AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: On March 9, the D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated earning a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations, in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' 6-4 record (.600) since April 14 is the NL's sixth-best winning pct. behind the Dodgers (.615, 8-5), Padres (.750, 9-3), Reds (.750, 9-3), Cubs (.769, 10-3) and Braves (.833, 10-2).

- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 23-game hit streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is MLB's longest active streak and tied for the second-longest streak since 2024, behind Bryan Reynolds' 25-gamer (June 1-29, 2024).
- **Merrill Kelly** is 2 strikeouts shy of tying Curt Schilling (875) for sixth in franchise history.
- **Nolan Arenado** has a 5-game hitting streak with 4 multi-hit efforts, batting .611 (11-for-18)/1.500 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 3 walks (2 K).
 - In his last 12 games, is hitting .419 (18-for-43)/1.168 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 3 walks (6 K).
- **Jose Fernandez** has hit safely in 9 straight starts at a .400 clip (14-for-35)/.975 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 2 walks (7 K), including multi-hit efforts in his last 3.
 - In his last 15 starts, is hitting .373 (22-for-59)/.868 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 2 walks (13 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs split the Mexico City Series with a 12-7 win vs. Padres on Sunday, coming back from a 6-run deficit twice highlighted by a 6-run seventh inning with **Tim Tawa's** first career grand slam, and **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s** go-ahead 2-run double.

- 12 runs were a season high, including 11 unanswered runs.
- Trailed 6-0 after the top of the fifth inning and 7-1 after the top of the sixth inning before responding with 11 unanswered runs.
 - Largest come-from-behind win since June 5, 2025 @ Braves (11-10 win, 6-run deficit 3 times, trailed 6-0 after 3.0 innings, 9-3 after 6.0 innings and 10-4 after 8.0 innings).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his career-best 23-game hit streak with his team-leading sixth homer in the sixth inning and came a single shy of the cycle (3-for-5, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI).
- **Ryan Thompson** (1.0 IP), **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP) and **Jonathan Loaisiga** (1.0 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless frames (3 H, 0 BB, 3 K).

IT'S VARGY'S WEEK: **Ildemaro Vargas** earned his first career NL Player of the Week Award (April 20-26).

- Hit safely in his 5 games at a .364 clip (8-for-22)/1.409 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 4 homers and a MLB-leading 12 RBI.
- Ranked among MLB in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 6), total bases (3rd, 23), homers (T-2nd, 4), SLG (4th, 1.045) and OPS (5th, 1.409).
