RECENT REDBIRDS: The defending 2019 National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals continue a 10-day, 13-game road trip through Milwaukee (5G, 2-3), Pittsburgh (5G) and Kansas City (3G) with a single nine-inning game to open a five-game series at Pittsburgh tonight...entering play today, the Cardinals are 22-23 and reside 5.5 games behind Chicago. They are tied for second place, one percentage point behind Cincinnati.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals arrived at their team hotel in Pittsburgh at 2:00 a.m., Eastern Time last night following a doubleheader at Milwaukee yesterday. **Adam Wainwright** threw his 24th career complete game as St. Louis rallied for a 4-2 win in game one, while the Cardinals fell behind early and lost the nightcap 6-0 despite only needing two outs from their bullpen in the pair of games.

A TEAM OF DESTINY: Despite not having Chicago or Cincinnati remaining on their schedule, the Cardinals still control their own destiny despite being outside the postseason standings if the season ended today. St. Louis resides three games up on Cincinnati in the loss column due to having 13 (15, if necessary) games remaining, while the Reds have nine (tied with the Padres for the fewest remaining scheduled games in the National League).

REMAINING SCHEDULE: The Cardinals have three opponents (with two "if necessary" rescheduled games at Detroit) with sub-.500 records (Pittsburgh 14-34, Kansas City 21-29, Milwaukee 23-26) on their schedule. The breakdown continues with eight on the road, five at Busch Stadium and four will be scheduled seven-inning doubleheader contests.

EXPANDED POSSIBILITIES: With eight teams making the National League postseason this year, the Cardinals have a better chance than most years. However, no Cardinals team has ever made the postseason with a sub-.500 record after September 16 and only three teams in MLB history have prior to this season. The 2005 San Diego Padres were 78-79 on Sept. 27, the 1973 New York Mets were 76-77 on Sept. 20 and the 1981 Kansas City Royals were 48-51 on Sept. 30, but won the first half during the strike season. *Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau*

GIMME' FIVE! Today opens the second straight five-game series for the Cardinals after going 2-3 in Milwaukee. The Cardinals play a five-game series at Pittsburgh and will end the season with a five-game series against Milwaukee at Busch Stadium. The last time the Cardinals played back-to-back five-game series was 1962 when they played five games at Philadelphia (June 22-24) followed by five in Chicago (June 25-28). St. Louis was 3-2 against the Phillies and 4-1 against the Cubs, ending a 16-game road trip that started with six games in San Francisco and Los Angeles. *Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau*

"GO THE DISTANCE..." In game one of yesterday's doubleheader with Milwaukee, **Adam Wainwright** tied his season-high with nine strikeouts en route to his second complete game of the season. The 39-year old Wainwright has posted multiple complete games for the first time since 2014 and is the first Cardinals pitcher over the age of 39 to do so since **Jim Kaat** went the distance six times in 1980. The last few pitchers over 39 to accomplish the feat in MLB were **R.A. Dickey** (2015, 2 CG), **Bartolo Colon** (2013, 3 CG) and **Jamie Moyer** (2010, 2 CG). *Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau*

GIBBY, LEFTY & WAINO: With his 7.0-inning, nine strikeout performance yesterday, **Adam Wainwright** recorded his 23rd career performance with those numbers. Only **Bob Gibson** (104) and **Steve Carlton** (26) have posted more in Cardinals history. *Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau*

PLUNDER & LIGHTNING: **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in all nine career games at PNC Park as a member of the Cardinals, hitting safely in six. This includes a streak of four consecutive games with a home run (7/22-25/2019), and an extra inning grand slam (7/22/2019) that became the 52nd home run hit into the Allegheny River and the first ever by a right-handed batter. **Tyler O'Neill** has hit more home runs (6) and RBI (15) against the Pirates in his 22 career games Bucs than any other opponent (2 teams with 2 HR/2 teams with 6 RBI)

DOUBLE-DIPPING: Following yesterday's doubleheader, the Cardinals have now completed 9 of their 11 doubleheaders this season with two remaining (at PIT 9/18 & vs. MIL 9/25). St. Louis has posted a 10-8 mark in twinbills with two sweeps (at CWS 8/15 & at CHI 9/5), have been swept once (vs. PIT 8/27) and will have played six twibills over 14 days from Sept. 5-18 for their longest stretch.

MILLENNIALS: Both Cardinals catchers **Yadier Molina** and **Matt Wieters** are racing to hit their millennium milestones in hits. Molina is nine hits shy of 2,000, while the switch-hitting Wieters is six hits shy of 1,000.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004), **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) and **Junior Fernandez** (August 11, 2019) made their Major League debuts against Pittsburgh.

Harrison Bader previously committed to play at the University of Pittsburgh and University of Maryland before receiving a partial scholarship from Florida.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to Texas in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Andrew Knizner's uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Bench coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pirates Manager **Derek Shelton** was born in in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at nearby Southern Illinois University.

Pirates Baseball Operations Special Assistant **David Eckstein** played three seasons at shortstop with St. Louis (2005-07), where he was a two-time NL All-Star (2005-06) and member of the 2006 World Series Champions.

Pirates Hitting Coach **Rick Eckstein** previously served as the 2007 hitting coach for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Administrator of Baseball Information & Media Services **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

- Ranks 7th in ground ball percentage (58.2%) among Major League pitchers with at least 35 innings pitched.
- Allowed 10 hits in the month of August in 21.2 innings pitched, fewest in the Major Leagues among pitchers with 20 or more innings.
- Would have ranked 3rd in the National League in ERA (1.66) and 2nd in opponent BA (.137), but missed qualifying for the league leaders by 3.1 innings.

- Has an 12-3 record with a 2.49 ERA in 35 career appearances (21 starts) at Busch Stadium, posting the highest winning percentage (.800) of any active Cardinals starting pitcher.

- His .696 win pct. (16-7) was the best by Cardinals rookie since Dick Hughes (.727, 16-6) in 1964, while his 3.35 ERA was best by Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller (3.06) in 2013. Both marks trailed Atlanta's Mike Soroka (.765, 2.68) among NL rookies.
- Was 9-2 with a 2.75 ERA in 17 starts at Busch Stadium this season with the Cardinals going 13-4 (.765) in his home starts. His nine home wins are the most by a St. Louis rookie since Shelby Miller had 10 in 2013, while his .818 winning pct. ranks 5th among all Cardinals rookie starters and highest since Harvey Haddix (.867, 13-2) in 1953.
- Hurlled 174.2 innings in 2019, marking the most innings pitched by a St. Louis rookie in the regular season since Rick Ankiel had 175.0 IP in 2000.
