BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles conclude a season-long 10-game homestand this afternoon against the Blue Jays...Baltimore is 6-3 through nine games against Detroit (2-1), Tampa Bay (3-0), and Toronto (1-2)...Following tomorrow's off day, Baltimore begins a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, including a road trip through Boston and Toronto (each 3 G) before returning home with sets against Seattle (4 G) and San Diego (3 G).

⚾ Yesterday's 6-5 win marked the seventh win in franchise history (since 1954) in which the Orioles trailed by 4+ runs through eight innings and went on to earn a victory...The last such win came on June 7, 2017 vs. Pittsburgh...The Birds scored four runs in the ninth inning that game to tie the score, 6-6, before Trey Mancini hit a walk-off three-run home run in the 11th frame.

⚾ According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Orioles became the first team whose final eight batters of a game reached base safely via hit, walk, or hit by pitch since the Twins against the Orioles on September 11, 1966 (also last 8).

⚾ **Pete Alonso** registered his 10th career walk-off plate appearance, including his first since a walk-off home run on September 14, 2025 vs. Texas...Since making his MLB debut in 2019, his 10 walk-off plate appearances lead MLB, ahead of Alex Verdugo (9).

⚾ The Birds drew a season-high 11 walks, their most since July 27, 2005 vs. Texas (11 BB), and their most in a nine-inning game since September 4, 2002 vs. Texas (11 BB).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** drew three walks in a game for the fourth time this season, tying ATH's Nick Kurtz and LAA's Mike Trout for the MLB lead...It marks the most such performances by an Oriole in a single season since Mark Reynolds (4 G) in 2012...Entering 2026, Ward had three or more walks in eight of 704 career games.

BRADISH ON THE BUMP: Over his last four starts since May 8, **Kyle Bradish** has posted a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) and .172 opponent average (15-for-87) after registering a 5.03 ERA (19 ER/34.0 IP) and .304 (41-for-135) opponent average over his first seven starts of the season.

⚾ During the recent four-start stretch, he has limited the opposition to a .043 (1-for-23) average on his curveball and a .095 (2-for-21) clip on his four-seam fastball...Through his first seven starts, opponents hit .478 (11-for-23) on his four-seamer and .273 (6-for-22) off his curveball.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .354/.394/.626 (35-for-99) with seven doubles, one triple, six homers, 16 runs scored, 20 RBI, and eight walks in 31 games since April 20...Among players with at least 100 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in OPS (2nd, 1.021), batting average (3rd), and slugging percentage (5th).

⚾ Basallo ranks among all qualified MLB rookies in slugging percentage (2nd, .506), OPS (3rd, .841), home runs (T-4th, 9), triples (T-5th, 1), batting average (6th, .276), extra-base hits (T-6th, 17), total bases (8th, 79), RBI (9th, 24), and hits (10th, 43).

ADLEY AND THE JAYS: **Adley Rutschman** has slashed .308/.386/.564 (65-for-211) with 15 doubles, 13 home runs, and 41 RBI in 53 career games against the Blue Jays...His .950 OPS is the second highest by an Oriole all-time against Toronto (min. 150 PA) behind Harold Baines (1.071).

⚾ Overall, Rutschman has drawn 11 walks against six strikeouts over his last 11 games since May 18 after having zero walks and nine strikeouts over his previous seven games from May 9-16.

START ME UP: Orioles starters have produced a 2.66 ERA (18 ER/61.0 IP) over the last 11 games since May 19, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB during that period behind the Mariners (2.11), Yankees (2.24), and Phillies (2.34).

⚾ O's starting pitching produced a 5.24 ERA through May 18, the second-worst clip in the majors during that time ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Birds are 9-4 in their last 13 home games since May 10...Baltimore opened the season 9-11 at home.

⚾ The Orioles' .747 OPS at home ranks eighth highest in the majors, while their .670 OPS on the road ranks 22nd in MLB.

⚾ Birds pitching owns a 3.75 ERA at Camden Yards, compared to a 5.86 ERA on the road...The 3.75 home ERA ranks 16th in MLB, while the 5.86 road ERA is the highest in the majors ahead of the Twins (5.41).

⚾ In 27 home games, Colton Cowser in batting .288 (17-for-59) with two doubles, two home runs, and 10 RBI, compared to .125 (6-for-48) with one double, one homer, and four RBI across 22 road games.

BLAZING THE TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .350/.381/.500 (21-for-60) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, six runs scored, 13 RBI, three walks (1 IBB), and three stolen bases in 24 games in May after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

⚾ His May batting average ranks second in MLB (min. 60 AB) behind TB's Jonathan Aranda (.379).

⚾ Alexander tallied a career-high six RBI on Wednesday night against Tampa Bay...He's the second Oriole this year with a six-RBI game (Rutschman, 4/24 vs. BOS) after no Orioles had a game of 6+ RBI in 2025.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (2nd, 53), on-base percentage (5th, .404), times on base (5th, 107), doubles (T-6th, 15).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,161 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,170)...He has seen 410 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, third in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (426) and CWS' Munetaka Murakami (420).

TWO OUT FOCUS: Baltimore pitching has held the opposition to a .194 batting average (19-for-98) with two outs over the last nine games since May 22...Prior to that stretch, opponents were batting .261 to begin the season...Overall, the Birds' .252 opponent average with two outs is fourth-highest in the majors ahead of the Angels (.266), Royals (.257), and Rockies (.253).

JAYS FLY SOUTH: Baltimore and Toronto are meeting this weekend for the first of four series this season (13 total G)...The clubs are in the midst of seven games in 11 days with the Orioles traveling to Rogers Centre from June 5-7...The O's and Jays will not meet again until September 11-13 in Canada and September 21-23 at Oriole Park.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 12th start of the season and 79th of his career today in the series finale vs. Toronto...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor in the decision after allowing one run on five hits (1 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts across 6.0 innings pitched...Has allowed no more than two runs in at least three straight starts for the first time since doing so in eight straight games from June 8, 2024-September 28, 2025...Threw 92 pitches, 59 strikes.
 ⚾ Owns a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), .172 (15-for-87) opponent average, and 0.99 WHIP over his last four starts compared to a 5.03 ERA (19 ER/34.0 IP), .304 (41-for-135) opponent average, and 1.82 WHIP over his first seven outings.

THE JAYS: Bradish has made eight career starts opposite Toronto, going 1-3 with a 5.18 ERA (23 ER/40.0 IP)...Is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (6 ER/18.0 IP) over his last three starts vs. the Blue Jays from June 14, 2023-May 15, 2024 after going 0-2 with a 6.95 ERA (17 ER/22.0 IP) in five starts against the club during his rookie season in 2022.
 ⚾ Holds a 6-15 record and 5.09 ERA (100 ER/176.2 IP) over 36 career starts against the AL East.

ABOVE THE CURVE: He deploys his curveball 22.7 percent of the time, holding opponents to a .156 (7-for-45) clip on the offering...Among all MLB starters, the .156 opponent average off the curveball is third lowest (min. 45 AB ending in pitch) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (.071) and PIT's Braxton Ashcraft (.111)...Bradish's 44.0 percent whiff rate on his curve is the best mark (min. 45 AB) in the majors this season ahead of Arrighetti (43.9%) and Ashcraft (39.1%).
 ⚾ Over his last six starts since April 26, Bradish has limited the opposition to a .067 (2-for-30) mark on his curveball.

SLIDE AWAY: Opponents have gone 16-for-60 (.267) off Bradish's slider with three doubles, two triples and four home runs...His .583 opponent slugging percentage off the offering is the highest mark in MLB (min. 50 AB ending in pitch), with the next closest pitchers being DET's Jack Flaherty (.571) and STL's Matthew Liberatore (.554)
 ⚾ Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025

DAY TRIPPER: Bradish's eight daytime starts this season are tied for the most in MLB with NYM's Freddy Peralta and TB's Drew Rasmussen...His 2.79 ERA (45 ER/145.1 IP) in 28 daytime starts since 2023 is the seventh-best mark in MLB during that span behind DET's Tarik Skubal (2.14), PIT's Paul Skenes (2.55), CHC's Justin Steele (2.64), BOS' Garrett Crochet (2.65), CIN's Hunter Greene (2.67), and CLE's Gavin Williams (2.77).
 ⚾ Has recorded a quality start in each of his last two daytime starts since May 13, allowing one run over 12.0 innings with a .146 (6-for-41) opponent average.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 52.4 percent first-pitch strike rate, the lowest mark in the majors (min. 50.0 IP), with the next closest pitchers being NYY's Max Fried and LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (both 52.9%).
 ⚾ In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish's 11.8 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the fifth-highest mark in the majors (min. 50.0 IP) behind PIT's Bubba Chandler (15.3%), CLE's Joey Cantillo (12.7%), KC's Kris Bubic (12.6%), and DET's Jack Flaherty (12.0%).

LAST TIME OUT: Baz earned his second victory of the season on May 26 vs. Tampa Bay after allowing one run on seven hits and two walks with nine strikeouts across 7.0 innings pitched...Has allowed three runs or fewer in four of his last six starts since April 28, including allowing one run in three of those starts...Threw 99 pitches, 69 pitches.

vs. BOSTON: Baz is 3-1 with a 2.64 ERA (9 ER/30.2 IP) over five career starts against the Red Sox, including a 1-1 mark with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP) in three career starts at Fenway Park...His 3.10 ERA (41 ER/119.0 IP) vs. the AL East is his best mark against any division, ahead of the AL West (3.81) and the NL West (4.09).
