KEEP YOUR CHIN UP: The Giants were swept by the Yankees in their three game set to open the season (Wednesday-Saturday)...the last time the Giants started a season 0-3 was 2012 when they went on to win the World Series.

- ▶ It marks the sixth time in the San Francisco era (1958-present) that the Giants have begun a season 0-3...it also occurred in 2012, 1984, 1982, 1980 and 1969.
- ▶ The Giants are looking for a win tonight to avoid going 0-4 to start the season for the first time in the San Francisco era (1958-present)... the 1950 New York Giants are the most recent team in club history to lose four straight to open a campaign.

WAKE THE BATS: The Giants' offense scored just one run over their three game series against the Yankees, which marked their fewest in a three-game series since also scoring just one run in a three-game set at the A's in 2010...it was their fewest number of runs in a three-game series at home since 1949 vs. St. Louis (also one run).

- ▶ The one run is also their fewest runs scored through their first three games in a season, surpassing the two runs over the first three games in 2018 and 1940.
- ▶ The Giants' 12 hits through their first three games of the season are the club's fewest through three games to open a season since at least 1901...the previous low was 15 hits through the first three games of the season in both 1913 and 1911.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Landen Roupp will make his season debut tonight.

- ▶ Made five Cactus League starts and posted a 0-2 record with a 4.50 ERA (6er, 12.0ip)... he struck out 15 batters over his 13.0 innings of work.
- ▶ He's struggled at Petco Park in his career, going 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA (9er, 8.2ip) and .342 opponents batting average in four outings (two starts)...his last start against the Padres came on August 20, 2025 when he allowed five runs in 2.1 innings of work in the Giants 8-1 loss to the Padres in San Diego.
- ▶ A couple of Padres batters have put up good numbers against Roupp with Fernando Tatis Jr. hitting .625 (5-for-8) and Manny Machado going 4-for-10 (.400) with a home run.

AGAINST THE PADRES: Dating back to September 2024, the Giants have struggled against the Padres, posting a 3-13 record with a -50 run differential.

- ▶ They have also dropped 11 of their last 16 games here at Petco Park...during that stretch, SF hitters have posted a .212 batting average, while Giants' pitchers have posted a 5.55 ERA and allowed 5.9 runs per game.

WILLY VS. SD: IF Willy Adames owns a .397 career on-base percentage against the Padres, fifth best among active players (minimum 100 PA)...it is Adames' second-highest mark against any team in his career behind a .404 OBP against the Blue Jays (STATS, LLC).

ON THE RISE: IF Luis Arraez owns a combined .323 career batting average in March and April, which is the best among active MLB players (minimum 500 PA)...the last MLB player who had a higher career March/April average was Moises Alou (.331), who retired after 2007 (STATS, LLC).

- ▶ Arraez, who spent the last two seasons with the Padres, has posted a .294 average in 139 career games at Petco Park...he's hit safely in each of his last nine games here, batting .432 (16-for-37).

THE STANDOUT: The Giants' bullpen has been a bright spot for SF, posting a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip) and 13 strikeouts so far this season.

TONY V: Manager **Tony Vitello** looks for his first MLB win as manager today.

- ▶ Vitello joined each of SF's last four managers (**Bob Melvin**, **Kai Correa**, **Gabe Kapler** and **Bruce Bochy**) in losing their first game at the helm...with Saturday's loss, he joined Bochy (3x World Series Champion) and Kapler (2021 Manager of the Year) in losing their first two games as manager of the Giants...the last SF manager to also start 0-3 in their first three games in charge was **Danny Ozark** in 1984.
- ▶ Vitello spent the last eight years (2018-2025) as head coach of the University of Tennessee where he went 341-131 (.722), leading the Vols to a National Championship in 2024.

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp enters his third season with San Francisco and is on his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his first start of the season tonight.

CACTUS LEAGUE: Made five Cactus League starts and posted a 0-2 record with a 4.50 ERA (6er, 12.0ip)...he struck out 15 batters over his 13.0 innings of work...in his last Cactus League outing, Roupp gave up three runs over 4.0 innings while taking the loss against the Dodgers...he bounced back in the Giants' 8-2 victory over the Monterrey Sultanes in March 24's exhibition matchup at Oracle Park, tossing 5.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on four hits with six strikeouts.

VS. SAN DIEGO: In his career versus San Diego, Roupp has made seven appearances (four starts), posting a 3.86 ERA (9er, 21.0ip)...he's struggled at Petco Park, going 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA (9er, 8.2ip) and .342 opponents batting average in four outings (two starts)...his last start against the Padres came on August 20, 2025 when he allowed five runs in 2.1 innings of work in the Giants 8-1 loss to the Padres in San Diego.

2025 SEASON: Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

HOME VS. ROAD: Had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park in 2025 compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road...his 2.63 home ERA ranked as the 14th-lowest among NL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched.

THROWING A CURVE: Roupp's curveball was very effective as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate in 2025...he relied on his curveball 35.7% of the time in 2025...opponents hit .305 (84x275) vs. everything else he throws.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...league average in 2025 was 15.8 seconds...when Roupp had runners on, he averaged 16.0 seconds between pitches, still below the league average of 18.7 seconds.

INJURED LIST: Last year, he missed a total of 54 games (approximately nine starts) with right elbow inflammation (missed 19 games) and a left knee inflammation/bone bruise (35 games missed).

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 3/28 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, h, r, k, hr (15 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with Pirates in 2025, 2024 and with Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as a NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
- ▶ Left-handed batters were 7-for-60 (.117) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) off him last season...has held lefties to a .181 clip (67-for-370) in his MLB career.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.00 ERA, 3h, 0r, bb, 8k, 0.67 WHIP (6g)

- ▶ On his fourth career OD roster (also: 2020-2022 with Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Began 2025 on NYY's injured list with left rib fractures...made six rehab appearances before appearing in 12 games with NYY (3.38 ERA, 6er, 16.0ip)...was then DFA'ed on Aug. 5
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.
- ▶ Hasn't allowed HR in his last 33.2 MLB innings dating to Oct. 4, 2022.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.45 ERA, 5h, 4r, 3er, 9bb, 11k (5g)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker, Changeup, Sweeper

Last Game: 3/27 vs. NYY; 0.2ip, 2h, r, er, hr, 2k (17 pitches)

- ▶ On his second career Opening Day roster (also 2025 with NYM).
- ▶ Helped Venezuela win the WBC, tossing 5.2-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit over five games.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Mets on July 30, 2025 as part of the RHP Tyler Rogers trade.
- ▶ Pitched in 21 games for SF last season, going 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10er, 20.0ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19er, 47.0ip), 41 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP in 34 games with the Mets before the trade last season.
- ▶ His 55 appearances in 2025 were by far a career-high after being used as a primarily as a starter prior to the 2024 season.
- ▶ Did not allow a run in 16 of 21 outings w/SF but did allow eight of 16 inherited runners w/SF to score.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 3/28 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, k (8 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- ▶ Signed a MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the majority of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 35.2 innings dating to June 11, 2023.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.84 ERA, 3h, 2r, 2er, 9k (7g)

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 3/25 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ On his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Came back from his injury throwing harder, touching 97.9 mph in his first outing back in Triple-A...spent the remainder of 2025 in the Iowa bullpen...seven of his eight relief outings after being activated were scoreless (4er, 10.1ip).
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.96 ERA, 6h, r, er, 2bb, 11k, 0.86 WHIP

- ▶ Made his third career Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco).
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total including last Monday's exhibition outing vs. Monterrey.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Walked 20 batters in 30.0 innings in 2025 (15.6% walk rate).
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.00 ERA, 2h, 0r, 4k, 0.67 WHIP (3g)

- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Enjoyed his best stretch of the 2025 season from July 4-September 3 where he posted a 1.64 ERA (4er, 22.0ip) in 23 games.

- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.

- ▶ Made his eighth Opening Day roster, second with the Giants.
- ▶ Last season became the first Giants player to reach 30 home runs in a season since **Barry Bonds** had 45 home runs in 2004...he became the first Giants infielder and right-handed hitter to reach 30 homers in a season since **Jeff Kent** (37 homers in 2002).
- ▶ Became one of six players to have three or more seasons with 30+ homers in a season when playing 90% or more of their games as a shortstop, joining **Álex Rodríguez** (seven), **Francisco Lindor** (six), **Miguel Tejada** (four), **Ernie Banks** (four) and **Corey Seager** (three).
- ▶ Led SF with 30 homers and 12 steals, becoming the first SS to lead the Giants in both categories in a season since **George Davis** in 1897.
- ▶ His 142 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's **Francisco Lindor** (139).
- ▶ His 26 go-ahead RBI were fifth-most in the NL last season.

- ▶ Had career best in games (154) and steals (11) in 2025 with SD.
- ▶ Led the NL in hits (181) for a second consecutive year.
- ▶ Spent previous two seasons with the Padres, combining to hit .304 with 102 RBI in 271 games.
