**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**MAY 8**  
**2004** - In a 5-4 loss at Atlanta, future Hall of Famer **Craig Biggio** has a memorable night. First, he leads off the game with a single for his 2,500th career hit. He later adds 2 solo HR in the game, ending up 3-for-5 with 2 RBI.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros and Reds will play the first game of a three-game series tonight at Great American Ball Park with first pitch scheduled for 5:10 p.m. CT...**RHP Mike Burrows**, who earned his first quality start of the season in his last start will be on the mound for the Astros tonight, opposite **LHP Nick Lodolo**, who is making his first start of the season and the Reds.

**TONIGHT'S ASTROS STARTER: RHP Mike Burrows** was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates...in his last start on May 1 vs. Boston, he allowed three runs on eight hits with one walk and three strikeout in six innings...marked his first quality of the season.

**VS. THE REDS:** The Astros have faced the Reds 857 times in their history, their most games played against any other Major League franchise, going 403-453-1 in the all-time series...the Astros went 2-1 against the Reds in 2025 at Daikin Park...Houston is looking for their first win in Cincinnati since a 5-1 victory at Great American Ball Park on Sept. 9, 2012.

**TONIGHT'S BROADCASTS:** Tonight's game and every game this road trip will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas**, **Steve Sparks** and **Julia Morales** on the call...the game will also air on SportsTalk 790 with **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder** behind the mic...lastly, the game will air in Spanish on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

**WEDNESDAY'S RECAP:** The Houston Astros were defeated by the Los Angeles Dodgers, 2-12 at Daikin Park on Wednesday afternoon...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2.2 IP, 4 H, 6 ER, 3 BB, 4 K) made the start for Houston...**2B Brice Matthews** (1x4, HR, RBI) hit his first career leadoff home run and **CF Zach Cole** went 1x3 with an RBI.

**LEAD OFF MAN: 2B Brice Matthews** went 1x4 with his first career leadoff home run on Wednesday vs. Los Angeles (NL)...it was also the first leadoff home run by an Astros player this season, last, was **SS Jeremy Peña** on Aug. 13, 2025 vs. BOS...it was also Matthews' second career game batting first in the order...Matthews has also reached base safely in a career-high eight consecutive starts, batting .323 (10x31) with five runs, one double, three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.017 OPS.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** The Astros have selected **RHP Logan VanWey** (#64) to the Major League roster...**RHP Jason Alexander** was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land following Wednesday's game...also **OF Dustin Harris** was outrighted to Triple A Sugar Land and subsequently elected free agency...Harris was designated for assignment on Tuesday, May 5.

**JOHNSON RE-SIGNED:** The Astros have re-signed **OF Daniel Johnson** to a minor league contract and assigned him to Triple A Sugar Land...Johnson appeared in eight games with the Astros this season before being designated for assignment on Monday, May 4.

**THE ORDER:** The Astros have used 38 different batting orders in their 38 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

**WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: Christian Walker** is hitting .379 (22x58) in his last 15 games (since April 20) with five homers and 11 RBI...for the season, Walker ranks fifth in the AL in SLG (.569), tied for sixth in RBI (27) and sixth in OPS (.950).

**CLIMBING THE CHARTS:** With 238 career homers as a second baseman, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...Altuve also needs two RBI to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 900.

**HIT PAREDES: IF Isaac Paredes** has hit safely in 13 of his last 16 games dating back to April 19, a span in which he's hitting .345 (20x58) with two doubles, three homers, nine RBI and a .950 OPS... additionally, he's reached base safely in 11 straight games, posting a .444 OBP in that span.

**PLAYER OF THE MONTH:** Announced on Monday, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for March/April for his third career AL Player of the Month Award...for the months of March and April, Alvarez batted .356 (42x118) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 27 RBI, 21 walks, 25 runs scored and a 1.199 OPS (.462 OBP/.737 SLG).

**ROAD WARRIOR:** In 14 road games (11 starts) this season, **IF/OF Brice Matthews** is batting .317 (13x41) with six runs, three doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks and a .945 OPS...in his young career, Matthews is hitting .292 (19x65) with six home runs, 20 RBI and a .997 OPS.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Single A Fayetteville defeated Wilson, 3-2 in seven innings...**RHP Javier Perez** was dominate in his outing, allowed two runs on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts in six innings...in the Carolina League, Perez ranks first in WHIP (0.88), second in innings (29.2), third in opponent batting average (.173) and tied for third in strikeouts (35).

**HARD TO HIT:** Opponents are just 15x82 (183) vs. **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, who is just the second Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history...among AL relievers, Teng ranks tied for fourth in innings (20.0), seventh in opponent batting average (.183) and 10th in WHIP (0.85).

**LAST START, May 1 at BOS:** Recorded his 1st quality start of the season, allowing 3 runs on 8 hits with 1 walk and 3 strikeouts through 6.0 innings (94 pitches-62 strikes)...was handed the losing decision in the Astros' 3-1 loss last Friday at Fenway Park...matched his single-game career high for innings, doing so for the 2nd time this season and 4th time in his career (last: April 13 at SEA).

**ABOUT BURROWS:** the 2nd-year starter is making his 8th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (37.2) and is tied with **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** in starts (7)...his 36 strikeouts on the year are also one away from matching McCullers Jr. for the team lead.

**SAVANT SAYS:** Among MLB pitchers, ranks in the 77th percentile in chase rate (33.3), the 75th percentile in hard-hit percentage (33.9) and the 73rd percentile in average exit velocity (87.6)...his average exit velocity of 87.6 mph ranks 16th-lowest overall among MLB pitchers (min. 100 batted-ball events).

**HIS REPERTOIRE:** has thrown his changeup at a 25.5% rate this year, throwing the pitch 162 times this season, compared to 166 four-seam fastballs (26.1%)...is holding opponents to a .205 (8x39) opponent average on the changeup this season...opponents are also hitting just .158 (3x19) vs. his curveball, which he's thrown at a 15.1% rate...his 162 total changeups thrown this season are the 12th-most among MLB pitchers.

**SPINNIN' IT:** Has averaged a spin rate of 2923 RPM this season, ranking in the 93rd percentile and 12th overall among MLB pitchers.

**STARTING PERFECT:** retired the first 14 batters he faced to open the game on April 19 vs. STL before allowing a 2-out single to **IF Masyn Winn** in the 5th inning...had 7 strikeouts in those first 14 batters faced.

**CONNECTICUT CONNECTION:** Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from Connecticut...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

**THE JOURNEY:** a native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

**THE TRADE:** after spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

**2025 RECAP:** pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

**LAST APPEARANCE (5/4 at LAD):** Allowed 1 hit and struck out 3 in 1.0 scoreless inning Tuesday night vs. LAD.

**FIRST W:** Earned his 1st win of the season on Sunday at BOS, allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season and his 2nd multi-inning scoreless effort of the year (also: 1.1 IP on April 15 vs. COL)...marked his longest scoreless outing since 2.0 scoreless innings on June 29, 2025 vs. CHC...was also his 1st winning decision since June 26, 2025 vs. PHI.

**ALL-TIME RANKINGS:** With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.0 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (330).

**DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS:** Is 2.0 innings from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 4 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

**CAREER:** In 330 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/3412P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.32 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
