THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Washing-
ton and 1-2 vs. Boston), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive losses to the
Guardians the last two nightstoday, they will play the three-game series finale in Cleveland
after today's game, they will travel to Detroit to play the Tigers from Monday-Wednesday

ANOTHER ONE-RUN DEFEAT IN THE 'LAND: The Twins lost to the Guardians by a score of 5-4 yesterday at Progressive Field...Bailey Ober made his return from the IL (left hip impingement) and started, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...three of his four runs allowed came on home runs from Daniel Schneeman (solo) and José Ramírez (2-run)...Pierson Ohl (0-2) was issued the loss in his second career appearance (first in relief), allowing one run on four hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, two apiece from Trevor Larnach and Royce Lewis...Matt Wallner hit his 14th home run tying his single-season career high, also done in 2023.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the ninth of 13 games in 2025...

Twins have gone 2-6 this season, going 1-1 at Target Field and 1-5 at Progressive Field.

◆ Today marks the final game for Minnesota in Cleveland this season...Iwins need a win today to avoid tying the club mark for fewest wins they've ever had at Progressive Field in a single season, previously done in 2024 (1-6), 1994 (1-5), 2020 (1-2) and 1996 (1-6).

◆ Five of the eight games this season between these two teams have been decided by one run...the Twins have gone 1-4 in those games.

◆ Since the start of 2024, 15 of the 21 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 2-13 in those)...and 10 have been decided by one run (Twins 1-9).

◆ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 74 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

◆ Royce Lewis is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with one home run, four walks, seven RBI, a .429 on-base percentage and a .912 OPS in nine career games at Progressive Field.

◆ Matt Wallner is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with three home runs, eight RBI and a .956 OPS in 13 career games at CLE.

◆ Austin Martin is hitting .500 (5-for-10) in six career games against the Guardians.

THIS IS A STORY ABOUT U: José Ureña had his contract selected on Friday to fill roster spots after the trade deadline...Ureña, who was signed by the Twins on a minor league contract on June 24, pitched in six games (4 starts) for the Saints this season, going 0-1, 4.05 ERA (13.1 IP, 6 ER), with 10 walks and 13 strikeouts...the 33-year-old has pitched in parts of 11 seasons in the majors with Miami (2015-20), Detroit (2021), Milwaukee (2022), Colorado (2022-23), Chicago-AL (2023), Texas (2024), New York-NL (2025), Toronto (2025) and Los Angeles-NL (2025), and has posted a career record of 44-77, 4.78 ERA (966-2 IP, 513 ER), with six saves, 359 walks and 645 strikeouts in 241 games (154 starts)...in nine major league games (2 starts) for the Mets, Blue Jays and Dodgers this season, Ureña allowed 11 runs on 23 hits in 18.1 innings pitched, with five walks and 10 strikeouts.

♣ Ureña's last major league start was on May 11 at Seattle, with Toronto, allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 innings pitched, serving as the opener that day for Eric Lauer.

♣ His last major league appearance was on June 5 vs. New York-NL, with the Dodgers, allowing one run on three hits in 2.1 relief innings pitched.

♣ His last appearance on a mound was for the Saints in a start last Saturday, July 26, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and four strikeouts.

JEFF YEAH: Over his last 17 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .362 (21-for-58) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, a .403 on-base percentage, a .483 slugging percentage and an .886 OPS...in those 17, he has reached safely in 13.

AUSTIN POWER: Dating back to August 19, 2024, Austin Martin is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with seven doubles, five RBI, four walks, a .362 on-base percentage and a .784 OPS in 23 games for the Twins...he has multiple hits in three of his last five major league games.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Today marks the 21st time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 7-13 against lefty starters...their last game against at lefty starter was July 26 against Mitchell Parker, losing by a score of 9-3...their last win over a lefty starter was the previous day against MacKenzie Gore, winning by a score of 1-0.

◆ Twins as a team have an OPS of .805 over their last 15 games against left-handed pitching.

◆ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .347 (10-for-28) with a .973 OPS in his last 17 games vs. lefties.

◆ Brooks Lee is hitting .381 (16-for-42) with a .970 OPS in his last 23 games vs. lefties.

◆ Royce Lewis is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with two home runs, a .515 slugging percentage and an .867 OPS in his last 18 games vs. lefties.

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time this season...the other four were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15) and three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22)...

Atlanta (April 10-20), three games at riscosa. Using 20-22).

© Other than those four sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale down 0-2 and avoided a sweep four times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati and July 20 at Colorado.

© The last time the Twins were swept by the Guardians was in three games at Progressive Field, from May 17-19, 2024.

REHAB UPDATE: Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) played in his 13th game on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo last night, going 2-for-3 with a single, a triple and a walk.

TWINS Milb WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Marco Raya and Double-A Wichita outfielder Walker Jenkins Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

Raya, 22, made the start for the Saints on Thursday at Toledo, allowing two runs on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the club's 14th-ranked prospect (6th pitcher) was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United South High School in Laredo, Texas.

Jenkins, 20, played in five games for the Wind Surge, hitting. 412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, two home runs, three RBI, three walks and a 1.359 OPS...the club's top prospect was selected by the Twins fifth overall in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of South Brunswick HS in Southport, North Carolina.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY, 2019 EDITION: Former Twins closer Joe Nathan was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame in a special pre-game ceremony...later that day, Nelson Cruz hit three home runs against Kansas City, becoming the 23rd player in baseball history with multiple three-homer games in a season (first in Twins history)...also, the first in MLB history with multiple after turning 39...he joined Doug DeCinces (8/3 & 8, 1982) and Johnny Mize (7/13 & 20, 1938) as the only players to homer three times twice within 10 days (homering 9 days earlier against the White Sox).

LAST TIME OUT: Started Saturday with Triple-A St. Paul against Worcester and turned in his longest outing with the Saints since being stretched out as a starter...pitched around two walks and a hit by pitch before conceding his first hit with two outs in the third inning, an infield single off the bat of Kristian Campbell...threw up four zeroes before handing off a 2-0 lead to the bullpen...threw 26 sinkers (44%), 23 sliders (39%), seven four-seamers (12%) and three changeups (5%) while generating five swings-and-misses, led by three on the slider...recorded two of his four strikeouts on the slider and one each on the changeup and sinker. generating five swings-and-minsses, led by times on the slider and one each on the changeup and sinker.

TWO APPEARANCES AGO: Pitched for the Saints on July 20 at Louisville, opposite Brain Van Belle, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 6-1 victory over the Bats...allowed four hits with one walk and two strikeouts in 3.0 shutout innings of work...permitted a double to Ryan Vilade in the first, singles to Trey Faltine and Blake Dunn in the third and a single to Christian Encarnacion-Strand in the fourth.

LAST TIME OUT IN THE MAJORS: Last pitched in the majors on June 5 with the Los Angeles Dodgers... replaced Jack Dreyer in the sixth; allowed one run on three hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 2.1 innings before being replaced by Alex Vesia in the eighth.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: After signing a one-year minor league contract with the New York Mets in February, Ureña is pitching for his fourth different organization already...after starting the year on the development list for Triple-A Syracuse, Ureña was activated to Syracuse's roster before making three appearances in the International League before a big league call-up...he would pitch in just one game for New York before being designated for assignment...because of his over eight years of MLB service time, he elected free agency rather than accept an assignment to Triple-A and has bounced around between the Blue Jays and Dodgers since, each time being DFA'd and electing free agency to sign with another club...over the past four seasons (2022-25), Ureña has been DFA'd or released a combined six times and pitched for nine different organizations (7 of them in the majors)...over his 17-year professional career, he's pitched for nine different MLB franchises and pitched for 33 different clubs between the major leagues, minor leagues and winter ball teams following his first appearance as a St. Paul Saint

GUARDING CLEVELAND: Ureña is facing the Cleveland Guardians for the fourth time in his career... all three of his previous starts against the Guards came in 2021 (with Detroit)...has gone 0-1, posting a 3.95 ERA (13.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 11 strikeouts and a .229 (11-for-48) opponent batting average

The Astraced Cleveland on June 30, 2021 at Progressive Field where he did not factor into the decision of the Tigers 9-4 victory...allowed four runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 3.1 innings of work.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ureña has gone 16-46 with a 4.62 ERA (498.2 IP, 256 ER), 6.08 K/9, 3.16 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 120 games (79 starts) at home compared to 28-31 with a 4.94 ERA (468.0 IP, 257 ER), 5.92 K/9, 3.54 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 121 road games (75 starts).

◆ He is 0-0 in five games at home so far this season with a 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP, 3ER), two walks and five strikeouts; compared to 0-0 with a 6.97 ERA (10.1, 8 ER), one save, three walks and five

strikeouts in four games (2 starts) on the road.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through nine major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .243/.317/.541 in 37 at-bats vs. Ureña, while righties have slashed .350/.366/.550 in 40 at-bats... lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 90.8 mph and a whiff rate of 17.3; compared to righties' 86.3 mph and 17.8 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ureña has used a four-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at
