PADDACK: After taking two of three in Toronto over the weekend, the Twins returned home and dropped the first two games of their three-game series/homestand with the Yankees the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale with New York...after today's game Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Guardians over the weekend, followed by three against the Nationals from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have won 17 of their last 22 games...since April 22, the Twins are tied with the Phillies (17-5) for the most wins in baseball.

☞ Twins are 9-4 in their last 13 at home after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight here.

☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing three consecutive games for the first time since dropping five-straight from April 14-19.

SERIES WIN STREAK STOPS AT SIX: The Twins were shut out by the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 4-0...Minnesota was shut out for just the second time this season, the other being March 31 at Kansas City...Pablo López (4-3) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on 10 hits in 6.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits and walked four times...Edouard Julien had the only extra-base hit for the Twins on the night, hitting his sixth double of the season.

I WANT TO SPEAK TO YOUR MANAGER: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (443-309) and Aaron Boone (438-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Kevin Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Aaron Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the third of six games in 2024...Minnesota will travel to the Bronx for a three-game series from June 4-6.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .291 (51-for-175) with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 34 RBI, a .577 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS in 46 career regular season games vs. New York...Correa's .577 slugging percentage against NY is the second-best among actives (minimum of 175 plate appearances), trailing only José Ramirez (.591)...his .933 OPS ranks fourth, trailing Ramirez (.992), Mike Trout (.979) and Francisco Lindor (.945).

SAVE THE NECK FOR ME, CLARKE. OK, EDDIE: Notable numbers vs. Clarke Schmidt: Jose Miranda is 1-for-2 with a double...Willi Castro is 1-for-2 with a double...Trevor Larnach is 1-for-1 with a double.

BUCK UPDATE: Byron Buxton went 0-for-3 last night for Triple-A St. Paul and played seven innings in centerfield...he is scheduled to make his second rehab start tonight with the Saints as they play Omaha at CHS Field at 6:37 pm (CT)...Buck has missed the club's last 12 games with right knee inflammation.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS: Among AL qualifiers, Joe Ryan ranks second in expected on-base percentage (.238), trailing only Tarik Skubal (.228)...additionally, he ranks third in expected wOBA (.257), sixth in expected batting average (.209) and 12th in expected slugging percentage (.358)...lastly, he ranks fourth in the AL in strikeouts-per-walk (8.83) and eighth in strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched (10.0).

KEPING UP WITH MAX: Max Kepler has hit safely in 16 consecutive games in which he has started (0-for-1 as pinch-hitter on Tuesday night)...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler is hitting .397 (27-for-68) with nine doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 17 RBI, a .447 on-base percentage and a 1.109 OPS in 21 games — Twins 16-5 in his games.

☞ Since June 30, 2023, Kepler is hitting .305 (108-for-354) with 26 doubles, two triples, 17 home runs, 60 RBI and a .905 OPS in 101 games...Twins are 63-38 in those 101 games.

THE LAST DANCE: The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the third time this season...the first sweep was in two games at Target Field by the Guardians April 4 and 6; the April 7th game was postponed due to rain, giving the Twins no chance to salvage the series finale...the second sweep was of three games in Baltimore from April 15-17.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept by the Yankees was in three games from August 19-21, 2021 at Yankee Stadium...the last time the Yankees swept in Minnesota was in four games from July 1-4, 2013.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept at home was in three games by Baltimore from July 7-9, 2023.

IN THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jason Kubel hit an eighth-inning grand slam off Mariano Rivera for a 6-3 win at new Yankee Stadium...Rivera had converted a record-tying 51-consecutive save opportunities at home and had not given up a grand slam since 2002; the runs were also the first he allowed that season.

HBD, BLACK JACK: Hall of Famer Jack Morris is celebrating his 69th birthday today...during his 18-year major league career, he pitched one game on his birthday, that coming in 1987, pitching a complete game over Cleveland at Tiger Stadium, allowing three runs on five hits with 11 strikeouts...he shares a birthday with Twins Radio Engineer Kyle Hammer (39), University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson (69), actress Megan Fox (38), pop singer Janet Jackson (58), actor Pierce Brosnan (71) and former Nirvana bassist Krist Novoselic (59).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his eighth start of the season on May 10 at Toronto; earned his second win on the year and first road win, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR) in a season-high 7.0 innings, with no walks and seven strikeouts...recorded his fourth consecutive quality start and a team-leading sixth...allowed a third-inning home run to Isiah Kiner-Falefa which was the only run he allowed...eighth time in his career he has gone 7.0-or-more innings and allowed one-or-fewer runs...lowered his career ERA by five points going from a 4.00 to a 3.95...has now tossed 6.0 innings in six of his eight starts this season.

- ☞ Per Baseball Savant, Isiah Kiner-Falefa's home run would have been a home run at 11 of 30 ballparks, but not Target Field.
- ☞ Ranks fourth in the American League in strikeout-to-walk ratio with 8.83.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second loss of the season on May 5 vs. Boston, allowing three runs on four hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...recorded his third-straight quality start and team-leading fifth of the season...was perfect through 3.0 innings before Jarren Duran's leadoff double in the fourth...allowed a Rob Refsnyder RBI double that drove in Boston's first run...allowed two more runs on Ceddanne Rafaela's fifth-inning home run...four of his five strikeouts came on 4-seam fastballs (three swinging, one looking); the pitch generated seven whiffs on 25 swings (28.0%).

HIGH EXPECTATIONS: Among AL qualifiers, Joe Ryan ranks second in expected on-base percentage (.238), trailing only Tarik Skubal (.228)...additionally, he ranks third in expected wOBA (.257), sixth in expected batting average (.209) and 12th in expected slugging percentage (.358)...lastly, he ranks fourth in the AL in strikeouts-per-walk (8.83) and eighth in strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched (10.0).

VS. NEW YORK-AL: Facing New York-AL for the fourth time in his career this afternoon...in the previous three starts he is 2-1, 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 6 ER), four walks, 20 strikeouts, 0.94 WHIP.
 ☞ Earned a win in his last start against the Yankees on April 25, 2023 at Target Field, allowing two runs (1 ER) on seven hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings; Twins won 6-2.
 ☞ Yankees hitters have hit .194 (7-for-67) with two home runs and a .523 OPS.

BACK AT HOME: Through four home starts in 2024, Ryan has tossed 23.1 innings going 1-2 with 20 hits allowed, three walks, 26 strikeouts and four home runs.
 ☞ In 36 career home starts, he is 15-11, 3.76 ERA (203.1 IP, 85 ER), 161 hits, 51 walks and 242 strikeouts...Twins are 20-16 in Ryan's 36 home starts.
 ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 15 home wins...behind him are Griffin Jax (11) and Caleb Thielbar (10).
 ☞ Has allowed six home runs this year...four have come at home.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .241/.283/.345 with six extra-base hits, including one home run, four walks and 26 strikeouts in 92 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .211/.227/.421 with five doubles, five home runs, two walks and 27 strikeouts in 97 plate appearances.
 ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .212 (146-for-689) with 28 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs and a .634 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .238 (181-for-760) with 44 doubles, no triples and, 41 home runs with a .737 OPS.
 ☞ In three game vs. Ryan, Yankees left-handed hitters have hit .194 (6-for-31), with one home run, one walk and strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .194 (7-for-36) one home run, three walks and 12 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in his eight starts this season, with six of his 10 sinkers coming in his last outing...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 75.0 percent of the time in his last start against the Blue Jays...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ In his last start against Toronto, hitters went 0-for-10 vs. the Split Finger with three strikeouts.
 ☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .214 (9-for-42) with two home runs and 12 strikeouts against the fastball in 2024.

RUNNERS ON: With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .313 (10-for-32) with two home runs, one walk and six strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .184 (23-for-125) with three home runs, four walks and 42 strikeouts.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DIAMOND: Making his fifth day start of the year...has gone 0-2, 3.09 ERA (23.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks, 29 strikeouts and a .202 (18-for-89) opponent batting average in his prior three outings...is 12-10, 3.12 ERA (161.2 IP, 56 ER), .206 BAA in 29 career day starts, compared to 16-11, 4.55 ERA (221.1 IP, 112 ER), .240 BAA in 40 career night starts.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Enters today with 431 career strikeouts, tied with Tom Hall for 30th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Mike Smithson in 29th place with 438.

HEART OF THE ORDER? NO PROBLEM: Opposing hitters 4-6 in the lineup are hitting a combined .156 (10-for-64) with 14 strikeouts, no walks and just two extra-base hits (one double and one home run) against Ryan this season.

QUALITY STARTER: Recorded his fourth-straight quality start and team-leading sixth of the season in his last start on May 10 at Toronto...has allowed three or fewer runs in each of his last eight starts this season.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
