**BIRDLAND BITES:** Today, Baltimore continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, including a road trip through Boston (2-1) and Toronto (1-1) before returning home with sets against Seattle (4 G) and San Diego (3 G)...The Birds have won five of seven and 10 of their last 15 games since May 22...They enter play today 0.5 games out of a Wild Card spot and 8.0 games back of the Rays in the AL East.

⚾ In yesterday's 6-4 defeat, the Birds went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position after going a combined 10-for-24 (.417) on Thursday and Friday.

⚾ O's pitching allowed Blue Jays hitters to go 6-for-13 (.462) with two outs, including Ernie Clement's three-run homer that broke a 1-1 tie in the third inning...Baltimore's .258 opponent batting average with two outs is third highest in the majors ahead of Colorado (.264) and Los Angeles-AL (.262).

**WIZARD OF BAZ:** Over his last four outings, all of which have been quality starts, **Shane Baz** is 2-1 with a 2.33 ERA (7 ER/27.0 IP), .202 (19-for-94) opponent average, and 1.07 WHIP.

⚾ His streak of four consecutive quality starts marks the third-longest active stretch in the majors behind PHI's Christopher Sánchez (7) and MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (6)...It is tied for the second-longest streak of Baz's career (also 6/26-7/12/25), trailing a six-start run from September 17, 2024-April 14, 2025.

⚾ Baz is 4-0 with a 2.23 ERA (8 ER/32.1 IP) in six career starts against the Blue Jays.

**INSIDE THE MATCHUP:** **Pete Alonso**, **Colton Cowser**, **Jackson Holliday**, **Sam Huff**, **Tyler O'Neill**, and **Leody Taveras** each have recorded one career home run off Kevin Gausman.

⚾ The Birds have had greater success against Gausman at Rogers Center over his career, as he owns a 5.14 ERA (20 ER/35.0 IP) over six starts vs. Baltimore at the venue, compared to his 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) in two starts opposite the O's at Camden Yards.

**POLAR BEAR ROARING:** **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in a season-high 10 straight games and is slashing .316/.371/.532 (25-for-79) with two doubles, five home runs, and 17 RBI over his last 20 games since May 16.

⚾ Alonso's 17 RBI since May 16 are tied for second most in the AL behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (18).

⚾ His current 10-game hitting streak is the fourth-longest active stretch in MLB behind SF's Jung Hoo Lee (14 G) and CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong/ATH's Zack Gelof (both 11 G).

⚾ It marks the second-longest hitting streak of his career, trailing an 11-game run from August 15-26, 2021.

⚾ Alonso is the second Oriole to hit safely in 10 straight games this year, joining **Samuel Basallo's** 10-game streak from May 5-17.

⚾ Eight of his 13 home runs this season have gone to the opposite field, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (10).

**MOOVING ALONG:** **Colton Cowser** is batting .348 (16-for-46) with one double, five home runs, 11 runs, 14 RBI, and five walks across 19 games since May 17.

⚾ During this stretch, he is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with one double, two home runs, and a 25.9 percent strikeout rate on breaking and off-speed pitches...Prior to that period, he was 4-for-48 (.083) with zero extra-base hits and a 47.1 percent strikeout rate on such offerings.

⚾ His five home runs this season have traveled an average distance of 422 ft., the furthest average home run distance in MLB (min. 5 HR) ahead of COL's Mickey Moniak and HOU's Cam Smith (both 417 ft.).

**BLAZING THE TRAIL:** **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .352/.390/.521 (25-for-71) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight runs, 15 RBI, five walks (1 IBB), and four stolen bases in 29 games since May 1 after slugging .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

⚾ His batting average since May 1 is tied with SF's Jung Hoo Lee for second highest in MLB (min. 70 AB) behind PHI's Brandon Marsh (.364).

**ALL ABOUT ADLEY:** Despite having his career-high-tying 16-game on-base streak come to an end yesterday, **Adley Rutschman** is slashing .266/.392/.469 (17-for-64) with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 runs, and 12 RBI over his last 17 games.

⚾ In 56 career games against Toronto, he is slashing .312/.390/.579 (69-for-221) with 17 doubles, 14 home runs, 43 runs, 47 RBI, and 29 walks against 33 strikeouts...His .969 career OPS opposite the Blue Jays is the second-highest mark by an Oriole in team history (min. 150 PA) behind Harold Baines (1.071).

⚾ The .969 career OPS is the third-highest mark by any active player in MLB against the Jays (min. 250 PA), trailing LAA's Mike Trout (1.008) and NYY's Aaron Judge (.993).

⚾ Rutschman has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games at Rogers Centre since August 1, 2023, slashing .359/.423/.656 (23-for-64) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 runs, 16 RBI, and six walks against six strikeouts.

⚾ His 14 career home runs and 47 RBI against the Blue Jays are his most against a single opponent, ahead of the Athletics (8 HR) and Red Sox (28 RBI), respectively.

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 56), times on base (4<sup>th</sup>, 117), and on-base percentage (T-9<sup>th</sup>, .398).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,271 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,286)...He has seen 438 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (472).

**'PEN PALS:** **Rico Garcia** ranks among all qualified MLB relievers in opponent average (1<sup>st</sup>, .083), opponent OPS (1<sup>st</sup>, .327), WHIP (1<sup>st</sup>, 0.61), hits per nine innings (1<sup>st</sup>, 2.39), base runners per nine innings (1<sup>st</sup>, 5.47), opponent on-base percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .172), and ERA (4<sup>th</sup>, 0.68).

⚾ Garcia's 40.2 percent whiff rate is fourth highest among all MLB pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) behind SD's Mason Miller (50.2%), TOR's Jeff Hoffman (42.5%), and NYY's Fernando Cruz (41.6%).

⚾ Orioles relievers own a 21.0 percent inherited runner scored rate (17 IRS/81 IR), second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (18.5%, 12 IRS/65 IR).

**QUICK HITS:** Baz is scheduled to make his 13<sup>th</sup> start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the victory on June 2 at Boston after throwing 7.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits and two walks with six strikeouts...Threw 94 pitches, 64 strikes.

⚡ His streak of four consecutive quality starts marks the third-longest active stretch in the majors behind PHI's Christopher Sánchez (7) and MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (6)...It is tied for the second-longest streak of Baz's career (also 6/26-7/12/25), trailing a six-start run from September 17, 2024-April 14, 2025.

⚡ Has thrown 7.0+ innings in back-to-back starts for the third time in his career, joining June 26-July 1, 2025 and August 13-20, 2024...Looks to become the first O's hurler to accomplish the feat in three straight starts since Trevor Rogers' four-outing run from August 13-30, 2025.

**BLUE BIRDS:** Baz is set to make his seventh career start opposite Toronto, having gone 4-0 with a 2.23 ERA (8 ER/32.1 IP), .198 opponent average (23-for-116), and 0.99 WHIP.

⚡ In two career starts at Rogers Centre, Baz is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP).

**INSIDE THE ARSENAL:** Over his last four starts since May 15, during which Baz owns a 2.33 ERA (7 ER/27.0 IP), he has limited the opposition to a .182 (4-for-22) clip on his four-seam fastball and a .188 (9-for-48) mark on his knuckle curve.

⚡ Prior to this stretch, the opposition hit .313 (15-for-48) off his four-seamer and .328 (21-for-64) off his knuckle curve.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 23 doubles, ahead of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (21)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 12 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** He has limited lefties to a .207 (19-for-92) clip over his last seven starts after they went 25-for-67 (.373) with 10 doubles over his first five outings.

⚡ During his most recent seven-start stretch, Baz has limited lefties to a .170 (8-for-47) clip with one home run off his knuckle curve...Over his first five starts, left-handed hitters went 12-for-32 (.375) with five doubles on the offering.

**TEEING OFF EARLY:** Opponents are slashing .419/.432/.744 (18-for-43) with eight doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.176 opponent OPS on the first pitch is the second highest in MLB (min. 40 BF), ahead of TB's Nick Martinez (1.178).

**CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL:** In 18 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted seven home runs over 99.2 innings (0.63 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ Since August 26, 2025, the 0.63 home runs per nine innings are tied with SF's Logan Webb for sixth fewest among all pitchers in MLB (min. 90.0 IP), trailing NYY's Max Fried (0.18), PHI's Christopher Sánchez (0.36), NYY's Cam Schlichtler (0.50), CWS' Davis Martin (0.53), and TOR's Kevin Gausman (0.63).

**ODDS AND ENDS:** Baz has limited the opposition to a 3-for-25 (.120) average with runners in scoring position and two outs...The .120 average is sixth lowest among all MLB pitchers (min. 25 AB).

⚡ Opposing 1-5 hole hitters have combined to hit .303 (47-for-155) off Baz with a .880 OPS, while six-nine hole hitters are batting .200 (22-for-110) with a .591 OPS.
