SNAKEBITES

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 1-0 @ Pirates in 11.0 innings last night after D-backs' pitchers **Ryne Nelson** (6.0 IP, 1 H), **Anthony DeSclafani** (4.0 IP, 0 H) and **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP, 0 H) combined to allow just 1 hit for their fourth extra-inning win...the game's lone run was produced in the top of the 11th via a **Eugenio Suárez** 1-out sacrifice fly to right field to plate **Corbin Carroll**.

- Ryne Nelson** tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed the game's lone hit (T. Pham triple in the second) with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts...has tossed 6.0+ innings with 2 runs or fewer allowed in 7 of his last 8 starts...since June 13 date, his 1.99 ERA ranks eighth in the Majors among starters.
- Anthony DeSclafani** tossed 4.0 scoreless and hitless innings (innings 7-10) to earn his first win as a D-back...became the seventh D-back reliever pitch 4.0+ innings from the seventh inning on and first since 2019 (Jon Duplantier on April 28, 2019 vs. Cubs)...is the third MLB reliever to do so since 2022 (also: Michael Soroka/CWS on June 30, 2024 and Génesis Cabrera/STL on June 5, 2022).
- **Fun Fact:** *Josh Collmenter is the only D-back reliever with multiple 4.0+-inning appearances from the seventh inning on - all in 2013: April 3 vs. Cardinals, June 4 @ Cardinals and July 10 vs. Dodgers.*
- Kevin Ginkel** collected his third save after facing the minimum in the bottom of the 11th.
- Ketel Marte** played his 1,000th game as a D-back to become the third D-back all-time to reach the feat, joining Paul Goldschmidt (1,092) and Luis Gonzalez (1,194).

ANOTHER HISTORIC D-BACKS GAME @ PNC: Last night, the D-backs became the only team since 1900 to win a 1-0 game in 11.0+ innings while allowing only 1 or no hits (source: @OptaSTATS)...additionally, it was the:

- First-ever D-backs extra-inning 1-0 win where the lone run was produced by a sacrifice fly.
- Fourth extra-inning 1-0 win in franchise history...also:
 - Aug. 13, 2014 vs. Indians [GM 2] (W 1-0 in 12.0 innings)
 - June 13, 2008 vs. Royals (W 1-0 in 10.0 innings)
 - May 29, 2001 @ Giants (W 1-0 in 18.0 innings)
- Fourth game in franchise history with 11.0+ shutout innings...also:
 - April 30, 2017 vs. Rockies (W 2-0 in 13.0 innings)
 - Aug. 13, 2014 vs. Indians [GM 2] (W 1-0 in 12.0 innings)
 - May 29, 2001 @ Giants (W 1-0 in 18.0 innings)
- Third MLB team this season to win an extra-inning game 1-0 on a sacrifice fly (also: Padres @ Giants/10.0 innings on June 2 and Cubs vs. Guardians/10.0 innings on July 3).
- Fourth MLB game this season to go scoreless thru 10.0 innings.
- 15th game in franchise history where the D-backs and their opponent went scoreless in regulation (9.0 innings)...last on June 14, 2022 vs. Reds (L, 3-5, 12.0 innings).
- Second game in franchise history where the D-backs allowed only 1 hit in a scoreless game thru 9.0 innings (also: May 28, 2002 vs. Giants; L, 0-1 in 10.0 innings).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Brandyn Garcia (No.55)** from Triple-A Reno and designated RHP **Trevor Richards** for assignment.

SUÁREZ INCLUDED IN MORE MLB HISTORY: With Nick Kurtz's/ATH 4-homer game last night, he and **Eugenio Suárez** are 1 of 3 pairs in MLB history to reach the feat in the same season...Arizona is the only team with multiple players:
2025: **Eugenio Suarez/AZ**, Nick Kurtz/ATH
2017: Scooter Gennett/CIN, **J.D. Martinez/AZ**
2002: Mike Cameron/SEA, Shawn Green/LAD

ALL-IN PITCHING: Since July 13, D-backs pitchers' (starters + relievers) 2.55 ERA (21 ER in 74.0 IP) is the fourth lowest in the Majors, behind the Rangers (1.38), Brewers (2.41) and Marlins (2.47).

- It is the D-backs' lowest ERA in an 8-game span in a season since their 2.49 ERA from July 10-21, 2024.

STARTING RHYTHM: D-backs' starting pitchers are 5-3 with a 2.27 ERA (12 ER in 47.2 IP), opponent .181 AVG/.556 OPS, 1.01 WHIP and 39 strikeouts in their last 8 games.

- Arizona starters, since July 13, rank among the NL in ERA (1st, 2.27), innings (1st, 47.2), innings per game (1st, 6.0), quality starts (T-1st, 5 with Pirates), fewest hits (T-1st, 31 with Brewers) and WHIP (3rd, 1.01).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers, in their last 17 games since July 4, are fifth in the NL with a 2.65 ERA (16 ER in 54.1 IP)...are scoreless in 10 of the games and limited to 1 run in 2 of the games.

- The D-backs bullpen's 2.98 ERA in July is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).

CARROLL IS 1 TRIPLE SHY: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of a career high...in the last 10 seasons, since 2016, is 1 of 3 players (also: Jarren Duran/BOS-14 in 2024 and Charlie Blackmon/COL-14 in 2017) with 13+ triples in a season but currently the only one to do so in consecutive seasons (also: 14 in 2024)...since 2010, the most triples in a season was 16 (Jose Reyes/NYM and Shane Victorino/PHI)...since 2008, the most triples in a season was 19 (Reyes/NYM).

WATCH OUT FOR PERDOMO: Since the All-Star break, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached safely in all 7 games (with hits in 5 of his 6 games), hitting a NL-best .464 (13-for-28)/.500 OBP/.607 SLG/1.107 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 7 RBI, 2 walks and 2 stolen bases.

- Post-All-Star, leads the NL with 13 hits, ahead of Willson Contreras/STL (12) and Luis Arráez/SD (12).
- Has a 12-game on-base streak, since July 9, batting .370 (17-for-46)/.463 OBP/.565 SLG/1.028 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 12 RBI, 7 walks (3 K), 1 hit-by-pitch and 2 stolen bases.

10-20-30-40 CLUB: The D-backs (**Corbin Carroll** and **Ketel Marte**) are 1 of 3 teams with 2+ players with respective seasons of 10+ doubles, 20+ homers, 30+ walks and 40+ RBI (also: Mets/Pete Alonso-Juan Soto-Francisco Lindor and Cubs/Michael Busch-Seiya Suzuki)

VS. PIRATES: Since 2022, the D-backs are 14-9 (.609) vs. Pirates, including 6-4 on the road.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 10 games vs. Pirates, is hitting .382 (13-for-34)/.432 OBP/.500 SLG/.932 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 2 walks.
- Ketel Marte**, in his last 8 games vs. Pirates, has a .750 SLG/1.121 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers and 10 RBI.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (7-11, 5.58)

- On July 21 vs. Astros (L; 6 ER in 6.0 IP), recorded his 1,000th career strikeout in the fourth inning.
- Will make his seventh career start vs. Pirates...first start @ PNC Park since May 19, 2023 (L; 5 ER in 3.2 IP)...has won each of his 2 quality bids in his last 3 starts (July 26, 2024/3 ER in 6.0 IP, and July 7, 2023/1 ER in 7.0 IP).
