AROUND THE HORN

SIX NON-PROFITS SURPRISED WITH OVER \$1 MILLION THRU 2026 KEN KENDRICK GRAND SLAM AWARDS: Six Arizona-based nonprofits - Arizona Educational Foundation, Delivering Dreams Arizona, Foundation for Blind Children, Keys to Change, Phoenix Public Library Foundation and Southwest Human Development - were surprised with a combined \$1 million in grant funding through the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 2026 Ken Kendrick Grand Slam Awards...established in 2002, this signature grant program has awarded more than \$13.8 million to organizations across Arizona, supporting transformative, large-scale projects that drive long-term change by improving operations and strengthening communities.

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs look to split the series 2-2 with the Braves to complete a 5-2 opening home-stand...the D-backs last won or split a home series vs. Braves from July 8-11, 2024 (2-2).

- Among NL teams, the D-backs rotation's 3.04 ERA (16 ER in 47.1 IP) is second best to the Braves' 1.78 ERA (10 ER in 50.2 IP), ahead of the Mets (3.12 ERA; 17 ER in 49.0 IP), Pirates (3.41 ERA; 14 ER in 37.0 IP) and Dodgers (3.56 ERA; 17 ER in 43.0 IP).
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 29 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the Majors' longest active streak.
 - Last season, he rode a streak of 43 plate appearances without a strikeout from April 3 (fifth inning)-April 14, 2025, the longest by a D-back since Ender Inciarte (44 PA from Aug. 31-Sept. 11, 2015).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 6 of his last 7 games, hitting .300 (6-for-20)/1.194 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Brandon Pfaadt**, in 2 career home starts vs. Braves, has gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER in 12.0 IP), 1 walk and 10 strikeouts...in his last 9 starts @ Chase Field since July 18, 2025, has gone 4-0 with a 2.84 ERA (18 ER in 57.0 IP), opponent .220 AVG, 10 walks and 43 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 2-1 vs. Braves last night...it was the third game in franchise history (first ever @ Chase Field) where the team won despite not recording an RBI...others: Aug. 20, 2016 @ Padres (W, 2-1) and July 27, 2005 @ Brewers (W, 3-0)...the last MLB team to win without an RBI was the Braves on Aug. 20, 2025 vs. White Sox (W, 1-0).

- Was just the fourth homerless game between the D-backs and Braves in 28 total matchups since 2022 (last: June 4, 2025 @ Braves, D-backs won 2-1)...in the span, the teams have combined for an average of 2.6 HR/G.
- **Michael Soroka** earned his second win in his second start after allowing just 1 run on 4 hits in 5.0 innings with 3 walks and 3 strikeouts...recorded consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings with 1 run or fewer allowed for the first time since July 18-23, 2025 while with the Nationals.
 - His 13 strikeouts over his first 2 starts as a D-back tied for fourth most in franchise history among pitchers making their first 2 starts (also: Ryne Nelson/2022 and Brandon Webb/2003), behind Randy Johnson (24 in 1999) and Miguel Batista (16 in 2006).
- **Gabriel Moreno** recorded his third multi-hit performance in 8 games and also his first caught stealing of the season (R. Acuña Jr., third inning).
- 4 relievers - **Taylor Clarke**, **Jonathan Loaisiga**, **Juan Morillo** and **Paul Sewald** (SV, 3) combined for 4.0 perfect innings of work with 4 strikeouts.

DEFENSE SAVING RUNS: The D-backs' 18 defensive runs saved (DRS) rank atop the Majors, ahead of the Red Sox (11), Mariners (11), Braves (9), Dodgers (8) and Pirates (8), while **Ketel Marte's** and **Alek Thomas's** 3 DRS rank tied for the second most among players (also: 3 others), behind Cole Young /SEA (4).

MARTE'S 10 YEARS OF SERVICE: On Friday, **Ketel Marte** reached the milestone of 10 years of service time.

- Marte, who debuted with the Mariners in 2015 and made his D-backs debut in 2017, became the second D-back all-time to play 10 seasons with the club, joining Nick Ahmed (2014-23), and, with 1,062 games, is the third D-back all-time to appear in over 1,000 games with Luis Gonzalez (1,194) and Paul Goldschmidt (1,092).
- In his D-backs tenure, Marte's accolades include Top 5 in NL MVP voting twice (fourth in 2019, third in '24), 3-time NL All-Star (2019, '24, '25), 2-time All MLB First-Team honoree (2024, '25), 2-time Silver Slugger winner (2024, '25), 2023 NLCS MVP and 2-time D-backs Arizona BBWAA Most Valuable Player (2021, '24).

TRENDING: Geraldo Perdomo has reached base in 12 of his last 15 home games since Sept. 15, 2025, with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI, 8 walks and only 6 strikeouts.

- Has reached base in 23 of his last 26 games with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 14 walks (12 K).

• **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 29 of his last 31 home games since Aug. 6, 2025, including 2+ times in 21 of those games, and has drawn 6 walks in his last 6 games...is batting .318 (35-for-110)/1.088 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers, 24 RBI, 21 walks and 12 stolen bases.

VS. BRAVES: The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 games.

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in 5 of his last 7 games with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 6 of his last 7 games with 1 double, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

- Won his last start vs. Tigers on April 1 after 6.0 scoreless innings with 0 walks and 2 strikeouts.
- In his last 3 starts vs. Mets, has gone 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER in 13.0 IP), 0.85 WHIP, opponent .116 AVG, 6 walks and 14 strikeouts.

LOADED ARSENAL: Features a diverse pitch selection, including a sinker (23.5% usage rate in 2025), 4-seam fastball (23.4%), sweeper (18.6%), changeup (15.7%), curveball (9.8%) and cutter (9.2%).

- Is scoreless in 3 career appearances vs. Braves (3.0 IP) and allowed just 1 walk with 3 strikeouts.
- In 2025, was 1 of 2 pitchers with 50+ appearances and 9 or fewer walks (also: Tyler Rogers/SF-NYM, 81 G/7 BB).

- Against his slider last season (42.6% usage), opponents hit .200 (9-for-45) with no homers and a 42.2 whiff pct.

- Is 1 of 3 players in MLB history with 5+ Silver Sluggers and 10+ Gold Gloves with Iván Rodríguez and Ken Griffey Jr.

- Has reached base safely in 29 of his last 31 home games since Aug. 6, batting .318 (35-for-110)/1.088 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers, 24 RBI and 21 walks.
- In 5 of his last 7 games vs. Braves since April 27, 2025, has reached base 2+ times...owns a .448 OBP and 1.221 OPS (6 H, 6 BB) with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 5 walks.
