SLEEPLESS IN SEATTLE: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers kick off a three-game weekend series at American Family Field tonight as the Redbirds continue their six-game, seven-day “Seattle Pilots” road trip ... The Cardinals touched down in Milwaukee at approx. 6:00 a.m. yesterday morning after being swept by the Seattle Mariners at T-Mobile Park, which culminated with Wednesday night’s walk-off defeat in 13 innings that lasted a season-long 3 hours and 44 minutes ... St. Louis jumped out to early leads in all three games in Seattle, but the M’s came back to win every game by two runs.

WHAT’S BREWING: The Cardinals and Brewers face off six times over the next 10 days ... Nine of the Cardinals final 15 games are against divisional opponents ahead of them in the standings ... St. Louis is 20-20 in divisional play this season (7-13 on the road).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 4.0 games behind New York for the final Wild Card position ... The Cardinals play the toughest remaining strength of schedule, with combined .559 winning pct. against the Brewers (6g), Reds (3g), Giants (3g), and Cubs (3g). - *Elías*

REDBIRDS ROSTER UPDATES: Prior to tonight’s game, St. Louis activated 2B **Brendan Donovan** and LHP **John King** from the Injured List, and optioned LHP **Nick Raquet** and INF **Jose Fermin** to Memphis (AAA).

- Donovan, who missed 25 games since Aug. 15 while recovering from a left groin strain, was 0-for-4 with three walks in two injury rehab games at second base with Springfield (AA).

- King, who last pitched for St. Louis on July 29, made a rehab appearance with Springfield (AA) on Wednesday, throwing 16 pitches (12 strikes) in 1.0 innings ... The left-hander missed 21 games from July 30-Aug. 24 with a left oblique strain, then another 15 games since Aug. 26 with a mid-back strain.

- 3B **Nolan Arenado** began a rehab assignment with Springfield (AA) on Wednesday and has played in two games at designated hitter, going a combined 0-for-7 ... Arenado has been sidelined for 37 games since Aug. 1 with a right shoulder strain.

FANTASTIC FINISHES: St. Louis needs to go 10-5 to finish with a winning mark, above .500 ... The Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their past 31 seasons since joining the NL Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000 ... The last time St. Louis posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

EXTRA BASES TAKEN: The Cardinals (153) & Brewers (149) are the top two MLB teams in extra bases taken (bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, and defensive indifference) this season ... **Lars Nootbaar** (18) ranks T-8th in the NL.

MINOR MATTERS: Eight Cardinals minor leaguers have been named to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2025 Arizona Fall League season: RHP **Chen-Wei Lin** (AA), RHP **Darlin Saladin** (AA), RHP **Tyler Bradt** (AA), RHP **Randel Clemente** (AA), RHP **D.J. Carpenter** (A+), C **Graysen Tarlow** (AA), OF **Miguel Ugueto** (AA), and OF **Travis Honeyman** (A+)

- Double-A Springfield has set a franchise record in wins (85-50), while winning both halves in the same season for the 2nd time in franchise history (2007) ... Game 1 of the best-of-three Texas League Division Series is Tuesday (TBD opponent).

- Cardinals 2025 first round draft pick (#5 overall) LHP **Liam Doyle** was recently transferred from Palm Beach (A) to Springfield (AA), and is scheduled to start tomorrow vs. San Antonio (AA-Padres) ... The last Cardinals draft selection to reach Double-A in the same season of being drafted was RHP **Michael Wacha** in 2012.

- C **Rainiel Rodriguez** (#98) recently joined INF **JJ Wetherholt** (#4) and Doyle (#63) in *Baseball America*’s recently updated Top 100 Prospect Rankings list.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Andre Granillo (June 12, 2025 at Am Fam Field) made his MLB debuts vs. the Brewers.

Erick Fedde made 30 starts for St. Louis over parts of two seasons (2024-25)...acquired at the 2024 MLB Trade Deadline from the White Sox as part of three-team trade with the Dodgers.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Late Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** & **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Lillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Willson Contreras’s younger brother, **William**, is a catcher for the Brewers.

Caleb Durbin played college baseball at Washington University in St. Louis (2019-21).

Riley O’Brien’s grandfather **Johnny O’Brien** was drafted by the NBA’s Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Jacob Misorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Brewers Media Relations Intern **Owen Buescher** previously worked as a 2024 Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate...graduated from Belleville (Ill.) West High School and Univ. of Missouri.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women’s basketball team.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin–Madison.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 29th start of the season and his 59th career start (167th career appearance). Has established new single-season highs in starts (28), quality starts (9), strikeouts (104) and innings pitched (150.0).
- Pitched 6.0 innings in his last start registering a quality start, snapping a stretch of six starts under 6.0 innings dating back to Aug. 3 at SD.
- Snapped a streak of six straight starts with a loss with a no decision in his last start vs. SF (9/6). Cardinals are 2-12 in his last 14 starts.
- Still holds an active six-game loss streak. The loss streak is the longest of his career and by a Cardinals pitcher since **Adam Wainwright** dropped 7 straight in 2023 (7/29-9/7) before winning his final two starts for 200 career wins.
- His 3.84 run support average ranks as the 5th-lowest in the National League. Has received 1 run or less in 15 starts, including 10 scoreless starts.**
- St. Louis is 9-4 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support, with losses coming vs. KC (6/3), at MIA (8/20) vs. PIT (8/26) and at CIN (8/31).
- Since returning to the starting rotation on May 26, 2024, ranks 2nd in wins (14, tied) and strikeouts (192), and 3rd in qualifying ERA (4.55).
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (64.2%) in MLB (min. 400 innings pitched).
- As a starting pitcher (315.2 IP), Pallante's 60.7 groundball pct. is the 7th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 300.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 17-of-28 starts this season and his 20 HR allowed more than doubles his total (8) for last season.
- Has had 43 total chances in the field, ranking 2nd among MLB pitchers four back of the Yankees' **Max Fried** (47).

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, Sept. 6 vs. San Francisco): Pitched 6.0 innings in a no decision vs. San Francisco. Exited trailing 2-0 as the Cardinals rallied to win in the 9th inning 3-2, depriving Justin Verlander of his first career win at Busch Stadium. Was Pallante's first start of 6.0+ innings since Aug. 3 and snapped a six-start losing streak, also halted a six-game streak allowing a home run.

2025 NOTES:

- His ERA has increased the first six months this season (3.60--4.23--4.34--4.91--5.16--8.67), down to 3.00 in September.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-25).
- Carried a no-hitter thru 5.0 IP vs. Miami (7/28) in a 7-1 win, as he tossed 7.0 IP of scoreless ball, allowing just one hit (6th inning single). Snapped a four-game losing skid.
- Received a no-decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh (July 1) as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.

PALLANTE vs. MILWAUKEE

- Is making his 3rd career start against the Brewers and his 15th career appearance.
- Received a no decision in his last start at American Family Field in an 8-5 Cardinals win. Exited leading 6-4 after 4.1 innings not qualifying for the win.
- Owns a career mark of 0-1, 5.33 ERA against Milwaukee, including an 0-1, 7.31 mark at American Family Field in 7 games (16.0 IP)
- The Cardinals posted wins in 4 of his first 5 career appearances against MIL, but they are 2-7 in his last 9 games pitched against the Brewers.
- Allowed 2 HR's in his 9/2/24 start at MIL after having allowed just one HR in his first 12 career appearances against the Brew Crew.
