TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rays face off this afternoon for the final game of this three-game set here at Tropicana Field...SF is looking to win its first road series of the year after evening out the series with yesterday's explosive 11-2 win.

- ▶ The Giants are is 1-0 in rubber games this season, with the one game being last Sunday's 3-2 victory over the Padres at Oracle Park.
- ▶ After today's game, SF will remain in the Sunshine State as they head southeast to Miami for a three-game series before returning home on Wednesday.

PUT THE WORD OUT THERE THAT WE BACK UP: IF Thairo Estrada's 4th inning solo homer yesterday snapped a seven-game homerless drought for the Giants...the streak was SF's longest in almost 10 years after last going seven consecutive games without a home run in 2014 (June 7-13).

- ▶ SF's home run fest then continued with longballs from **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr., OF Jorge Soler, IF Matt Chapman** and a second homer by Estrada...the offensive display marked the Giants' first five-homer game since April 29, 2023 at SD (Mexico City) and the first one stateside since April 6, 2023 at Chicago-AL.

EL DE BEJUMA: One of the offensive highlights of yesterday's hitting frenzy was Estrada, who recorded his fourth career multi-HR game and first since last June vs. Chicago-NL.

- ▶ It was also Estrada's third such game as a second baseman, all of which came with SF...his three multi-HR games at second base are tied for fourth-most by a Giant all-time and trail only Jeff Kent, Ray Durham and Robby Thompson.
- ▶ Estrada also homered twice as the starting shortstop on July 12, 2022 vs. Arizona.

CYZILLA: Reigning National League Cy Young award winner **LHP Blake Snell** makes his return to Tropicana today as he gets the ball for the Giants...the southpaw, who inked a two-year deal with SF on March 19 worth \$62 million, is making his first return to Trop since he was a member of the Rays in 2020.

- ▶ Snell's five seasons with Tampa Bay (2016-2020) included his first Cy Young award in 2018 in a season that saw him post an AL best 21-5 record and 1.89 ERA across 31 starts...at 25 years old, he became the youngest pitcher to win a Cy Young Award since LAD Clayton Kershaw (25) in 2013, and the youngest AL pitcher since SEA Félix Hernández (24) in 2010.

WE'RE 'CYHED: With Giants ace **RHP Logan Webb** as last year's runner up, SF became the seventh team with two pitchers who both finished in the top-2 in Cy Young Award voting (either league) the prior season after adding Snell...the other six are listed below courtesy of *Sarah Langs* and *Elias*.

TOP OF THE TROP: Snell is 23-12 with a 2.51 ERA in 50 career starts here at Tropicana and ranks among the top pitchers in the history of this ballpark in ERA (4th), strikeouts (330; 6th), opposing average (.208; 4th) and strikeouts-per-nine (10.91; 4th).

- ▶ Snell has faced the Rays only once in his career, a start at Petco Park on June 17 of last season...the lefty tossed 6.0-scoreless innings in the start, allowing just two hits and striking out 12.

STAY HOT!: Wade Jr., who's starting at right field today, lined his first homer of the season yesterday...the utilityman is slashing .368/.478/.526 in the year and has appeared in all 15 games for SF, reaching base in 13 of the 15 contests.

- ▶ Wade leads the club in average, on-base percentage (.478), OPS (1.005) and is second in SLG (.526) and hits (14).
- ▶ He also ranks among the top of the MLB leaderboards in batting average and OBP, as shown below (min. 40 PA).

BANG, BANG: Giants batters have been crushing the ball this season, compiling 166 hard-hits (95mph+) in the year according to *Statcast*...leading the club are **IF Matt Chapman** and **OF Jung Hoo Lee**, who have 27 and 26 such hits, respectively...below is where they rank among the MLB leaderboard.

- ▶ SF's 166 hard hits are sixth-most in MLB and fourth in the NL behind the Dodgers (179), Padres (174) and Braves (167).

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young will make his second start since joining SF in his first return to Tropicana Field today.

LAST TIME OUT: Snell made his first start of 2024 on April 8 vs. Washington, striking out five while allowing three runs on three hits and two walks over 3.0 innings (72 pitches, 39 for strikes).

WELCOME BACK: After being selected in the first round (52nd overall) by Tampa Bay in the 2011 MLB Draft, Snell would debut on April 23, 2016 and pitch five seasons for the Rays, going 42-30 with a 3.24 ERA, 648 strikeouts (fifth in Rays history) and a 1.24 WHIP over 556.0 innings (108 starts)...at Tropicana Field, Snell is 23-12 with a 2.51 ERA (76er, 272.1ip) with 330 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in 50 career starts...his 330 strikeouts at the Trop rank sixth all-time in ballpark history while his 2.51 ERA ranks fourth.

VS. TAMPA BAY: Snell made his first career start against the team that drafted him last season while pitching for San Diego...he struck out 12 (one shy of his career-high) while tossing 6.0 shut-out innings with just two hits and three walks allowed on June 17.

CYZILLA: Snell won his second career Cy Young and first in the National League last season (also in 2018 with Tampa Bay)...he went 14-9 with an MLB-leading 2.25 ERA to become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to win the Cy Young in both leagues:

WALK IT BACK: The lefty became the first pitcher since ERA was established in both leagues in 1913 to finish as baseball's leader in walks (99) and ERA (2.25)...the Rays offer an interesting challenge as their 7.4% walk rate is third-lowest in MLB, while their 30.2 O-Swing% (percent swings at pitches outside the strike zone) is fifth-highest in MLB.

RARE 1-2 PUNCH: Per Sarah Langs and Elias, the duo of **LHP Blake Snell** and **RHP Logan Webb** make the Giants just the seventh team in MLB history to have both of the top-2 Cy Young Award vote getters from the prior season.

NO TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Snell held the Nationals 0-for-3 against his curveball last week...of Snell's 234 strikeouts last season, 109 came on his curveball...opponents hit .079 on the pitch with a .140 slugging percentage...his curveball had a run value of 22 last season after posting a run value of three in 2022...the 22 run value was the second-best rated curveball behind Atlanta RHP Charlie Morton's 25, and rated as the sixth-best pitch overall...against curveballs this season, the Rays have a .200 average (17th), a .267 SLG (26th) and a 28.6% strikeout rate (T-16th).

NEXT BEST THING: In addition to the high strikeout numbers, Snell was also excellent at keeping the ball on the ground last year, finishing 16th in MLB and ninth in the National League with a 44.4% ground ball rate...in his first start of the year, Snell got nine outs (three via ground outs and five via the strikeout).

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Has appeared in just three of SF's 11 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/7 vs. SD; SV, 1.0ip, h, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first save of the season last Sunday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last four outings, Miller has struck out eight hitters over 4.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 14 at-bats (.071).
- ▶ Has appeared in seven games for SF, allowing six runs in 7.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
