LEADING OFF: Today the Angels play the eighth (4-3) of 13 games on the homestand and the first of three games in a series against the White Sox...To begin the homestand, Halos have gone 2-2 vs. Seattle and 2-0 vs. Texas...Following the current series vs. Chicago (A.L.), the homestand will conclude with three games against the Rays (Aug. 4-6)...LAA was 2-4 on last road trip at Philadelphia (2-1) and New York (N.L.) (0-3).

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: Today, LHP **Andrew Chafin** and INF **Oswald Peraza** join the active roster...In a corresponding move, RHP **Sam Bachman** was optioned to Triple-A Salt Lake following Wednesday's game.

JOHNNY G. FIRST PITCH: Prior to tonight's game, former Angels infielder **Johnny Giavotella** will throw an honorary first pitch...Giavotella played two seasons for the Halos (2015-16).

DEADLINE DEALS: Yesterday, the Angels acquired INF **Oswald Peraza** from the New York Yankees in exchange for minor league OF **Wilberson De Peña** and international bonus pool space...Wednesday, the Angels acquired LHP **Andrew Chafin** and RHP **Luis García** from Washington in exchange for LHP **Jake Eder** and minor league 1B **Sam Brown**...In corresponding 40-man roster moves, LHP **José Quijada** and INF **Kevin Newman** were designated for assignment.

TROUT TRACKER: **Mike Trout** is three home runs shy of 400 for his career and is one HR shy of having 200 at Angel Stadium...He would become the 27th player all-time to have 200+ HR at one ballpark and the first player in MLB history with 200 HR and 100 SB at a ballpark...He is looking to become the third player to record his 400th HR in an Angels uniform, joining Hall of Famers **Dave Winfield** (Aug. 14, 1991 at Minnesota) and **Vladimir Guerrero** (Aug. 10, 2009 vs. Tampa Bay).

ON THE MOUND TODAY: LHP **Tyler Anderson** makes his 22nd start of the season today and 11th at home...He has a 3.19 ERA (53.2 IP - 19 ER) at Angel Stadium this year, compared with a 5.52 ERA (58.2 IP - 36 ER) on the road... Anderson has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 14 of 21 starts this year and is seeking his first winning decision since April 18 vs. Giants.

HIT AND RUN: **Zach Neto** has totaled 15 HR and 21 SB on the season...He has become the fifth player in Angels history to have 15+ HR and 20+ SB in consecutive seasons, joining **Bobby Abreu** (2009-10), **Don Baylor** (1977-79), **Darin Erstad** (1997-98) and **Mike Trout** (2012-13 & 2016-18).

WELCOME TO THE 1,000 RBI CLUB: Sunday vs. Seattle, **Mike Trout** recorded his 1,000th (and 1,001st) career RBI with a two-run HR in the 5th inning...He is the third player in Angels history to reach 1,000 RBI with the club, joining **Garret Anderson** (1,292) & **Tim Salmon** (1,016).

CLUTCH COMEBACKS: The Angels lead the Majors with 13 wins when trailing or tied after eight innings this season...It's also the Halos most such wins in a season since 2015 (14 wins).

THE CLOSER: **Kenley Jansen** has not allowed an earned run in 17 consecutive appearances...It's tied for the longest streak of his career (also, June 18 - Aug. 30, 2011 & Sept. 5, 2014 - June 9, 2015); the streak is also tied with **Edwin Díaz** (NYM) and **Jeremiah Estrada** (SD) for the longest active streak in the Majors...With 1,260 career strikeouts, he is six SO shy of matching **Craig Kimbrel** for the fourth-most all-time by a reliever...Jansen has also become the fourth pitcher all-time to have 13 seasons with at least 20 saves, joining **Mariano Rivera** (16), **Trevor Hoffman** (15) and **Lee Smith** (13).

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Angels lead the season series 2-1 after taking two of three games at Rate Field in the opening series of the regular season from March 27-30...Since 2016, Angels are 36-22 (.621) vs. White Sox, which is their best winning percentage against any opponent in that span...Halos won seven consecutive season series vs. Chicago from 2016-23, before White Sox won four of six meetings last year.

OUCH: Tuesday vs. Texas, **Mike Trout** was hit by a pitch for the 105th time in his career, which tied **Brian Downing** for the most in Angels history.

TAYLOR'S VERSION: **Taylor Ward** has matched his single-season career-high with 25 HR on the year (also had 25 HR in 2024)...His 78 RBI on the season are also a new career high (75 RBI in 2024)...Ward reached 100 career home runs on July 19 at Philadelphia and became the 21st player all-time with 100+ HR in an Angels uniform (11th to hit each of his first 100 career homers for the Halos).

ZACH ATTACKS: **Zach Neto** leads the American League with seven leadoff home runs this season and has also tied the Angels single-season record (**Brian Downing** had seven leadoff HR in 1987)...Overall, the Angels have hit nine leadoff HR this year, which is tied for second-most in a season in franchise history (10 leadoff HR in 1986 & nine in 2021 and 2024).

THE JO SHOW: **Jo Adell** has already set a new single-season career-high with 21 home runs on the season (previous was 20 HR in 2024).

STILL HOME: Today is game eight of a 13-game homestand for the Angels...It is the Halos longest homestand since a 13-gamer from June 27 - July 10, 2011...The Angels are in a stretch of playing 22 of 28 games at home and will play just three games outside California over the 32 day span from July 24 - Aug. 24 (Aug. 8-10 at Detroit).

ON REHAB: INF **Christian Moore** is currently on a rehab assignment with Low-A Inland Empire...In two games for the 66ers, he has batted .500 (3/6), with two doubles and one walk and has totaled 14 innings at second base.

ACL CHAMPS!: The Arizona Complex League Angels swept the best-of-three ACL Championship Series against the ACL Giants to earn their first ever Arizona Complex League Championship.

RAYS ON DECK: Following the current series vs. Chicago, the Angels will conclude the homestand with three games against the Tampa Bay Rays...Angels lead the season series 2-1 after taking two of three at Steinbrenner Field from April 8-10...Angels hit a season-high six HR in their last game vs. Rays on April 10 and totaled 11 homers in the three-game series (most for the Halos in any series vs. TB and second-most in any three-game series in franchise history).

Is 1-3 with a 3.19 ERA (53.2 IP - 19 ER) and 42 strikeouts in 10 home starts in 2025.

- TODAY'S GAME:** Making 22nd start of the season and 11th at home...In 10th Major League season...Made ninth career Opening Day roster.
- LAST TIME OUT:** Took no-decision in last time out on July 26 against Mariners; Pitched 4.2 innings and allowed two runs on six hits with one strikeout.
- VS. WHITE SOX:** Is 0-2 with a 8.50 ERA (18.0 IP - 17 ER) with 11 strikeouts in four career starts against the Chicago White Sox.
- AT ANGEL STADIUM:** Making 11th home start of the season; Is 1-3 with a 3.19 ERA (53.2 IP - 19 ER) and 42 strikeouts in 10 home starts in 2025; Angels are 6-4 at home when Anderson starts this season...Is 8-15 with a 4.85 ERA (219.0 IP - 118 ER) and 177 strikeouts in 41 career games (40 starts) at Angel Stadium in career.
- COMPETITOR:** Has a 4.34 ERA (74.2 IP - 36 ER) and 61 strikeouts in 14 starts against teams with records at or above .500 this season.
- GETTING AHEAD:** Has thrown a first pitch strike to 58.9% (290/492) of hitters this season...Opposing hitters have a .220 (48/218) average against after falling behind 0-1 in the count against Anderson this season.
- RELIABLE:** Today is 22nd start of the season...Has made at least 25 starts in every season since 2021, and has made at least 30 appearances (including 28 starts) in three of those seasons...Ranks third among left-handed pitchers with 778.1 innings pitched since 2021.
- RIGHT THE SHIP:** Has lost six straight decisions across last 14 outings since May 11, the longest active streak in the American League, and third-longest in baseball.
- SPRING KING:** Posted a 2.67 ERA (33.2 IP - 10 ER) in six starts in March/April this season...Has a 3.35 ERA (96.2 IP - 36 ER) in the first two months of the season since joining the Angels in 2023.
- CONGRATULATIONS T.A.:** Reached 10 years of MLB service time on July 11.
- 2024 IN REVIEW:** Pitched to a 10-15 record and 3.81 ERA (179.1 IP - 76 ER) with 142 strikeouts against 73 walks in 31 starts in his second season with the Angels...His 179.1 innings pitched set a career-high and were the most in a season for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney pitched 180 innings in 2018...Made second career All-Star team and first with Halos after going 8-8 with a 2.97 ERA (118.0 IP - 39 ER) and 81 strikeouts in 19 starts in the first half.
- CAREER NOTES:** Native of Las Vegas, NV, where he attended Spring Valley HS...Was a first round (20th overall) selection by Colorado in the 2011 Draft out of the University of Oregon...Made Major League debut with Rockies on June 12, 2016 vs. San Diego...Has previously played with Colorado (2016-19), San Francisco (2020), Pittsburgh (2021), Seattle (2021) and Los Angeles (N.L.) (2022)...Two-time All-Star (2022, 2024).
