TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second loss of the season on May 5 vs. Boston, allowing three runs on four hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts..recorded his third-straight quality start and team-leading fifth of the season...was perfect through 3.0 innings before Jarren Duran's leadoff double in the fourth...allowed a Rob Refsnyder RBI double that drove in Boston's first run...allowed two more runs on Ceddanne Rafaela's fifth-inning home run...four of his five strikeouts came on 4-seam fastballs (three swinging, one looking); the pitch generated seven whiffs on 25 swings (28.0%).
