SNAKEBITES

**RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K REGISTRATION NOW OPEN:** The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefiting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...register at [dbacks.com/race](https://dbacks.com/race).

- SNAKE BITES:** Since August 1, the D-backs’ 23-17 (.575) record is the third-best record in the NL, behind the Phillies (28-13, .683) and Brewers (27-14, .659).
- The D-backs currently face the fourth-hardest remaining strength of schedule: Cardinals (.551), Rays (.547), Twins (.546) and **D-backs (.544)**.
  - On August 1, the D-backs were a season-high 13.0 games back in the division and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card...now the D-backs are 9.5 back in the division and 2.0 back in the NL Wild Card...their final 4 series (12 games) are against division leaders or teams in the Wild Card race (Giants, Phillies, Dodgers, Padres).
  - The D-backs have won 10 of their last 16 games, since Aug. 27.
  - Have won or split 6 of their last 7 series...have 8 series wins in their last 12.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs secured their second all-time win at Target Field with a 5-2 win @ Twins.

- Ryne Nelson** threw 6.0 shutout innings, improving his ERA to 2.76 (30 ER in 98.0 IP) over his last 17 starts since June 13.
- Gabriel Moreno** recorded his fifth consecutive multi-hit game since Sept. 7, tied for the longest streak by a D-backs player since 2020.
- Blaze Alexander** recorded a 2-run double in the 10th inning...he now has 13 RBI in his last 20 games since Aug. 23.

**VS. TWINS:** This is the D-backs sixth road series @ Twins (last: Aug. 4-6, 2023...2017, 2014, 2008 and 2003), fourth at Target Field (opened in 2010).

- The D-backs’ win last night was their first @ Twins since Sept. 22, 2014 and only won their first-ever series from June 13-15, 2003 (2-1).
- James McCann**, who played in the AL Central for the Tigers (2014-18) and White Sox (2019-20) for 7 seasons, has tallied 27 career extra-base hits vs. Twins, notching 14 doubles, 1 triple and 12 home runs (.466 SLG).

- START ME UP:** D-backs starters, in their last 16 games, are 8-1 with a 2.84 ERA (29 ER in 92.0 IP), an opponent .241 AVG, 27 walks and 69 strikeouts... since Aug. 27, their 9 wins are tied for third in the Majors behind the Phillies (9) and Yankees (9), while their 2.66 ERA is third in the Majors behind the Yankees (2.36) and Pirates (2.74).
- This 16-game stretch has come against opponents with a combined .532 winning percentage (Brewers, Dodgers, Rangers, Red Sox, Giants, Twins).
  - The starting rotation has posted quality starts in 8 of their last 11 games, 10 of their last 14 and 11 of their last 16.
  - D-backs starting pitchers’ streak of 6 straight quality starts from Sept. 1-7 tied their longest since 2017 (also: 6 from April 8-15, 2025), behind 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

- HIT, RUN, SCORE:** Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.35 runs per game rank fifth in MLB, behind the Mets (5.82), Yankees (5.55), Brewers (5.43) and Phillies (5.43).
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 85 RBI with 2 outs rank second in MLB, behind the Phillies (99).
  - Since August 1, the D-backs’ 53 runs scored in innings 1-2 are second most in the NL behind only the Mets (58).
  - The D-backs lead the Majors with 46 homers this season in the 8th inning or later...Arizona’s 171 runs in the 8th inning or later lead the NL and are second-most in the Majors behind the Blue Jays (177).
  - Over their last 8 games since Sept. 5, D-backs 6-9 hitters have combined to hit .281 (34-for-121)/.720 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 20 RBI.

- YEAR OF THE SNAKE:** **Geraldo Perdomo** leads all NL position players and ranks second in the Majors with a 6.3 bWAR (Wins Above Replacement, according to Baseball-Reference.com) to Aaron Judge/NYY (8.1).
- His 6.3 bWAR is tied for the eighth by a D-backs’ position player and is the highest since Ketel Marte’s 6.8 bWAR last season en route to finishing third in the NL MVP race.
  - Among NL players, ranks third in OBP (.387), fifth in RBI (95) and walks (87), sixth in AVG (.286) and tied for sixth in hits (156).

- COUPLE OF THIEVES:** **Corbin Carroll** (28 SB) and **Geraldo Perdomo** (26 SB) are looking at becoming the second D-backs teammates with 30+ stolen bases in a season: 2016’s Jean Segura (33) and Paul Goldschmidt (32).
- Perdomo, with 19 home runs, and Carroll would be just the seventh set of teammates all-time to record 20+--homer, 30+--stolen base seasons, joining Goldschmidt and Segura in 2016, Jose Cruz and Raul Mondesi/TOR in 2001, Jeff Bagwell and Craig Biggio/HOU in 1997, Dante Bichette and Ellis Burks/COL in 1996, Howard Johnson and Darryl Strawberry/NYM in 1987 and Barry Bonds and Andy Van Slyke/PIT in 1987.

- PERDOMO NEARING A CENTURY OF RBI:** **Geraldo Perdomo** is now 5 RBI shy of his first career 100 RBI season and looks to become the first player since Carlos Gonzalez in 2009-2010 with a season of 100+ RBI the year following recording 40 or fewer RBI with 300+ PA (100 RBI rookie seasons excluded)[source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Others to accomplish this feat: J.D. Drew/LAD (2005-06), Mike Sweeney/KC (1998-99), Danny Tartabull/3 teams (1995-96), Jim Edmonds/CAL (1994-95), Phil Plantier/BOS-SD (1992-93), Glenn Wilson/PHI (1984-85), Don Mattingly/NYY (1983-84), Hal McRae/KC (1981-82), Dick Dietz/SF (1969-70), Roy Sievers/SLB-WSH (1953-54), Ed Morgan/CLE (1929-30).

- CARROLL REACHES 100 RUNS:** **Corbin Carroll**, with 1 run scored last night, became the third D-back all-time to collect 3+ straight seasons of 100+ runs (also: 121 in 2024, 116 in 2023), joining Luis Gonzalez (1999-2001) and Paul Goldschmidt (2015-17) [never done 4 straight].
- Carroll joins Shohei Ohtani/LAD, Francisco Lindor/NYM and Kyle Schwarber/PHI as the only players with 100+ runs in each of the last 3 seasons.

- CARROLL’S EXTRA BASES:** **Corbin Carroll** has a MLB third-best 75 extra-base hits, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (78) and Aaron Judge/NYY (77)...no D-back has ever led a MLB season in the category.
- His 75 extra-base hits are tied for ninth in franchise history in a single season (with 4 others), behind Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001), Gonzalez (80 in 2000), Ketel Marte (77 in 2019), Gonzalez (76 in 2003), Aaron Hill (76 in 2012), Stephen Drew (76 in 2008), Steve Finley (76 in 1999) and Jay Bell (76 in 1999).

- CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON:** **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 28 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back with a 30+--HR/30+--SB season...since his debut in 2022, only 7 players have accomplished the feat: Juan Soto/NYM (2025), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).

**ON-DECK: SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS:** The D-backs return home vs. Giants in a pivotal 3-game series in the NL Wild Card race...the D-backs are 5-5 vs. Giants (2-2 at home).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (11-14, 4.84)

- Is 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA (15 ER in 47.2 IP), 36 strikeouts and 13 walks in his last 8 starts since Aug. 2.
- Is 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER in 13.2 IP) in 2 starts vs. Giants this season...is 7-6 with a 3.94 ERA (45 ER in 102.2 IP) in 18 career starts vs. San Francisco.

**AT A GLANCE:** Second stint with the D-backs (also: 2023 for 1 game).

- Native of Barranquilla, Colombia was born on Christmas Day, December 25, 1994.
- Has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with the Cardinals (2020), Padres (2021-23), D-backs (2023), Dodgers (2024) and D-backs (2025).
- Made his Major League debut, with Cardinals, on Aug. 17, 2020 (GM 2) vs. Cubs (0 ER in 1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 2 K).
- Recorded his first Major League win on April 22, 2021 @ Dodgers (0 ER in 0.2 IP, 2 H, 0 BB, 0 K).
- Signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on May 31, 2012.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Making his sixth appearance and fifth start with the D-backs.

- In 4 starts, is 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 21.0 IP), an opponent .289 AVG (24-for-88), 4 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 3-2 in his 5 games (4 starts) and have scored 5+ runs in each of their 3 wins.
- Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs over 4.0+ innings in 4 of his 5 games this season.
- Spanning parts of his previous 3 starts -- Aug. 28 @ Brewers, Sept. 2 vs. Rangers and Sept. 8 @ Giants -- held opponents scoreless in 9 of 11 innings, allowing 2 runs in 10.0 innings on 11 hits, 1 walk and 5 strikeouts...allowed 1 run in each of the third and fourth innings on Sept. 2 vs. Rangers.
- Appeared in 1 game with the D-backs in 2023, on Aug. 26 vs. Reds, allowing 1 unearned run in 2.0 innings in relief (2 H, 0 BB, 3 K).

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the decision on Sept. 8 in an 11-5 loss @ Giants (4 ER in 4.0 IP, 6 H, 1 BB, 3 K).

- Eclipsed 200.0 career innings.

**QUALITY START:** Tossed his first career quality start (in his fourth career start) on Sept. 2 en route to a 5-3 win vs. Rangers...in a career-best 6.1 innings, allowed 2 runs on 7 hits and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts.

**COLOMBIAN-BORN STARTERS FACE OFF:** His start against fellow Colombian José Quintana on August 28 @ Brewers was just the third Major League game all-time with Colombian-born starting pitchers facing off [h/t D-backs Spanish Broadcaster Oscar Soria] [confirmed by source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

**83+ PITCHES IN RELIEF:** Threw 83 pitches (52 strikes) over 4.0 shutout frames (4 H, 3 BB, 4 K) in the 10-1 win vs. Reds on Aug. 23.

- Became the seventh D-backs reliever all-time (eighth time) to throw 83+ pitches in a game and first since Ryne Nelson on May 22, 2024 @ Dodgers (86 pitches).

**SOFT CONTACT:** Among starters since Aug. 1 (min. 4 GS), his 86.8 MPH average exit velocity is tied for 15th lowest, with Nathan Eovaldi/TEX (86.8) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (86.8) behind Quinn Priester/MIL (86.5), Tarik Skubal/DET (86.4), Tyler Glasnow/LAD (86.4), Paul Skenes/PIT (86.2) and Yu Darvish/SD (86.1)...leader is Jack Perkins/ATH (84.4).

**2025 IN THE MINORS:** Began the season with the Phillies’Triple-A Lehigh Valley and in 19 starts, went 5-6 with a 4.04 ERA (45 ER in 100.1 IP), opponent .253 AVG (99-for-391), 25 walks and 68 strikeouts.

- Released on Aug. 4 by Lehigh Valley.
- Signed by the D-backs as a Minor League free agent on Aug. 9 and made 1 start for Triple-A Reno on Aug. 13 vs. El Paso (0 ER in 2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 2 K).
- Overall, held lefties to a .198 AVG (38-for-192) with 16 walks and 34 strikeouts.
