LAST GAME: The D-backs won 3-1 vs. Nationals on Sunday.

- Justin Martinez recorded his fourth save.
- Eugenio Suárez's team-best-tying 16th homer measured 466 feet, his furthest under Statcast since 2015.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. had a RBI double to extend his season-high 8-game hitting streak.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs recalled LHP **Tommy Henry** from Triple-A Reno and placed RHP Corbin Burnes on the 15-day IL (right elbow inflammation; retro June 2).

JARVIS PCL PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Triple-A RHP Bryce Jarvis was named Pacific Coast League Pitcher-of-the-Week on Monday...the D-backs' 2020 No. 18 overall pick tossed 6.0 no-hit innings @ Round Rock (Rangers), with 1 walk and 9 strikeouts on May 30.

GOOD PEN-MANSHIP: The D-backs bullpen owns a 12.1-inning scoreless streak since May 31.

DEFENSIVE WORK: The D-backs have a 26.1-inning errorless streak since May 30.

• Over their last 16+ games dating back to the eighth inning on May 13, the D-backs have committed just 5 errors over their last 142.2 innings...since May 14, the only NL team with fewer in that time is the Cubs (4).

VS. BRAVES: Eugenio Suárez has hit 6 homers in his last 5 games...has a 5-game hitting streak since July 10, 2024, batting .600 (9-for-15)/2.618 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.

TURNING IT OVER: The D-backs' 6-9 batters combined .723 OPS and .404 SLG rank second in the Majors, behind the Cubs (.792 OPS/.450 SLG).

SNAKES POWER TANDEM: The D-backs are the only team in the Majors with multiple players with 16+ homers in Corbin Carroll (16) and Eugenio Suárez (16).

Carroll and Suárez are the third duo in franchise history with 16+ homers in the team's first 59 games [also: Luis Gonzalez (22) and Reggie Sanders (16) in 2001; Jay Bell (17) and Matt Williams (16) in 1999].
