That's a First

Atlanta beat Washington, 11-5, last night in the opening game of this series. The victory was the Braves' ninth consecutive win.

In each of the nine wins, Atlanta has scored at least five runs, has allowed no more than five runs, and has played error-free baseball.

Per StatsPerform, the Braves are the only team in MLB history to have such a streak over any nine-game winning run.

Atlanta owns a run differential of +46 (72-26) during the streak, and is one of just two teams in baseball without an error since its winning run started.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals tonight continue a three-game mid-week series with the 12th of 13 matchups between the teams this season...The two clubs are set to play seven times in a span of 10 days, following a four-game series at Nationals Park last week.

Atlanta completed its first-ever four-game sweep of the Washington/Montreal franchise last week, and has now won five straight games against the club... The Braves are 8-3 in 11 total games between the two clubs this season.

Following last night's win, Atlanta has now won four-of-five against Washington here at Truist Park this season...The Braves are 39-33 (.542) versus the Nationals here all-time, however, Washington's .458 winning percentage in this building is the best of any other NL East team.

RH Hurston Waldrep made the first appearance of his major league career and his most recent appearance of his major league career against Washington, and is 1-1 with a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) all-time against the club...The 6-foot-2, 210-pound right-hander beat the Nationals just six days ago in D.C., pitching 5.0 three-run innings and fanning eight.

RH Brad Lord also faced Atlanta just six days ago, and left with a no-decision after allowing six hits and two runs over 5.1 innings...The 6-foot-3, 210-pound Floridian has made three relief appearances and a single start against the Braves in his career, and is 0-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) all-time versus Atlanta.

ROSTER MOVES: The Braves today reported RHP Joel Payamps and recalled INF Brett Wisely to Atlanta, after optioning RHP Nathan Wiles to Triple-A Gwinnett following last night's game and placing INF Ozzie Albies on the 10-day injured list this afternoon... Yesterday, Atlanta signed RHP Charlie Morton to a major league contract for the remainder of the season.

Morton returns to Atlanta after making 124 starts for the Braves between 2021-2024, compiling a 45-34 record with a 3.87 ERA (295 ER/686.1 IP)...He ranked seventh in the majors in both starts and strikeouts (771) over those four seasons.

He made four starts for Atlanta during the 2021 postseason, including pitching Game 1 of the World Series on the Braves' path to the championship.

Atlanta claimed Payamps off waivers from the Milwaukee Brewers yesterday afternoon, for whom he was 0-1 with a 7.23 ERA through 28 games this season...He went 10-12 with a 2.78 ERA over 137 games for Milwaukee in the previous two seasons, and his 2.7 bWAR over 2023-24 ranked ninth among all relievers in the NL.

The Braves claimed Wisely off waivers from the Giants on September 18, and the infielder is a .217/.263/.324 batter over 164 career major league games.

STREAKING: Atlanta's win last night was its season-best ninth consecutive victory...It is the longest active winning streak in baseball, and tied for the eighth-longest winning run by a team this season.

The Braves last won nine straight games in 2023, doing so from June 24 to July 3 of that year...Atlanta has not compiled a winning streak of double-digit games since winning 14 straight in June of 2022.

Eight of Atlanta's nine victories in the streak have come by multiple runs, and the Braves have a run differential of +46 (72-26) over the nine games... The streak has trimmed Atlanta's run differential for the season down to just -5.

Six different teams have combined to compile seven individual winning streaks of at least 10 games this season, with Milwaukee owning a season-best 14-game streak...The Braves can tie the Brewers' league-best streak this season if they win out.

OFFENSE: Atlanta plated 11 more runs in last night's game, and its 322 total runs dating to the All-Star break are the third most in all of baseball...Only Milwaukee (337) and Toronto (328) have scored more since the break.

Atlanta has averaged a full run more per game after the break (5.19) than before (4.08).

The 72 total runs for Atlanta over its current winning streak are its most in any nine-game stretch this season, and its most over any nine games since two non-overlapping streaks in 2023.

The Braves have batted .251/.331/.415 as a collective unit since the All-Star break, with a .746 OPS...Atlanta hit .243/.315/.388 with a .703 OPS over 95 games to open the season.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Collected two more hits last night, going 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI...He has at least one RBI and one extra-base hit in each of his last six games, becoming the only rookie catcher in MLB history (since 1920, when RBI became an official statistic) with such a run.

Dating to the 1947 season, when the first national Rookie of the Year award was presented by the BBWAA, Baldwin is just the eighth rookie to reach 35 extra-base hits and 78 RBI while playing over half his games behind the plate, and the first to do so since J.P. Arencibia in 2011.

Of the first seven such catchers to reach Baldwin's counting stats in their rookie seasons, five were named Rookie of the Year - Johnny Bench in 1968, Earl Williams in 1971, Benito Santiago in 1987, Mike Piazza in 1993 and Geovany Soto in 2008.

KIM SCORING RUNS: Ha-Seong Kim has hit in each of his last 10 games dating to September 13, and has scored a run in each of his last nine.

It is the longest run-scoring streak by a Brave since 2023, and the longest by an Atlanta shortstop since Rafael Furcal in 2003.

Tonight's Game

- Set to make his 11th major league start, ninth this season, and 55th professional appearance...Making his third career appearance against Washington.
- Faced the Nationals in his last turn, earning his fifth win of the season while fanning eight hitters and allowin three runs over 5.0 frames.
- Is 1-1 with a 5.26 ERA over his last five games...Started the season 4-0 with a 0.73 ERA in his first four outings.
- With a win, Waldrep will become the only rookie in Braves franchise history (modern era) to earn six wins while only losing one game in a season as a primary starter.
- His current .833 win-loss percentage in a single season is currently the highest among rookies in franchise history with at least as many appearances as Waldrep (dating to 1900).
- Opposing hitters are batting .145 against Waldrep's splitter this season.

2025

- Went 7-8 with a 4.42 ERA 19 starts with Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

Went 1-2 with a 0.78 ERA in four starts during the month of July...It was the second lowest ERA in the International League during the month (among QS).
- Earned his first career win in on August 2, scattering three hits over 5.2 innings of one-run ball against Cincinnati in Bristol, Tennessee.
- Waldrep became the first player in major league history to earn his first career win in the state of Tennessee...He is also the only player in MLB history to record a win in the Volunteer state.
- He was appointed as the additional player for the continuation of the MLB Speedway Classic, after returning INF Jonathan Ornelas to Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Won his third game of the year with Atlanta in his last outing, holding Cleveland to two hits over 6.0 scoreless frames while fanning seven hitters.
- Became just the fourth rookie in Atlanta franchise history (1966) to win at least four of his first his six career games and first since Matt Wisler in 2015.
- Earned his fourth win of the season and his third quality start of the year, scattering four hits over 7.0 scoreless frames while fanning seven hitters and issuing just one walk against Chicago (AL) on August 20.
- Became the second MLB rookie in the modern era to earn the win in each of his first four appearances of a season while allowing one run or fewer in each outing... The other was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981...Research courtesy of StatsPass.
- Also became the youngest pitcher in Braves franchise history to open the season 4-0 and first since Rick Mahler in 1985.
- Since 1963, only five other Braves have finished their fourth game with a 0.73 ERA or lower (min. 20 IP): Greg Maddux (1998, 2001), Tim Hudson (2007), Aaron Harang (2014), Max Fried (2023) and Reynaldo López (2024).

- Waldrep went 4-0 with a 0.90 ERA in his first five outings of the season...Joined Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux as the only Atlanta-era hurlers to earn four wins, pitch at least 30.0 innings and have a sub-1.00 ERA in the first five outings of a season... Maddux posted a 0.88 ERA in his first five starts of the 1994 season.
- Struck out a career-most nine hitters against Philadelphia on August 31.
- Began 4-0 with with a 1.33 ERA in six starts and one long relief appearance with the Braves this season...Snapped his four-game winning streak on September 12 against Houston.
- His 1.33 ERA was the lowest ERA by a Braves rookie in franchise history in a single season with at least seven appearances and six starts.
- His 1.01 ERA was the lowest in the month of August by an Atlanta-era starter (min. 35.0 innings pitched) since Kris Medlen also went 4-0 while posting a 0.50 ERA in 2012.
