NATIONALS NEWS

BELTWAY SERIES

The Washington Nationals opened the 2026 Beltway Series with a 3-2 win over the Baltimore Orioles on Friday night in front of a sellout crowd at Nationals Park.

- The Nationals are 8-3 (.727) against the Orioles since the start of the 2024 season...Washington has outscored Baltimore 58-34 and has pitched to a 2.67 ERA during this 11-game stretch.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won three of four, six of nine, seven of 11 and 11 of 18 games since April 25...They have won four of their last six series...The Nationals won four of their last five home games.

- Washington leads Major League Baseball with 14 wins (14-15, .485) against teams with records of .500 or better...Washington's 29 games against teams with a record of .500 or better lead the league.
- Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team.

HOMER HAPPY

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 16 home runs in nine games since May 6, ahead of the Philadelphia Phillies (15), Chicago White Sox (14) and Los Angeles Dodgers (14)...The Nationals have homered at least once in seven of the nine games.

- Daylen Lile's four homers are tied for third in Major League Baseball over this stretch.

SPEAKING OF DAYLEN...

Daylen Lile is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with an .811 slugging percentage (4 2B, 4 HR) with 10 RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and eight runs scored in his last 10 games...He's hit safely in eight of the 10 and has reached safely in nine of the 10.

- Lile is 10-for-21 (.476) with two doubles and four homers (1.143 SLG) in his last five games.
- Thanks to this stretch, Lile is now tied for third in the National League with 12 doubles.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 20-for-61 (.328) with five doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 11 runs in his last 16 games...He's reached safely in 13 of the 16 (.397 OBP) and is slugging .541 during the stretch.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (4th, 36), on-base percentage (5th, .387), OPS (9th, .912), wRC+ (9th, 155) and wOBA (9th, .397).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 239 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 87 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 26 times this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.3 MPH ahead of O'Neil Cruz (95.9).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with Yordan Alvarez (3) and O'Neil Cruz (3).
- Wood's 53 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for third in Major League Baseball.

ACE OF BASES

The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams as a club, according to Baseball Savant...They are tied for the Major League lead with five baserunning runs (A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths)...The Nationals are tied with the Boston Red Sox (5).

- Nasim Nuñez is tied for the Major League lead with three baserunning runs...His 18 stolen bases are the most in the National League and tied for the most in baseball with Cleveland's Jose Ramirez.

THAT LITTLE GUY? I WOULDN'T WORRY ABOUT THAT LITTLE GUY

Removing the 15 runs allowed on May 15 at Cincinnati, Simon Mathews' pitching staff has pitched to a 3.29 ERA (56 ER/153.0 IP) since April 25...Washington is 11-7 (.611) during this stretch...In the 11 wins, the staff has recorded a 2.47 ERA (28 ER/102.0 IP) and a .201 opponents' average with just six home runs allowed.

- The starters ranked third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a 3.07 ERA from April 24 to May 12.

FARM REPORT

YOOOOOOO

Rochester first/third baseman Yohandy Morales has five-straight multi-hit efforts and has hit safely in seven straight games overall...The five-game multi-hit streak is tied for the second-longest active streak in Minor League Baseball...During the seven-game hitting streak, he is 15-for-26 (.557) with five doubles, four homers, nine RBI, five walks, one stolen base and 10 runs scored...He's 13-for-19 (.684) with five doubles and three homers during the multi-hit game streak.

STREA-KING

Harrisburg shortstop Seaver King has reached base safely in all 33 games this season, tied for the third-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and tied for the third-longest active streak.

A switch-hitting catcher, his 47 home runs with the Nationals, second-most among catchers in National history (2005-pres.) behind Wilson Ramos (83 from 2010-16).

- His pinch-hit, two-run single on 4/12 at Milwaukee put Washington ahead, 8-6.
- Finished 3-for-4 with 2 2B, HR, 3R and 4 RBI on 5/7 vs. MIN...Became just the third catcher in Nationals history (2005-pres) to record a three-extra-base hit game
- Ranks 6th in MLB with a 10.9% strikeout rate over the last 6 Major League seasons (2021-pres.).
