◆Twins are 28-16 in their last 44 games since April 22, second most wins in baseball

₱ They have gone 17-6 in their last 23 home games, since April 15...they are 13-5 in their last 18 home games, since April 25.

TEXAS TWO STOMP: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 16-4, Minnesota's most runs allowed this season and largest margin of defeat in 2025...Simeon Woods Richardson (2-3) made his return to the Twins and allowed seven runs (6 earned) on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Byron Buxton...Ty France reached three times, going 2-for-3 with a walk... Matt Wallner hit his fifth home run of the season, his third home run in his last five games.

RANGER DANGER: The Twins have gone 5-3 against the Rangers since the start of last season...the Twins are 10-5 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, that includes a home record of 5-3.

The next series between these two will be a three-game series at Globe Life Field, the penultimate series of the 2025 season and part of the final roadtrip for Minnesota.

♣ Since the start of 2021, 23 of 29 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.

♣ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with two doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.154 OPS in 15 career games vs. Texas.

♣ Carlos Correa has an .848 career OPS in 109 games against the Rangers...in his last six games against Texas, he is hitting .417 (10-for-24) with three doubles, four RBI and a .965 OPS...he has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers, his most against any opponent...21 homers are tied with Shohei Ohtani for the fourth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), Jose Altuve (35) and George Springer (28).

♣ Ty France is hitting .310 (71-for-229) with 10 doubles, 10 homer runs, 35 RBI and an .861 OPS in 60 career games against the Rangers...10 homers are his most against any opponent.

♠ Harrison Bader is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with an .888 OPS in 12 career games against TEX.
 ₱ Trevor Larnach is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with two doubles, two home runs and a .980 OPS in nine career games against Texas.

TWINS CLAIM WENTZ: The Twins have claimed left-handed pitcher Joey Wentz off waivers from the Pirates. Wentz, 27, appeared in 19 games for the Pirates this season, going 2-1, 4.15 ERA (26.0 IP, 12 ER), 11 walks, 22 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP, while holding left-handed batters to a slash line of .225/.311/.350 (.661 OPS) and right-handed batters to .258/.329/.387 (.716 OPS)... he split the 2024 season between the Tigers and Pirates, appearing in a career-high 46 games and striking out 73 batters in 67.1 innings...the 6-foot-5, 220-onul lefty has pitched parts of four major league seasons with the Pirates (2024-25) and Tigers (2022-24), going 8-18, 5.40 ERA (231.2 IP, 139 ER), 104 walks and 220 strikeouts in 97 games (26 starts). ♣ To make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Pablo López to the 60- day Injured List...López was placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 5 with a grade 2 strain of the teres major muscle in his right shoulder...Wentz will report in time for tomorrow afternoon's game against the Texas Rangers, at which point the Twins will make a corresponding 26-man roster move.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 21-straight games... it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023...France's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in baseball...the longest in MLB this season was Kyle Schwarber's 41, from March 27-May 12.

◆ During the streak, France is hitting .329 (26-for-79) with three doubles, one home run, 15 RBI, seven HBP and a .398 on-base percentage.

DON'T STOP BE-LEE-VIN': Brooks Lee has hit safely in 10-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...his previous high for a hitting streak was six, done twice, once in 2024 and once earlier this season...the current streak is the longest by a Twin this season and tied with Vinnie Pasquantino and José Ramírez for the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.
◆ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with one double, one home run and six RBI.

SERIES STUFF: Twins are looking to avoid losing their fourth series in their last five chances... Minnesota is 11-9-1 in series play, going 6-3-1 at home and 5-6-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 10-5-1 in their last 16.

◆ Twins have not lost a series to the Rangers since dropping three of four from August 19-22, 2022 at Target Field...they have since gone 4-0-0 in series play vs. Texas.

JUNE BOOM: Twins offense has scored 5.33 runs-per-game in nine games this month...they scored 4.22 runs-per-game in 27 April games and 4.31 runs-per-game in 26 May games... additionally, their .784 OPS is highest of any month this season (.706 in April and .709 in May).

LEWIS PLAYING LOOSE: Royce Lewis has hit safely in five of his last seven games...over that span, he is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with two doubles, five RBI, five walks, a .520 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a 1.020 OPS...since that date, he has posted a 20.0 walk percentage, which ranks sixth in baseball among players with at least 20 plate appearances...among that same criteria, he has a BB/K ratio of 1.67, seventh-best in the AL.

WALLY BALL: Matt Wallner has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, dating back to April 13...in his last 18 games, dating back to April 6, Wallner is hitting .283 (17-for-60) with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, seven RBI, three HBP, eight walks, a .394 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a .994 OPS.

TOUCHING BASE WITH BUCK: Byron Buxton has posted a .412 on-base percentage in his last 11 games, recording 13 hits and drawing eight walks in 51 plate appearances...in his last three games, he has reached eight times (5 BB, 3 H) in 14 plate appearances (.571 OBP).

Since June 1, he has posted a 18.8 walk percentage, which ranks third in the AL among players with at least 20 plate appearances... among that same criteria, he has a BB/K ratio of 1.50, fourth-best in the AL.

From the leadoff spot this season, he is hitting .284 (23-for-81) with an .883 OPS.

LAST TIME OUT: Last started on June 5 against the Athletics in Sacramento opposite Mitch Spence, his first major league outing since April 23...took the loss in Minnesota's 14-3 defeat...allowed a career-high eight runs on a season-high six hits, including a career-high-tying three home runs, with two walks and six strikeouts over 3.2 innings...allowed four runs in the first inning on two singles, a walk and a home run...five of first six outs recorded were strikeouts...gave up a solo home run, a base hit and a two-run home run to start the third inning...exited the game with two outs and a runner on (BB) in the fourth; runner scored on Tyler Soderstrom's grand slam, allowed by Jorge Alcala in relief.

MAJOR LEAGUE RECAP: Has made 19 appearances (18 starts) at the major league level since his debut on June 27, 2024 at Arizona...was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 5 to fill in for Pablo López, who was placed on the 15-day Injured List with a Grade 2 right teres major strain...Festa's first stint with the Twins this season came in April when López was placed on the IL with a right hamstring strain...made three starts from April 11-23, all at Target Field, going 0-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), five walks and 15 strikeouts.

MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: In six starts with St. Paul this season, went 2-1 with a 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 9 ER), two home runs allowed, four walks and 34 strikeouts...earned his first win of the year as the Opening Day starter for the Saints on March 28; allowed three hits and no walks, striking out four, over 5.0 scoreless innings...after returning to the minor leagues on April 29, went 1-0 in four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), one home run allowed, two walks and 26 strikeouts...did not pitch

between May 6 and May 23 due to right arm fatigue.

The work of the Month for May...made three starts for St. Paul, going 0-0 with a 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER), two walks, 19 strikeouts, a .160 (8-for-50) ent batting average and a .412 opponent OPS.

TRUE OUTCOMES: Since April 16 vs. New York-NL and including his four starts at Triple-A from April 29-May 29, Festa has struck out five-or-more batters in a professional career-high seven consecutive starts...previous high was five-straight games, which he accomplished three times: twice in 2024 with St. Paul and once in 2023 with Wichita...his 10.68 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings in 17 MLB starts ranks 15th among pitchers with 75.0-or-more innings pitched as a starter since 2024.

◆ Has allowed a home run in eight of his 18 major league appearances...his 1.33 home runsper-9.0 innings pitched rank 15th-most among pitchers with between 75.0 and 100.0 innings pitched since 2024.

FACING THE RANGERS: Is facing the Rangers for the second time in his career...first outing came on August 17, 2024 at Globe Life Field...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 victory; allowed two runs on six hits, including two doubles, while walking none and striking out six over 5.0

anowed two tins of six first, including two doubles, while waiting note and striking lost six over 3.0 innings...after today, the Rangers will be the third team Festa has faced more than once in his career (Detroit and New York-NL, twice apiece).

◆ In three career starts against the American League West (8/17/24 at Texas, 9/9/24 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 6/5/25 at Athletics), is 0-2 with a 9.95 ERA (12.2 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, finally and 10 stylengths. five walks and 16 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In three home starts this season, is 0-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), five walks and 15 strikeouts...in 11 career appearances (10 starts) at Target Field, is 0-4 with a 4.75 ERA (47.1 IP, 25 ER), seven home runs, 20 walks and 56 strikeouts, compared to 2-3 with a 5.35 ERA (33.2 IP, 20 ER), five home runs, 10 walks and 42 strikeouts in seven road starts...Twins are 4-7 in Festa's home appearances.

 ♣ In his career at Target Field, he has a .254 (47-for-185) opponent batting average, a .335 opponent on-base percentage and an .800 opponent OPS, compared to a .250 (33-for-132) BAA, a .308 OBP and a .702 OPS on the road.

- ◆ Infloring his first four major league starts this year (304 pitches), restains a 24.5 percent chase rate, a 25.7 percent whiff rate and a 44.4 percent hard hit rate with an average exit velocity of 91.1 mph...batters are striking out 28.0 percent of the time and walking 9.3 percent of the time.
 ♦ In 14 games (13 starts) in 2024, Festa's fastball velocity averaged 94.7 mph, while his offspeed velocity averaged 88.4 mph and his breaking velocity averaged 86.1 mph...he posted a 27.8 percent strikeout rate and a 8.3 percent walk rate, with a 28.4 percent whiff rate.
