SNAKEBITES

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-1 @ Tigers last night in the series opener.

- Alek Thomas**, in the eighth inning, hit his sixth homer (solo) for the D-backs lone run and first D-backs homer of the road trip (last: July 23 vs. Astros @ Chase Field).
- Ketel Marte** had his fifth multi-hit performance in July...has hit safely in 3 straight games and in 4 of his last 5 games.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** hit safely in his third straight game...has hit safely 6 straight games vs. AL Central opponents and 12 of his last 13 games against the division.
- Kyle Backhus**, in the eighth inning after allowing a leadoff single, proceeded to strike out the side...is scoreless in 11 of his first 14 career games.

PFAADT'S FIRST GO VS. DETROIT: **Brandon Pfaadt** is making his first career start vs. Tigers...he becomes the 20th different D-back starting pitcher to make a start @ Tigers.

- Tigers are his 28th team to face out of the 29 opponents, missing only the Royals.
- In his last 4 interleague starts, is 3-0 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), opponent .250 AVG (26-for-104)/.720 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.

ON-BASE PAIR: Since July 1, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 20 of his 23 games, hitting .310 (26-for-84)/.426 OBP/.417 SLG/.842 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 14 RBI and 14 walks (10 K)...his 43 times on base in the span rank tied for the NL's most with Fernando Tatis Jr./SD and tied for sixth most in the Majors.

- Ketel Marte**, since July 1, has reached base safely in 14 of his 17 games (16 hits, 12 walks, 10 strikeouts) with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 4 RBI.

VS. AL CENTRAL: Since 2019 among NL teams vs. AL Central, the D-backs' .585 win pct. (31-22) ranks fifth, behind the Braves (.720, 36-14), Dodgers (.689, 42-19), Marlins (.600, 33-22) and Padres (.600, 33-22).

TRENDING VS. INTERLEAGUE: **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 4 straight interleague matchups (July 21-23 vs. Astros and July 28 @ Tigers)...has 2 doubles, 2 RBI, 1 walk, 1 stolen base and only 2 strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD: **Ketel Marte**, since June 1, has reached in 21 of his last 24 road games, hitting .363 (33-for-91)/.458 OBP/.670 SLG/1.128 OPS with 7 doubles, 7 homers, 17 RBI and 16 walks (12 K).

- Eugenio Suárez**, since July 7, has reached safely in 8 of his 11 games with 8 hits, including 2 doubles and 3 homers, 6 RBI, 3 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.

LEADERBOARD CHECK-IN: **Eugenio Suárez**, since June 1, ranks among MLB leaders in homers (1st, 21), RBI (1st, 45), extra-base hits (2nd, 28), total bases (2nd, 117), SLG (3rd, .669) and OPS (5th, 1.001).

- Ketel Marte**, since June 1, ranks among MLB leaders in OPS (T-9th, .958) while **Corbin Carroll** ranks in triples (1st, 7).

JULY FREE PASSES: Since July 1, the D-backs' 77 walks rank third in the NL, behind the Braves (85) and Mets (78), while their 8.9 pct. walk rate ranks fifth in the NL, behind the Braves (10.0), Mets (9.6), Cubs (9.1) and Reds (9.0).

CARROLL IS 1 TRIPLE SHY: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of a career high...in the last 10 seasons, since 2016, is 1 of 3 players (also: Jarren Duran/BOS-14 in 2024 and Charlie Blackmon/COL-14 in 2017) with 13+ triples in a season but currently the only one to do so in consecutive seasons (also: 14 in 2024)...since 2010, the most triples in a season was 16 (Jose Reyes/NYM and Shane Victorino/PHI)...since 2008, the most triples in a season was 19 (Reyes/NYM).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers are scoreless in 3 of their last 4 games (8.1 of the 10.1 IP)...in their last 20 games, since July 4, are sixth in the Majors with a 2.72 ERA (18 ER in 59.2 IP) [are scoreless in 12 of those games].

- The D-backs bullpen's 3.01 ERA in July is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).

GENO BACK WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: **Eugenio Suárez** was signed by Tigers as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 9, 2008 [signed by Alejandro Rodriguez] and made his Major League debut with the Tigers on June 4, 2014 vs. Blue Jays.

- On June 7, 2014 vs. Red Sox, he became the 23rd player in franchise history to record a home run for his first Major League hit (solo off John Lester)...on deck, the first person waiting to congratulate him was Miguel Cabrera, his countryman and a player he grew up revering: *"It's a moment I will never forget. And to have Miggy there to be the first person to shake my hand was very special. For all of us, he is not only a great player but a mentor in this game."*

TOREY, THE FORMER TIGER: D-backs manager, **Torey Lovullo**, made his Major League debut with the Tigers on Sept. 10, 1988 @ Yankees, entering the game as a defensive sub (3B) for Tom Brookens in the eighth inning...in his first career at-bat in the ninth inning, hit a 2-out line drive single to right fielder Dave Winfield.

- Lovullo cites Hall of Fame former Tigers manager Sparky Anderson as the biggest influence on his managerial career, telling the Detroit Free Press: *"...one of the things Sparky taught me from Day 1: Your family, your parents are the people that are going to be around to support you, they need to love you the most. My thoughts and strategies of how I get to know the players on that level first...Having conversations beyond the game and asking about parents, children, understanding how important families are."*

TIGER TALES: **Corbin Carroll**, on June 9, 2023 @ Tigers, had his first career 2-homer game, including his first career grand slam, along with a career-best 10 total bases.

- D-backs assistant hitting coach **Damion Easley** played for the Tigers from 1996-2002...he tied Detroit's 9.0-inning record with 6 hits on Aug. 8, 2001 @ Texas (also: Carlos Pena on May 27, 2004 @ Kansas City, George Kell on Sept. 20, 1946 @ Cleveland, Ty Cobb on May 5, 1925 @ Baltimore and Kid Nance on July 13, 1901 vs. Cleveland).
- D-backs first base coach **Dave McKay** made his Major League debut with the Twins on Aug. 22, 1975 vs. Tigers and homered in his first career at-bat (off Vern Ruhle).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (6-2, 3.29)

- On July 25 @ Pirates, tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed the game's lone hit (T. Pham triple in the second) with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings with 2 runs or fewer allowed in 7 of his last 8 starts...since June 13, his 1.99 ERA ranks eighth in MLB among starters.
- Will make his third career start vs. Tigers.

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His 10 wins are tied with Sonny Gray/STL and Nick Pivetta/SD for third in in the NL, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (12) and Matthew Boyd/CHC (11).

- Is the first D-back starting pitcher with 10+ wins in his first 20 starts of a season since Zac Gallen's 11 wins in 20 starts in 2023.
- Is 1 win shy of tying his career high (11).
- Making his 22nd start (11th road start).
- Second consecutive start vs. an AL opponent (last: July 23 vs. Astros).
- In his last 3 starts, is 2-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP), opponent .176 AVG/.492 OPS, 0.74 WHIP, 2 walks and 15 strikeouts.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on July 23 vs. Astros after allowing 2 runs over 5.1 innings on 5 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts.

VS. TIGERS: Making his first career start vs. Tigers.

VS. AL CENTRAL: In 2 career road starts, is 2-0 with a 1.50 (2 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .200 AVG, 0.83 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

- In 3 career starts (D-backs are 3-0), is 2-0 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER in 18.1 IP), opponent .236 AVG, 0.93 WHIP, 3 walks and 16 strikeouts.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: In his last 4 interleague starts, is 3-0 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), opponent .250 AVG (26-for-104)/.720 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD: Had a quality start in his last road start after tossing a career-high 8.0 innings on July 9 @ Padres (2 ER in 8.0 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

- Over his last 3 starts, has gone 1-1 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER in 18.0 IP), opponent .206 AVG, 0.89 WHIP, 2 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- In his first 2 road starts, went 2-0 with a 3.86 ERA (5 ER in 11.2 IP), .250 AVG, 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES: In his last 5 starts, has held righties to a .224 AVG (15-for-67)/.590 OPS with 2 walks and 21 strikeouts.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Throwing his fastball 29.1%...his 93.0 exit velocity is a career-high ahead of 90.3 in 2024 and 91.6 in 2023.

FEW FREE PASSES: Among NL starting pitchers, his 25 walks are fourth fewest, behind Spencer Schwellenbach/ATL (18), Sonny Gray/STL (19) and Nick Lodolo/CIN (23).

- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 14 starts with no walks are third in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (20) and with Sonny Gray/STL(15).

WINNING WAYS: Became the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165) and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season, behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013).

APRIL WAS NO JOKE: Had a career-high 5-game win streak from April 4-April 27.
