LAST START: Made his second career start on 9/12 at NYY and did not factor in the decision after 5.0 innings of work, allowing one run on four hits and three walks with seven strikeouts...Became only the sixth pitcher since 1903 to start against the Yankees in both of his first two Major League appearances, and the first since TEX Brian Sikorski in 2000...Is only the fourth pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to toss at least 5.0 IP and allow one run-or-fewer in each of his first two career starts (last: Mike Wright in 2015).

LEFT AND RIGHT: Kremer did not allow a hit to a left-handed batter (0-for-13) in his first two appearances...Right-handers have hit .208 (5-for-24) with nine strikeouts against him.

DEBUT TO REMEMBER: Made his Major league debut on 9/6 vs. NYY... Became the fourth Oriole to make his Major League debut this year... Earned his first career win after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts... Struck out the first batter he faced, DJ LeMahieu (looking), for his first career strikeout... Threw a nine-pitch third inning with two punchouts... Retired 12-straight batters from the second to sixth innings... Became the fourth pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 6.0 innings while allowing one-or-fewer hits in his Major League debut (Chris Waters in 2008, Anthony Telford in 1990, and Bib Milacki in 1988)... Is the sixth pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least seven batters in his Major League debut... He is the ninth different starting pitcher that the Orioles have employed this season.

QUICK HITS: Was acquired by the Orioles along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for INF Manny Machado on 7/18/18... Was selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 draft out of UNLV.

PROSPECTING: Is the No. 10 Orioles prospect according to *MLB.com*... Entered the 2020 season ranked as the No. 8 O's prospect by *Baseball Prospectus*... Entered the 2019 season ranked as the No. 9 Orioles prospect, according to *Baseball America*.

PERSONAL: Attended the University of Nevada, Las Vegas... **Became the first Israeli citizen to be selected in the MLB draft**... Became the Pitched for Israel's National Team in the 2017 World Baseball Classic and was named Most Valuable Pitcher for Israel in 2014 and 2015 after he helped Israel qualify for the European Baseball Championship... **He has dual Israeli-American citizenship, and his parents served in the Israel Defense Force**... Helped San Joaquin Delta (NJCAA) to a 41-7 record and a state runner-up finish in 2015, going 13-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 112.2 innings.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Went a combined 9-6 with a 3.72 ERA (47 ER/113.2 IP) and 122 strikeouts in 21 starts across three different levels (Class A-Advanced Frederick, Double-A Bowie, and Triple-A Norfolk)... Received an invite to Spring Training as a non-roster invitee; did not make an appearance after suffering an oblique strain prior to camp starting... Won eight-straight decisions from 6/22-8/10, over a 10 start span with Double-A Bowie; went 8-0 with a 1.93 ERA (12 ER/56.0 IP) and 57 strikeouts during this stretch... Matched his career-high with 7.0-scoreless innings three different times during the season (6/11 vs. New Hampshire, 7/2 at Hartford, and 7/18 vs. Altoona)... Ranked among Orioles minor leaguers in wins (T-3rd, 9) and strikeouts (T-7th, 122)... Pitched in the Arizona Fall League for the Surprise Saguaros following the season; went 1-1 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER/19.0 IP) and 23 strikeouts in five starts (six appearances)... Named an Arizona Fall League Rising Star.

Zimmermann will become the fifth Oriole to make his Major League debut this season with his start in Game 2 of today's doubleheader vs. TB... The Baltimore native was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the fifth round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Mount Olive... Was acquired by the Orioles along with C Brett Cumberland, INF Jean Carlos Encarnación, and RHP Evan Phillips from the Atlanta Braves for RHP Kevin Gausman, RHP Darren O'Day, and International Signing Bonus Slots on July 31, 2018... In 2019, he split the season between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk, going a combined 7-6 with a 3.21 ERA (50 ER/140.0 IP) and 134 strikeouts in 24 starts (25 games).

QUICK HITS: Zimmermann will be making his Major League debut in Game 2 of the doubleheader...Will become the fifth Oriole to make his Major League debut this season...The Baltimore native was acquired by the Orioles along with C Brett Cumberland, INF Jean Encarnacion, and RHP Evan Phillips from the Atlanta Braves for RHP Kevin Gausman, RHP Darren O'Day, and International Signing Bonus Slots on 7/31/18... Was originally selected by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Mount Olive College (Mount Olive, NC).

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Split the season between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk, going a combined 7-6 with a 3.21 ERA (50 ER/140.0 IP) and 134 strikeouts in 24 starts (25 games)...Earned a promotion to Norfolk on 7/28, after posting a 2.58 ERA (29 ER/101.1 IP) in 17 starts (18 games) for Bowie...Finished the season ranking in the organization's top 10 in strikeouts (3rd - 134), games started (T-2nd - 24), complete games (T-1st - 2), shutouts (T-1st - 2), and innings pitched (2nd - 140.0)...Threw his first career shutout on 6/18 at Hartford, allowing just four hits while striking out nine batters; the 9.0 innings set a career-high...Tossed his second shutout of the season in his final start for Bowie on 7/22 at Richmond, tossing 7.0 innings and allowing just five hits.

PROSPECTING: Entered the 2020 season ranked as the No. 29 Orioles prospect by *MLB.com*...Finished the 2019 season as the No. 17 O's prospect, according to *Baseball America*.

PERSONAL: Spent his freshman and sophomore years of college at Towson University (MD) and transferred to Division II Mt. Olive College (NC) for his junior and senior years...Went 9-2 with a 3.18 ERA and 129 strikeouts as the Friday starter during his senior year at Mt. Olive; his 129 strikeouts tied the university's single-season record, originally set by former Major League pitcher Carter Capps...**Attended Loyola Blakefield High School (MD), where he was selected to play in the Brooks Robinson All-Star Game at Camden Yards**...Also played football in high school.

PROFESSIONAL CAREER: In 2018, spent the season with three different affiliates (Class-A Rome, Double-A Mississippi, and Double-A Bowie)...Combined to make 25 starts and posted a 11-7 record with a 3.21 ERA (48 ER/134.2 IP) and 141 strikeouts...Named a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star, while with Rome...Named SAL Pitcher of the Week on 5/20; 7.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 9 K, GS...Made 14 starts with Rome before being promoted to Mississippi on 6/28...Assigned to Double-A Bowie following the trade from Atlanta...Tossed his first career complete game on 8/12 at Hartford, a 5.0 inning outing in which he received the win...In 2017, spent his first professional season with Rookie Level Danville, making 11 starts for the Braves and posting a 3.09 ERA (8 ER/23.1 IP)...Struck out at least one batter in all 11 of his appearances.
