 OPS in 15 career interleague games.

LOWE OR NEVER: Brandon Lowe went 2-for-4 on Monday vs. Detroit, extending his hitting streak to six straight games (since August 12 at Miami)...He is 8-for-26 (.308) with five RBI during the streak...Lowe is batting .311 (28-for-90) with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and an .869 OPS over his last 22 contests (since July 26 vs. Chicago-NL)...Lowe's average during that stretch is the second-highest in Major League Baseball (minimum 90 at-bats), trailing only Boston's Ceddanne Rafaela (.326, 30-for-92).

FROM THE ASHES: Braxton Ashcraft's 12 wins this season are tied for the seventh-most in all of Major League Baseball...His seven wins in his last 10 starts (since June 17 at the A's) are tied for the second-most across all of MLB.

GOOD AS GONZO: Nick Gonzales doubled, walked twice and scored a run on Monday vs. Detroit...His .308 average (138-for-448) ranks fifth in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Houston's Yordan Alvarez (.321), Philadelphia's Luis Arraez (.314), Miami's Otto Lopez (.310) and Tampa Bay's Chandler Simpson (.309)...He is hitting .324 (100-for-309) against righties this season.

SO(To) GOOD: Gregory Soto, who pitched 204.2 innings over his 186 appearances (seven starts) with Detroit from 2019-22, struck out three batters in a scoreless eighth inning on Monday vs. the Tigers...He has a 2.04 ERA (17.2ip/4er) and 23 strikeouts in his last 17 appearances (since July 2 at Philadelphia)...Soto is one of only two National League relievers with a sub-2.05 ERA (minimum 17.2 innings pitched) and at least 23 strikeouts during that stretch, along with San Diego's Adrian Morejon (1.57 ERA, 29 strikeouts).

August 18, 2022: Bryan Reynolds recorded his third career multi-home run game, leading Pittsburgh to an 8-2 win over Boston at PNC Park. Each of his homers were two-run blasts off the Red Sox' Josh Winckowski, the latter of which was home run No. 3000 in stadium history. JT Brubaker earned the win after allowing two hits and one hit-by-pitch while striking out seven batters in 7.0 scoreless innings.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2018 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Ashcraft pitched his first career complete game during Pittsburgh’s 13-1 victory on August 13 at Miami...It was the first complete game by a Pirate since Paul Skenes (8.0 innings) on May 18, 2025 at Philadelphia, the first 9.0-inning complete game since Mitch Keller on May 6, 2024 vs. Los Angeles (AL) and the first 9.0-inning road complete game since Johan Oviedo on August 28, 2023 at Kansas City.

GO THE DISTANCE: Ashcraft’s 85-pitch complete game on August 13 at Miami marked the third 9.0-inning complete game on 85 or fewer pitches by a Pirate (since pitch counts began being tracked in 1988)...It was also accomplished by Doug Drabek (80 pitches, September 30, 1990 at St. Louis) and Jeff Karstens (83 pitches, July 15, 2011 at Houston)...Ashcraft became the first Major League pitcher (since 1988) to throw a 9.0-inning complete game on 85 or fewer pitches while striking out at least 10 batters.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Ashcraft tossed a scoreless seventh inning during his only career appearance against Detroit, which came in Pittsburgh’s 3-0 victory on July 21, 2025 at PNC Park...He struck out Dillon Dingler to begin the seventh inning that night.

LEADING THE WAY: Ashcraft has a team-high 12 wins this season...The last Pirate with more than 12 wins in a season was Mitch Keller (13 wins) in 2023...Pittsburgh has not had a pitcher with at least 12 wins and a sub-4.00 ERA in a season since Trevor Williams (14 wins/3.11 ERA) and Jameson Taillon (14 wins/3.20 ERA) did that in 2018.

HEY NOW: Ashcraft was named to his first career All-Star team this season, joining Paul Skenes as Pittsburgh’s representatives (he replaced Skenes on the roster)...Skenes (130) and Ashcraft (128) became just the second pair of Pirates teammates to both have at least 115 strikeouts prior to the All-Star break in a single season (the first All-Star Game was held in 1933), joining Francisco Liriano (125) and Gerrit Cole (116) in 2015...They were also only the third pair of Pittsburgh starters to be named to the All-Star team in the same season, along with Bob Friend and Vernon Law (1960), as well as A.J. Burnett and Cole (2015)...Ashcraft’s 128 strikeouts prior to the All-Star break were the sixth-most in Pirates history, behind Bob Veale (137) in 1965, Veale (134) in 1966, Skenes (131) in 2025, Skenes (130) this year and teammate Mitch Keller (129) in 2023.

TWICE AS NICE: Ashcraft has made multiple starts where he recorded at least 10 strikeouts and did not issue a walk...He struck out 11 batters on May 31 vs. Minnesota and 10 batters on June 24 vs. Seattle...Ashcraft became the only Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to post multiple such starts during a single season.

MR. CONSISTENT: Ashcraft pitched at least 6.0 innings, struck out at least five batters and walked two or fewer batters in six consecutive starts from May 3-May 31...He became one of five Pirates (six instances) during the Modern Era (since 1901) to do that, joining Rick Reuschel (six starts, September 4-October 1, 1985), Jon Lieber (six starts, June 15-July 13, 1998), Gerrit Cole (six starts, April 14-May 11, 2017 and six starts, July 30-August 26, 2017) and Paul Skenes (seven starts, June 11-July 23, 2024).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Ashcraft did not allow a first-inning run in any of his first 20 Major League starts (from last year on June 23 at Milwaukee to May 31 vs. Minnesota)...The streak was snapped on June 6 at Atlanta (allowed two runs in the first inning)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he was one of three Major League pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to allow zero first-inning runs in at least each of his first 20 career starts, along with Rollie Sheldon (20, 1961) & Dennis Rasmussen (22, 1983-84).
