TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **John Blake's Rangers** and the opening game of Cin's first road trip of 2026, a 7-game jaunt that includes an upcoming 4-game set at **loanDepot park** vs the **Marlins** (Mon-Thu).

- The Reds opened the season with 3-3 homestand vs the **Red Sox** (2-1) and **Pirates** (1-2).
- Following Thu's game at **Mia**, the Redlegs will return to **Great American Ball Park** for a 6-game homestand vs the **Angels** and **Giants**.

LODOLO REAGGRAVATES BLISTER: LHP **Nick Lodolo** (15-day IL, blister on left index finger) was removed from his rehabilitation start yesterday with **A-Daytona** due to the recurrence of a blister on his left index finger...before leaving the game vs **Jupiter**, **Lodolo** retired all 8 batters he faced (4k, 40TP).

WILD WEST: The Reds have won 34 of their last 61 games vs **AL West** opponents dating back to 2017 (.557).

3-4-5: Reds' 3,4,5 batters have combined to slash .304/.400/.623 in the first 6 games of the 2026 season (21-for-69, 6 HR 13 RBI, 32 times on base).

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **1b Sal Stewart** on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 3/25-3/29...He's the 10th Reds rookie to win NL Player of the Week honors since the award's inception in 1973 (last: **Rece Hinds**, 7/8-7/14, 2024).

- Stewart** is the fifth Red to win the award in the season's first week (others: **Kal Daniels** 1988, **Eddie Milner** 1984, **Johnny Bench** 1983, **Dave Collins** 1980).
- In the 3 games vs **Bos**, he went 7-for-10 with a home run, 3 doubles, 3 walks, and 5 hard-hit balls (exit velo of +95mph).

OUR PAL SAL: **1b Sal Stewart** has hit safely in 5 of his first 6 games and reached base in all 6 (9-for-19, .474/.615/.947, 2 HR, 18 TB)...he's been on base 16 times, which ranks T2nd in the majors.

- Stewart** is the first Reds batter to reach 16 times in any 6-game span since **Gavin Lux** did it last year and **Tyler Stephenson** and **Jonathan India** both accomplished the feat in 2024.

SERIES NOTES:

- Cin is 14-14 all-time vs **Tex**, including 10-7 at **GABP**...the 2024 series in **Arlington** marked Cin's first ever trip to **Globe Life Field**.
- Tex** took 2 out of 3 in last year's series, including back-to-back 1-0 wins at **GABP** on 4/1 & 4/2...it was the first time since 1907 that the Reds lost consecutive games by a 1-0 score (6/2-6/3g1).
- In the 1-0 **Rangers'** win on 4/2/25, **RHP Nathan Eovaldi** produced the series' first-ever complete game (9ip, 4h, 0r, 0bb, 8k, 99TP).
- Cin's 14-3 win on 3/31/25 marked the largest margin of victory by either team in this all-time series.
- In 2023, the Reds swept **Tex** in a 3-game series from 4/24-4/26 at **GABP**, only the second sweep by either team in series history (also: 2004 at Cin, 3-0 Reds).

SPRING RECAP: The **Reds** finished 2026 Spring Training action with a 14-17 record, going 9-6 at Goodyear Ballpark (including when **Cin** was the "away" team vs **Cle**) and 5-11 on the road...the overall record reflects the 2 exhibition games the Reds lost vs the **Brewers** in Milwaukee on 3/23 and 3/24.

- Reds** batters concluded their spring schedule ranked among Major League leaders in extra-base hits (129, 1st), average exit velocity (91.6 mph), home runs (55, T1st), total bases (535, 2nd), slugging pct (.499, 2nd), hard-hit balls (237, 2nd), and runs scored (182, 6th).
- The **Reds'** 55 home runs were their most in a single Spring Training season since 2006 (as far back as ST data is available), surpassing the previous best of 44 set by the 2024 club.
- Cin** earned its 200th win all-time in Cactus League action with a 3-2 victory on 2/25 at **CWS**.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Terry Francona** returns for his second season after guiding the 2025 Reds to their first Postseason berth since 2020 and their first during a full season since 2013...his 83-79 Reds were the 12th Postseason club he has managed in the majors.

- Francona** finished as the runner-up to **Mil's Pat Murphy** for the **2025 National League Manager of the Year Award**.
- He became the fifth skipper in Reds history to lead the team to the Postseason in his first year at the helm, joining **Lou Piniella** (1990), **John McNamara** (1979), **Sparky Anderson** (1970), & **Patrick Moran** (1919).
- Francona** became the 12th manager in Major League history to lead 3 or more teams to the Postseason (Cin, **Cle**, **Bos**).
- His 2,035 career wins as a Major League manager lead all active skippers and rank 12th in Major League history.

...AND HIS CREW: New members of the Reds coaching staff in 2026 include third-base coach **Willie Harris**, catching coach **Bill Haselman**, and bullpen coach **Oscar Marin**.

- Returning to the coaching staff for the 2026 season are bench coach/field coordinator **Freddie Benavides** (13th season on the Major League staff), director of pitching/pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (8th), bullpen catcher **José Duarte** (8th), coach/coordinator of advance scouting **Kyle Arnsberg** (5th), first-base coach **Collin Cowgill** (4th), assistant pitching coach **Matt Tracy** (1st in current role, 4th on staff), director of hitting/Major League hitting coach **Chris Valaika** (2nd), assistant hitting coaches **Alex Peláez** and **Will Remillard** (2nd for each), assistant bench coach **Mike Napoli** (1st in current role, 2nd on staff), & bullpen catcher **James Keller** (2nd).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in Sat's 11-inning 6-5 win vs Bos (4.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 74 TP).

- Left the game after 4 innings with the Reds leading 4-3.
- Was originally slated to start the season's third game but was moved up in the rotation when Nick Lodolo was placed on the injured list.

2026 SPRING TRAINING: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 5 spring starts (16.2ip, 11r/10er, 8bb, 12k, 292 TP).

- In his final Spring Training start on 3/23 vs the Brewers in Milwaukee, allowed 6 runs (5er) on 6 hits over 4.0 innings (1bb, 3k, 1hr, 78TP).
- Exited his second-to-last spring appearance after 51 pitches due to a blister on his right finger (3/18 vs Col).

2025 RECAP: In his first season with the Reds, led the staff with 32 starts, 14 wins, 169.2 innings pitched, and 15 quality starts...produced a quality start in a career-high 6 straight outings from 8/12 to 9/12.

- His 14 wins were a career high and tied for the fourth-most in the National League...were the most wins by a Reds pitcher since Luis Castillo won 15 games in 2019.
- Over his final 12 starts (7/27-9/28), pitched to a 7-4 record with a 2.81 ERA.
- Received votes for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award for the second consecutive season.

ACQUIRED: From the Royals on 11/22/24 in exchange for INF Jonathan India and OF Joey Wiemer.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor in the decision in Sun's 3-2 win vs Bos (5.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 86 TP)...was his first Major League appearance since 9/28/24, a span of 547 days.

- Missed the entire 2025 regular season due to injuries (R forearm strain & L oblique strain).
- Had his career-opening 33.2-inning homerless streak snapped after allowing a 2-run HR to Willyer Abreu in the 4th inning...marked the longest streak by a Reds pitcher to begin his career since Tom Browning (55.1ip, 1984-85).
- Became the seventh Reds pitcher since 1893 to allow 6 hits or fewer in each of his first 7 career starts, the first since Tony Cingrani did so in each of his first 24 Major League starts from 2013014.

STILL A ROOKIE: Still meets rookie qualifications despite entering the season with over a year of service time (1.031).

SPRING RECAP: Went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 5 Spring Training appearances (15.0ip, 17h, 10r/6er, 6bb, 18k, 0hr).

- Made his final spring appearance in the 4-1 exhibition loss
