THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game homestand, winning a series over the White Sox this week, taking games one and two, but losing game three... starting tonight, Minnesota will host the Royals for four games through the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are on day 14 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday.

TWINS MISS SWEEP OF SOX: The Twins were blanked by the White Sox yesterday by a score of 8-0, suffering their first time being shut out this season...Taj Bradley (5-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with five walks and five strikeouts...five walks for Bradley tied a career-high, while eight walks by Twins pitchers were one short of the season-high (9 on 5/9 at CLE)...the offense recorded five hits, all of which were singles, while just two players reached scoring position.

TWINS TRADE SWR: Last night, the Twins traded right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson to the Toronto Blue Jays in exchange for cash considerations...Woods Richardson, who was designated for release or assignment on Saturday, appeared in 12 games (10 starts) for the Twins this season, going 0-7, 7.74 ERA (47.2 IP, 41 ER), 25 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .330 opponent batting average...over parts of five-plus seasons in a Twins uniform, the right-hander appeared in 65 games (61 starts), going 12-17, 4.76 ERA (302.1 IP, 160 ER), 124 walks and 258 strikeouts.

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the fourth of 13 games in 2026...these two last met for a three-game series at Kauffman Stadium as the second-leg of Minnesota's opening roadtrip, as the Twins won just the third game.

☞ Since the start of 2024, the Twins have gone 9-4 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 5-11 at Kauffman Stadium.

☞ Twins last hosted the Royals for three games from August 8-10, 2025, winning the three-game series 2-1...Twins went 4-2 vs. the Royals at Target Field last season.

☞ Twins are 35-24 in their last 59 overall against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022... that includes a home record of 23-7.

☞ Josh Bell is hitting .330 (31-for-94) with six doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a 1.034 OPS in 26 career games vs. Kansas City...two of his five home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Bailey Falter and April 2 off Steven Cruz).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and an .802 OPS in nine career games vs. Kansas City...Keaschall recorded his first career three-hit game against the Royals at Target Field, capped off by a walk-off homer on August 10, 2025.

OH JEEZ, SURE, YOU BET: Twins have won five of their last seven games at home...they have won three of their last four series' (May 12-14 vs. Miami, May 18-20 vs. Houston and June 1-3 vs. Chicago) in Minnesota.

☞ They are 17-15 at home this season, compared to 12-19 on the road.

☞ They have a +14 run differential at home (151-137), compared to -38 on the road (139-177).

☞ Twins have scored 151 runs at home this season, fourth-most in the AL, trailing Baltimore (171), New York (156) and Chicago (152).

☞ Twins are 6-1 vs. the AL Central at home in 2026.

☞ The Twins bullpen at home, since May 3, has gone 2-1, 2.81 ERA (48.0 IP, 15 ER) with a .230 opponent batting average in 12 games.

☞ Kody Clemens has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 home games, posting a .357 on-base percentage in that span.

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall went 1-for-4 yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 10 games...over that span, he is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with two doubles and a .780 OPS... the 10-game streak is the third-longest of his career, trailing his 14-game streak (August 13-29, 2025) and 11-game streak (April 18- August 10, 2025).

RISPY BUSINESS: Through three games this homestand, Twins have gone 10-for-22 (.455) with runners in scoring position...on the season, they have hit .282 (150-for-532) with RISP, the best in the AL and third-highest in baseball, trailing Atlanta (.291) and Milwaukee (.286).

☞ Notable individuals with RISP this season in chart in right margin.

☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 50 RISP plate appearances: Brooks Lee (.412) ranks third and Luke Keaschall (.345) ranks fourth.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2012, the Twins selected Byron Buxton with the second overall selection in the MLB First-Year Player Draft...he was the top ranked high school prospect in the country by *Baseball America*...he was the 2011-2012 Gatorade Georgia Player of the Year after leading Appleton County High School to the Georgia Class AA State Championship that season...the 6-foot-2, 185 pound First-Team Rawlings Preseason All-American hit .513 with 17 doubles, three home runs, 35 RBI and 38 stolen bases during his senior season... on the mound, Buxton was 10-1 with five saves and 154 strikeouts in 81.0 innings pitched.

SAINTS HIT CENTURY MARK: Yesterday afternoon, Triple-A St. Paul became the first team in Minor League Baseball and Major League Baseball to reach the 100 home run mark...Matt Wallner hit the 100th in the second inning while Royce Lewis hit the 101st with a grand slam in the seventh inning...it marked Lewis' 10th of the season, and eighth since being optioned on May 19...Lewis became the fastest Saints player with 10 home runs in a season, doing it in 13 games.
