THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Colorado and 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL), the Twins began a six-game homestand with a 2-1 series loss to the Nationals over the weekend, winning game one on Friday night, followed by consecutive losses on Saturday and Sunday...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Red Sox through Wednesday afternoon.

MINNESOTA ON MINNESOTA CRIME: The Twins lost to the Nationals and Bloomington native Jake Irvin yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-2, dropping the three-game series, making them 14-18-2 in series play in 2025...Cole Sands was the opener, allowing one run on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched...Travis Adams (1-1) was the bulk pitcher, allowing five runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, led by Harrison Bader, who went 2-for-3 with a single and a double...Matt Wallner added a home run, his 12th of the season and fourth in his last 14 games.

TONK IN: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin from Triple-A St. Paul...Tonkin appeared in 18 games for the Saints this season, going 2-0, 4.82 ERA (28.0 IP, 15 ER), seven walks, 34 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP...six of his last seven appearances for the Saints have been scoreless, posting a 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER) with 12 strikeouts since July 1...the 35-year-old pitched in 57 games for the Twins and Yankees in 2024, combining to go 4-4, 3.63 ERA (79.1 IP, 32 ER), two saves, 30 walks and 85 strikeouts. ◆ To make room for Tonkin on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams to St. Paul...Adams made one appearance during his most recent stint with Minnesota, allowing five runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts while taking the loss yesterday afternoon vs. the Nationals.

◆ To make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Connor Gillispie for release or assignment...Gillispie, who was claimed off waivers from the Miami Marlins on June 23, appeared in four games (3 starts) for the Saints.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of six games in 2025... these two teams last met for three games at Fenway Park from May 2-4 as the Twins lost game one and won games two and three...those two wins were the first two of the 13-game winning streak that went until May 17.

◆ Twins last hosted the Sox for three games May 3-5, 2024 as the Twins won the series two games to one.

◆ Iwins have gone 7-4 in their last 11 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.

◆ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with one home run, nine RBI and a .742 OPS in his last 10 games against the Red Sox.

◆ Carlos Correa has posted an .843 OPS in 61 career regular season games vs. the Red Sox... additionally, in those 61, he has a .380 on-base percentage, a .463 slugging percentage, 11 home runs and 32 RBI.

◆ Ty France has 15 career doubles in 30 games against the Red Sox, his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16).

◆ Christian Vazquez is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with three walks and a .417 on-base percentage in his last six games vs. the Red Sox.

◆ Notable offensive numbers during the May series at Fenway: Ryan Jeffers went 5-for-12 (.417) with a double and a home run...Harrison Bader went 4-for-10 (.400) with a double... Bryon Buxton went 5-for-13 (.385) with a home run...Christian Vazquez went 2-for-6 (.333) with two walks.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, an .885 slugging percentage and a 1.313 OPS in his last seven games... below are his season comparisons in a few categories:

ROSS, DRESS FOR LESS: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Michael Ross has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...Ross, 23, made the start on Saturday vs. Lakeland, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...the Winter Haven, Florida native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Samford University in Homewood, Alabama.

REHAB UPDATE: Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) remains on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...the Saints have the day off today but will play in Toledo tomorrow night at 6:05 pm (CT)...Keaschall has played in eight games on rehab assignment over the last week-plus, going 7-for-32 with five walks.

CAN'T DODGE THIS: Last pitched on July 22 at Los-Angeles-NL, opposite Yoshinobu Yamamoto... did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-7 victory; allowed three runs on two hits, with a career-high-tying five walks and two strikeouts in 3.0 innings...all three runs allowed came on a home run from Andy Pages in the fourth inning...Woods Richardson was subsequently pulled and replaced by reliever Danny Coulombe.

- ◆ Marked his shortest outing since his final appearance of the 2024 season on September 25 when he pitched just one inning vs. Miami.
- ♣ Had a career-low single-game strike percentage of 48.3, following his previous start on July 13 where he had a career-high single-game strike percentage of 74.0.

CAN'T DODGE THIS: Pitched on July 13 vs. Pittsburgh, opposite Mitch Keller...did not factor into the decsion of Minnesota's 1-2 defeat; allowed one run on six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings...sole run permitted was a solo homer to Tommy Pham in the second; just Sim's second home run allowed in seven games since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 10.

GONNA KNOCK YOUR SOX OFF: Woods Richardson is facing the Boston Red Sox for the first time in his career..this is his 26th new opponent of his career, and sixth new opponent faced this season (also, Baltimore, Los Angeles-AL, Milwaukee, Chicago-NL and Los Angeles-NL)...he is 2-1 in those five starts.

OUR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 5-4 with a 4.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 49 ER), 8.31 K/9, 3.32 BB/9 and 1.00 HR/9 in 22 games (21 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.46 ERA (111.0 IP, 55 ER), 7.22 K/9, 3.73 BB/9 and 1.38 HR/9 in 24 road games (23 starts).

◆ He is 4-2 in eight starts at home so far this season with a 3.12 ERA (40.1 IP, 14 ER) with four home runs, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts; compared to 1-2, 5.30 ERA (35.2 IP, 21 ER), seven home runs, 21 walks and 31 strikeouts in eight appearances (7 starts) on the road.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 16 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed 277/.351/.431 in 130 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .222/.303/.380 in 158 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 34.6 compared to righties' 91.5 mph and 46.3 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his phaggain against left handed batters, here is a left at his pitch broaddown.
