BRADEN MONTGOMERY AND PATRICK CLOHISY WIN FALL STARS GAME FINAL 2 VOTE

PHOENIX — The Arizona Fall League has announced the winners of the Fall Stars Game Final 2 Vote. Following over 5,000 votes cast, Chicago White Sox outfielder **Braden Montgomery** and Atlanta Braves outfielder **Patrick Clohisy** are set to be added to the 2025 AFL Fall Stars Game rosters.

MLB Pipeline's No. 35 overall prospect and top White Sox prospect, **Braden Montgomery**, is slashing .351/.529/595 with four doubles, a triple, a home run, and 10 RBI. He has a 1.124 OPS through 11 games while walking 13 times and stealing three bases. He has reached base in every game played in the AFL. He will join the American League roster headlined by offensive talent. This comes after his first professional season, where he rose from Single-A Kannapolis to Double-A Birmingham, hitting .270 across three levels.

Atlanta Braves prospect **Patrick Clohisy** is the newest speed threat in the AFL. With 21 stolen bases on 23 attempts, Clohisy is only the 4th player to steal 20-plus bases in the Fall League since at least 2005 and is tied for 2nd most during that time. Caleb Durbin, in back-to-back years, stole over 20 bags, securing the AFL record with 29 in 2024. The 23-year-old from St. Louis, Missouri, is slashing .276/.389/.355 with four extra-base hits, 10 RBI, and 13 walks. He will be added to the National League roster.

Fall Stars Weekend kicks off today, Nov. 8, beginning the Fall League's annual **PLAY BALL** event from 9 a.m. MST to 10:30 a.m. EST at Sloan Park in Mesa, Arizona. All participants will receive a free PLAY BALL T-Shirt, wristband, and bat and ball set. Later this evening, the AFL Home Run Derby begins at 6:30 p.m. MST/8:30 p.m. ET. Showcasing a brand-new format, eight participants will be split up into four teams of two. On Sunday, Nov. 9, the best prospects in the AFL from the National League square off with the American League live on MLB Network with first pitch of the 19th Arizona Fall League Fall Stars Game at 6 p.m. MST/8 p.m. EST.
