**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Colorado and 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL), the Twins began a six-game homestand with a 2-1 series loss to the Nationals over the weekend, winning game one on Friday night, followed by consecutive losses on Saturday and Sunday...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Red Sox through Wednesday afternoon.

**MINNESOTA ON MINNESOTA CRIME:** The Twins lost to the Nationals and Bloomington native Jake Irvin yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-2, dropping the three-game series, making them 14-18-2 in series play in 2025...Cole Sands was the opener, allowing one run on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched...Travis Adams (1-1) was the bulk pitcher, allowing five runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, led by Harrison Bader, who went 2-for-3 with a single and a double...Matt Wallner added a home run, his 12th of the season and fourth in his last 14 games.

**TONK IN:** The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin from Triple-A St. Paul...Tonkin appeared in 18 games for the Saints this season, going 2-0, 4.82 ERA (28.0 IP, 15 ER), seven walks, 34 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP...six of his last seven appearances for the Saints have been scoreless, posting a 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER) with 12 strikeouts since July 1...the 35-year-old pitched in 57 games for the Twins and Yankees in 2024, combining to go 4-4, 3.63 ERA (79.1 IP, 32 ER), two saves, 30 walks and 85 strikeouts.  
✦ To make room for Tonkin on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams to St. Paul...Adams made one appearance during his most recent stint with Minnesota, allowing five runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts while taking the loss yesterday afternoon vs. the Nationals.  
✦ To make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Connor Gillispie for release or assignment...Gillispie, who was claimed off waivers from the Miami Marlins on June 23, appeared in four games (3 starts) for the Saints.

**LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER:** The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of six games in 2025...these two teams last met for three games at Fenway Park from May 2-4 as the Twins lost game one and won games two and three...those two wins were the first two of the 13-game winning streak that went until May 17.

✦ Twins last hosted the Sox for three games May 3-5, 2024 as the Twins won the series two games to one.  
✦ Twins have gone 7-4 in their last 11 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.  
✦ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with one home run, nine RBI and a .742 OPS in his last 10 games against the Red Sox.  
✦ Carlos Correa has posted an .843 OPS in 61 career regular season games vs. the Red Sox... additionally, in those 61, he has a .380 on-base percentage, a .463 slugging percentage, 11 home runs and 32 RBI.  
✦ Ty France has 15 career doubles in 30 games against the Red Sox, his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16).  
✦ Christian Vázquez is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with three walks and a .417 on-base percentage in his last six games vs. the Red Sox.  
✦ Notable offensive numbers during the May series at Fenway: Ryan Jeffers went 5-for-12 (.417) with a double and a home run...Harrison Bader went 4-for-10 (.400) with a double... Byron Buxton went 5-for-13 (.385) with a home run...Christian Vázquez went 2-for-6 (.333) with two walks.

**ROYCE MAKING NOISE:** Royce Lewis is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, an .885 slugging percentage and a 1.313 OPS in his last seven games... below are his season comparisons in a few categories:

**PARDON MY FRENCH:** Ty France has six hits in his last 12 at-bats over his last four games... also during that span, he has three doubles, two RBI, one hit-by-pitch, three walks, a .625 on-base percentage, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.375 OPS.  
✦ France leads the team in games played with 98.

**CARLOS COR-RAKING:** Over his last nine games, Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, eight walks, a .450 on-base percentage and an .856 OPS.  
✦ He has drawn eight walks since the All-Star break, tied for second-most in baseball (with 4 others)...the leader is Matt Olson (9).

**ROSS, DRESS FOR LESS:** Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Michael Ross has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...Ross, 23, made the start on Saturday vs. Lakeland, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...the Winter Haven, Florida native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Samford University in Homewood, Alabama.

**REHAB UPDATE:** Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) remains on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...the Saints have the day off today but will play in Toledo tomorrow night at 6:05 pm (CT)...Keaschall has played in eight games on rehab assignment over the last week-plus, going 7-for-32 with five walks.

#### THIS AND THAT:

✦ Twins batters have grounded into 13 double plays since the All-Star break, the most in baseball.  
✦ Twins fielders have committed just three errors since the All-Star break (9 games), tied for seventh-fewest in baseball.  
✦ Matt Wallner has four home runs in his last 14 games...he has 12 homers on the season, two short of his career-high of 14 (2023).  
✦ Kody Clemens has 12 RBI in 13 games this month, which leads the team.  
✦ On this day in 2024, Target Field hosted the Foo Fighters' "Everything or Nothing at All Tour," drawing 41,029 in attendance.  
✦ Tonight, the Twins are celebrating St. Paul Saints Night...fans who purchased this theme night package received a ticket to the game and an exclusive T.C. Bear and Mudonna bobblehead, presented by CHS...additionally, Mudonna and the Saints' squad of ushertainers will be on hand to engage with fans throughout tonight's game.
