Daytime Drake

Drake Baldwin will hit leadoff and catch for Atlanta this afternoon, and enters play batting .349/.424/.640 in 22 day games this season.

His 1.064 OPS in the daytime is the best among qualified batters in baseball.

Baldwin enters play with a six-game hitting streak in day games dating to July 5 vs. the Mets, during which he has batted .520/.586/1.000 with four homers and 10 RBI across 29 total plate appearances. He has not struck out during this stretch, and has reached base 17 total times.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Orioles today conclude a three-game weekend series with what are the only scheduled games between the two teams this year...The two are meeting for the sixth time in the last seven seasons, and for the fourth consecutive year.

 The clubs have split the first two games of this series after the Orioles walked off with a win, 3-2, last night.

 Baltimore swept all three games against Atlanta last season at Truist Park, and the Braves were just 1-5 versus the Orioles from 2024-2025...That was Atlanta's worst record versus any American League club in that span.

 Atlanta dropped two-of-three in its last visit here to Oriole Park at Camden Yards in 2024, but is 14-12 (.539) in 26 total games played in this park...The Braves have, however, dropped four of their last five series here dating to 2009, with a three-game sweep in 2021 standing as the only series win.

 Atlanta and Baltimore have played 59 total games since the advent of interleague play in 1997 and have nearly split them down the middle, with Baltimore holding a one-game advantage, 30-29.

 RH Reynaldo López has made three starts and 10 total appearances against Baltimore in his career, and enters play and even 2-2 but with a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP) all-time versus the club...The 6-foot-1, 225-pound right-hander last faced them on June 13, 2024 here at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to earn the win.

 RH Shane Baz is set to make the 75th start of his career this afternoon, but his first against Atlanta... The 6-foot-3, 200-pound Houston native has pitched against just three members of the Braves active roster in his career, with Mauricio Dubón (1-for-7), Joey Bart (1-for-5) and Jorge Mateo (0-for-2) combining to go 2-for-14 against him.

ONE-RUN GAMES: Atlanta and Baltimore have seen each of the first two games of this series decided by just a single tally, with the Braves winning, 7-6, in 10 innings on Friday before Baltimore walked off, 3-2, in the ninth last night.

 The Braves have seen each of their last four games decided by one run dating to their series against the Padres, and six of Atlanta's nine total games since the All-Star break have been one-run affairs.

 Atlanta has played 30 one-run games on the season, and split them evenly at 15-15...The club's 30 such games are tied for ninth most in baseball, while its .500 winning percentage is tied for 14th.

 Atlanta started out 8-5 in its first 13 games decided by a single run, dropped eight of its next 10 such games, and then has rebounded by winning five of its next seven...Last night's loss snapped a streak of four straight wins in one-run affairs.

RUBBER GAMES: The Braves are set to play their 16th rubber game of the season this afternoon, and enter play 10-5 (.667) in series-deciding contests on the year.

 Only the Washington Nationals, at 12-5 (.706), have more wins or a better winning percentage in such games this season.

 Atlanta has won each of its last two rubber games, beating Texas, 8-5, last Sunday and Pittsburgh, 10-5, on July 9.

THE SERIES AT LARGE: Atlanta is looking to secure its 23rd series victory of the season this afternoon, which would tie the Los Angeles Dodgers for the most in MLB...Milwaukee can also secure its 23rd series victory with a win over Colorado today.

 The Braves have won each of their two series since the All-Star break, and look to remain undefeated in post-break series play this afternoon.

 Atlanta has already surpassed its series win total from all of last season, doing so with a series-clinching win over the Padres on Thursday.

 The Braves are looking for their first series win over the Orioles since 2023, and their first victory in a set here in Baltimore since a three-game sweep in 2021.

 Atlanta is 17-14 (.548) in day games this season, including wins in four of its last five such games.

OZZIE ALBIES: Knotted last night's game at 2-2 in the eighth inning after sending an 0-1 pitch out to right field for his 17th homer of the season...The drive was his third homer in his last six games - three of his last seven hits have left the stadium.

 Just two primary second basemen in baseball - Brandon Lowe (21) and Ketel Marte (18) - have more homers this season.

 Albies in on pace for 26 homers on the season, in what would be his first 20-homer season since hitting 33 in 2023...By hitting three more homers this season, he would become just the 14th second baseman in baseball history with at least five seasons of at least 20 homers.

LOTTA GAMES: Opposing first basemen Matt Olson and Pete Alonso enter play this afternoon with consecutive games played streaks of 886 and 521 games, respectively...They mark the two longest active games played streaks in baseball.

 Per Elias and with credit to Orioles PR, their matchups this weekend marked the first time two players with active games played streaks of at least 500 games opposed each other since April 23, 2006, when Baltimore's Miguel Tejada (938) faced New York-AL's Hideki Matsui (504).

 Olson's streak stands as the ninth longest in baseball history...He is currently nine games shy of matching Stan Musial (895) for eighth in baseball annals.

Today's Game

⚡ Makes his 11th start of the season and the 134th of his career, in the finale of a three-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...Atlanta is 6-4 in his 10 turns.

⚡ Makes his fourth career start and 11th career appearance against Baltimore, and his first outing against the Orioles since June 13, 2024...Is 2-2 with a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP) in those 10 appearances.

⚡ Has not been charged with a run in either of his last two starts against Baltimore, both here at Oriole Park at Camden Yards - 6.0 innings for Atlanta on June 13, 2024, and 7.0 innings for Chicago (AL) on September 15, 2018... Both were quality starts, and he earned the win in each.

⚡ Has made five career appearances at Camden Yards, all against the Orioles, going 2-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) and 17 strikeouts in 17.1 innings...All three of his career starts against Baltimore have come in this ballpark, as have both of his career wins over the club.

⚡ Makes his first day start of the season...Each of his nine daytime outings in 2026 has come in relief, and he has worked to a 0.59 ERA (1 ER/15.1 IP) with a .167 opponents' average (9-for-54) in those appearances.

⚡ Returned to the rotation June 26 at San Francisco after 13 consecutive relief appearances from April 29 through June 21...Worked to a 3.27 ERA (8 ER/22.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts across those 13 outings.

⚡ Is 1-2 with a 4.84 ERA (12 ER/22.1 IP) in five starts since rejoining the rotation... Allowed one earned run in each of the first three of those turns, a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), before surrendering four July 11 at St. Louis and five July 21 against San Diego.

⚡ Opponents are batting .378 (17-for-45) against him in the first inning, where he has been charged with nine of his 29 earned runs...From the second inning on, they are hitting .217 (45-for-207) with a 3.21 ERA (20 ER/56.0 IP).

⚡ All of his first-inning work this season has come in his 10 starts...From the second inning on in those turns, he has pitched to a 3.18 ERA (12 ER/34.0 IP) with 33 strikeouts.

⚡ Owns a 2.70 ERA (62 ER/206.2 IP) since the start of the 2024 season, the seventh-lowest mark among 149 major league pitchers with at least 35 starts over that span... Chris Sale ranks second at 2.39, giving Atlanta two of the top seven.

⚡ Has held opponents to a .091 average (7-for-77) on pitches out of the strike zone and .180 (24-for-133) in two-strike counts.

⚡ Batters are hitting .152 (5-for-33) against his curveball with five strikeouts... They have hit .208 (15-for-72) against his slider and .287 (41-for-143) against his four-seam fastball.

⚡ Opponents are hitting .243 (35-for-144) against him with the bases empty and .250 (27-for-108) with men on...Twenty-two of the 29 earned runs he has allowed have scored with a runner aboard, a 6.60 ERA (22 ER/30.0 IP) in those situations against a 1.75 mark (7 ER/36.0 IP) with the bases empty.

⚡ Took the loss July 21 against San Diego, allowing five runs on nine hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 4.1 innings in an 8-3 defeat at Truist Park.

⚡ The nine hits, five runs and two home runs were each season highs...The three walks tied a season high, set April 21 at Washington.

⚡ Threw his slider a season-high 44.7 percent of the time July 21, well above his 31.0 percent usage rate for the season...Allowed no hits on the pitch and recorded four of his six strikeouts with it.

⚡ Earned the win July 1 against St. Louis, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts in a 5-1 victory...Tossed 4.0 hitless innings after the first, and the win was his first in a starting assignment since April 2 at Arizona.

⚡ Moved to the bullpen in late April after five starts to open the season and made 13 relief appearances before returning to the rotation June 26 at San Francisco.

Career Recap

⚡ **Awards:** NL All-Star (2024).

⚡ Has pitched for five organizations - Washington, Chicago (AL), Cleveland, Los Angeles (AL) and Atlanta - beginning his career in the rotation before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021...Signed by the Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

⚡ In his first season with Atlanta in 2024, earned his first career All-Star selection, going 8-5 with a 1.99 ERA (30 ER/135.2 IP) over 26 games (25 starts)...His 1.99 ERA was the lowest in the majors among pitchers with at least 25 starts.

⚡ His 2.00 ERA as a starter was the lowest by a pitcher in his first stint with the franchise in the Live Ball era (min. 25 starts) and the fourth-lowest in baseball since 1920 for a pitcher with 25-or-more starts to open a stint with a new team after debuting elsewhere, trailing only Hall-of-Famer Gaylord Perry (Cleveland, 1972), Roger Clemens (Toronto, 1997) and Kevin Brown (Florida, 1996).

⚡ His 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP) through 13 starts was the lowest by a Brave over that span since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine (1.57) in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are the only Atlanta-era (since 1966) starters with lower ERAs through 13 starts.

⚡ Made just one start in 2025, April 1 at San Diego, before undergoing arthroscopic right shoulder surgery on April 8 that ended his season.
