**RAY MATTER**—The Rays have won five consecutive games on the heels of a 3-7 stretch from April 21–May 1 and are a season-high 3 games over .500...they have outscored opponents, 31-14, during the streak, which matches their longest winning streak of the season (April 16-20)...a win tonight would give them their longest single-season streak since Aug 25-31, 2020 (6)...this winning streak has brought them from last place in the AL East into second place...they are 1.5 GB of the Red Sox (19-13) in the division, matching their smallest deficit since the end of play on April 24.

- + Last night the Rays completed a 4-game sweep for the 17th time in franchise history, first since Aug 10-13, 2020 at BOS...it was the seventh in club history on the road and second at Angel Stadium.
- + Last night the Rays recorded their eighth come-from-behind win and matched their largest comeback win, joining May 2 vs. HOU (trailed 3-0, won 5-4) and April 24 vs. TOR (trailed 3-0, won 5-3).
- + The Rays are 11-5 on the road this season, 3rd in the majors, and 31-11 (.738) on the road since Aug 10, 2020, best in the majors...the Rays have won nine of their last 10 road games after going 2-4 on the season-opening road trip...over this 9-1 span, the Rays have made 3 errors while their opponents have combined for 17 errors.
- + The Rays have used 37 players (tied for 3rd in the majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd) and 11 starting pitchers (tied for 1st) this season.
- + The Rays are 8-6 in this stretch of 17 consecutive days without an off day, and 16-11 in this stretch of 30 games in 31 days.

**ABOUT THE OFFENSE**—Last night the Rays offense combined for 8 runs on 8 hits, 1 HR and 2 BB against the Angels bullpen after starter **Andrew Heaney** pitched 6.2 scoreless innings...the Rays greeted the Angels bullpen with a **Mike Zunino** solo homer before a groundout ended the 7th inning, then opened the 8th with three consecutive hits to tie the game...said another way, five hitters after Heaney was replaced from the game, the Rays had scored 3 runs off the Angels bullpen to erase a 3-0 deficit.

- + The Rays scored 7 runs on 7 hits in the 8th inning, their highest-scoring frame since Aug 30, 2020 at MIA (7-run 5th) and highest-scoring 8th inning since July 3, 2010 at MIN (7)...the 7 hits were their most in a single frame since the 1st inning on July 12, 2019 at BAL (8)...**Brett Phillips** singled and doubled in the 8th inning, the 41st time in franchise history a Rays batter recorded multiple hits in a frame and first since **Carlos Gómez** on July 31, 2018 vs. LAA.
- + The Rays have totaled 26 runs on 35 hits, 6 HR, 23 BB and 6 errors through the first 4 games of this 7-game road trip (LAA/OAK)...the 26 runs pass their total from the preceding 10-game homestand (25) and the 6 HR are one shy of matching their homestand total.
- + During the 5-game winning streak, opposing starters have a 2.84 ERA (25.1-IP, 8-ER) and bullpens have a 9.16 ERA (18.2-IP, 19-ER).
- + In the last 14 games since April 23 vs. TOR, the Rays have scored 51 runs (3.64 R/G) on 98 hits and 50 BB, have struck out 151 times and are batting .212 (98-for-463) overall and .155 (17-for-110) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 20 of 33 games (60.6 pct.), tied for the 3rd-fewest in the AL after the Tigers (22) and A's (21).
- + The Rays offense has a majors-most 340 SO this season, ahead of the Tigers (339) and Rangers (336)...they rank 11th in the AL in batting avg. (.226), 6th in on-base pct. (.311) and 10th in homers (34).
- + The Rays have used 33 different batting orders in 33 games.

**CHICKEN ON THE BONE**—The Rays have scored 26 runs this road trip, batting .256 (10-for-39) with RISP over that stretch...last night the Rays went 4-for-9 with RISP, and the 4 hits were their most since going 4-for-15 on April 21 at KC...the 10 hits this road trip pass the team total from the preceding 10-game homestand, when they hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP.

- + This season the Rays are batting .200 (58-for-290) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the Nationals (.203)...with RISP/2 out, their .152 avg. (21-for-138) is last in the majors (29th: Mets, .155).
- + The Rays are batting .247 (39-for-158) with RISP on the road, compared to a .144 avg. (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 101 times with RISP, most in the majors ahead of the Dodgers (98)...**Willy Adames** leads the majors with 15 SO with RISP, while **Randy Arozarena** ranks 2nd with 14 SO.
- + The Rays have had 67 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 32 times (47.8 pct.), 15th in the majors...the major league avg. in those situations is 49.0 pct.

**PITCHING PROPERLY**—The Rays have allowed a total of 4 runs in their last 2 games and 3 runs (or fewer) in four straight games...last night all 3

runs allowed by the Rays came in the 3rd inning, but the pitching staff has been unscored upon in 14 of the last 15 frames and 17 of 19...the Rays have pitched to a 2.92 ERA (117-IP, 38-ER) in their last 13 games, allowing 3 runs (or fewer) 11 times over that stretch...this has lowered the staff's season ERA from 4.62 to 3.92, its lowest since the end of play on April 2 (2.00)...the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in 17 of their last 26 games (65.4 pct.) since April 10, after doing it once in the first 7 games this year.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.44 ERA (235.2-IP, 90-ER) in 26 games, which ranks 8th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.62 ERA (65.1-IP, 19-ER) in the last 14 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.92...since April 10, the bullpen is 14th in the majors with a 3.39 ERA (122-IP, 46-ER) in 26 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 53 runs in the 7th inning or later, 7th in the majors and 3rd in the AL...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 2 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras...however, in the last 14 games the Rays have allowed 8 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games of this season.
- + The Rays are 9-8 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 4-5 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

**START ME UP**—Rays starters rank 10th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.75 ERA (151.1-IP, 63-ER)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.48 ERA (113.2-IP, 44-ER) behind the White Sox (2.77)...over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 15 of 26 starts (57.7 pct.), including 11 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 10 of 20 starts since April 10, including eight scoreless starts...this comes on the heels of a 4.54 ERA through the first 7 games this season, which ranked 22nd in the majors.

- + Rays pitchers have made 10 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), tied with four other clubs for the most in the AL—despite using an opener six times...in comparison, Rays starters accomplished that only 11 times in 60 games (18.3 pct.) last season.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 12 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

**RAYS vs. ATHLETICS**—Tonight is the fifth of seven meetings with Oakland this season, all coming over a 14-day stretch, after the two clubs split a 4-game series at Tropicana Field last week...tonight is the first time the Rays are playing at the Oakland Coliseum since winning the 2019 AL Wild Card Game...the Rays held a lead from the fifth pitch through the final pitch, after **Yandy Díaz** hit a leadoff homer off **Sean Manaea**...the Rays are 78-111 (.413) all-time against the Athletics and 32-60 (.348) at the Oakland Coliseum—their lowest winning pct. at a current AL ballpark.

- + Since July 22, 2016, 20 of the 27 games have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and 16 of the 27 have been decided by 1-run margins.
- + **LH Rich Hill** made 14 starts for Oakland in 2016 before they sent him to the Dodgers at the trade deadline...**INF Joey Wendle** is the only other Ray who once played for the Athletics (2016-17).

**BACKSTOP POP**—Last night **Mike Zunino** hit a solo homer in the 7th inning and added a RBI single in the 8th...Rays catchers are batting .259 with 8 2B, 7 HR and 18 RBI this season, compared to .176 with 10 2B, 6 HR and 29 RBI last season...Rays catchers lead the majors with 15 XBH, are tied for 2nd with 7 HR (Diamondbacks, 9) and rank 4th with a .509 SLG.

- + Since the start of last postseason, Zunino has hit 10 HR in 38 games, and his 6 HR this season rank 2nd on the club (Meadows, 7).

**MINOR MATTERS**—The Rays are ranked by *Baseball America*, MLB.com, *Baseball Prospectus*, ESPN and *The Athletic* as the No. 1 farm system in the game...their four full-season affiliates are a combined 10-1 (.909) this season with a +40 run differential (72-32)...the Rays system is led by **INF Wander Franco**, the consensus No. 1 prospect in the minors, and he is batting .385 (5-for-13) with 1 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 4 RBI in 3 games this season for Triple-A Durham...last night **Vidal Bruján** (MLB.com's No. 42 overall prospect) hit a 2-run homer in the 3rd inning off former Rays prospect **Matthew Liberatore**, his second consecutive game with a homer...he has multiple hits in three straight games for the first time since Aug 9-11, 2018.

- + **1B Ji-Man Choi** (arthroscopic surgery, right knee) continues a rehab assignment with the Bulls...last night he played 7 innings at first base and went 0-for-4...he is not scheduled to play in tonight's game as Durham continues its opening series in Memphis.

**LAST START**—On Sun vs. HOU, took no decision after facing two batters over the minimum in three scoreless innings, his first scoreless start of any length since July 29, 2020 vs. STL (5 IP, with MIN)...worked around a walk and a single in the 1st and 2nd innings, respectively, then went 1-2-3 in the 3rd before being replaced...eclipsed 1,000 career innings pitched in the 2nd...has allowed 2 runs in his last 9 IP after allowing 16 runs in his first 16.1 IP...his line: ND, 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 4 SO, 44 pitches, 26 str.

**vs. ATHLETICS**—Is 1-2 with a 4.20 ERA (15-IP, 7-ER) in 7 apps against the Athletics and 1-2 with a 5.25 ERA (12-IP, 7-ER) in 3 starts...last faced them on April 26 at Tropicana Field, taking the loss despite recording 10 SO, his 17th career double-digit strikeout game...both runs came after allowing a walk and 2-run homer to **Sean Murphy**, both with 2 outs in the 4th.

+ Went 9-3 with a 2.25 ERA (76-IP, 19-ER) in 14 starts with the Athletics in 2016 before going to the Dodgers at the trade deadline.

**IN THE ZONE**—Has thrown first-pitch strikes to 64.2 pct. (68 of 106) of his batters faced this season, 9th among AL left-handed pitchers (min. 25 IP)...has thrown strikes on 67 pct. of his pitches, tied for 12th in the AL and 5th among AL lefties, compared to 63 pct. of his pitches in 2020 (with MIN).

+ Has entered 2-strike counts to 60.4 pct. (64 of 106) of batters faced, and is allowing a .193 opp avg. (11-for-57) in those situations.

**ROAD TRIPPING**—Has allowed 2 runs (or fewer) in eight of his last 10 road starts since May 17, 2019 at CIN...since 2018, is 8-2 with a 3.55 ERA (114-IP, 45-ER) in 24 road starts, including a 7-game winning streak from July 20, 2018-June 8, 2019...has only lost once in his last 17 road starts, with an unbeaten streak of 16 straight road starts snapped on Sep 18, 2020 at CHC...took the loss despite allowing 1 run on 3 hits and 2 BB in 7 IP.

+ Min. 100 IP on the road since 2018, ranks among major league leaders in opp avg. (.209, tied for 10th) and opp SLG (.347, 12th).

**CRAZY CURVE**—Hill has used his curveball on 39.9 pct. of his pitches this season, the highest rate in the majors (min. 300 pitches)...opponents are batting .182 (8-for-44) in at-bats ending with the curveball, the 10th-best rate in the AL (min. 20 PA)...his 22.7 pct. whiff rate on the curveball this season is his highest rate since 2017, when his whiff rate was 25.1 pct.

+ His hard-hit rate on the pitch this season is 38.2 pct. compared to 18.2 pct. last season, which was the 9th-best rate in the majors.

**MR. 1000**—Became the 50th active pitcher to eclipse 1,000 career innings pitched with a 1-out flyout in the 2nd inning of his start on May 2 vs. HOU...among those pitchers, ranks 7th in opp avg. (.224), 10th in opp SLG (.371), 11th in winning pct. (.602) and 12th in strikeout rate (25.7 pct.).

**SWEET SINCE '15**—Over the last seven seasons (2015-21), is 44-23 with a 3.09 ERA (530.1-IP, 182-ER) and 612 SO in 101 apps (100 starts)...min. 400 IP, ranks among major league leaders over that stretch in ERA (10th), WHIP (1.07, 11th), opp avg. (.207, 4th) and opp SLG (.346, 3rd)...in comparison, through his first 10 seasons, he was 24-22 with a 4.72 ERA (471-IP, 247-ER), 1.99 SO/BB ratio (451-SO, 227-BB) and .243 opp avg. (429-for-1,768).

**SENIOR LIVING**—Ended the 2020 season as baseball's oldest active pitcher...if he appears in a game for the Rays on May 24 or later, he would become the oldest player in club history...would pass **Wade Boggs**, who was 41 years, 73 days old when he played in his last game on Aug 27, 1999.

+ Since turning 38, he is 18-9 with a 3.56 ERA (255.1-IP, 101-ER).

**2020 IN REVIEW**—Opened the season in the Twins starting rotation due to the delayed season from the COVID-19 pandemic...went 2-2 with a 3.03 ERA (38.2-IP, 13-ER) in 8 starts, allowing 2 runs (or fewer) in seven of those starts...recorded a 2.38 ERA (22.2-IP, 6-ER) in his final 4 starts.

- + Batting .261 (6-for-23) since snapping a career-long 0-for-25 drought.
- + Has 4 DRS, tied for 2nd among ML shortstops...had 2 DRS last season.
- + On Mon at LAA, recorded his second multi-XBH game this season (April 9 vs. NYY), with a double in the 3rd inning and solo homer off José Quintana in the 4th...his homer traveled 446 feet, the 3rd-longest homer of his career behind Sep 21, 2019 vs. BOS (462 feet) and Sep 13, 2019 at LAA (450 feet).
- + Since 2019, has a .300 avg. (130-for-433) on the road and 23 of his 31 HR (74.2 pct.) have come on the road, highest rate in the AL (min. 20 HR).
- + Made his third consecutive Opening Day roster, all starts at shortstop.
- + His full bio is on Page 51 of the 2021 Rays Media Guide.
