TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins finish a four-game set today with the 16th of 19 meetings between the clubs...This is Atlanta's last trip to Miami this season...The clubs will meet again at SunTrust Park on August 20-22 to wrap up the season series.

- The Braves went 14-5 (.737) against the Marlins last season, matching the franchise record for most single-season victories against Florida/Miami... The tied the mark first set in 2004 and matched in 2012...The Braves are 11-4 this season against Miami with four more games to go.
- Despite last night's loss, the Braves are 48-25 (.658) here, the best record by any National League team in Marlins Park...Among all major league teams that have played double-digit games here, they rank second...Tampa Bay is 13-6 (.684).
- With a win today, the Braves would tie the most single-season victories by an opposing team at Marlins Park...The 2013 Braves set the mark with eight.
- RH Mike Foltynewicz is set to face the Marlins for the 12th career time and for the 11th time as a starter...The righty is 5-2 with a 3.12 ERA (20 ER/57.2 IP) and has not pitched against Miami this season...Foltynewicz went 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) in 2018, allowing no home runs and just one run in each start.
- RH Héctor Noesí has never faced Atlanta...The righty made his first major league appearance since 2015 last Tuesday at New York (NL), going 5.0 innings and allowing five runs, earned, in a 5-0 loss.

STRUGGLES: Since the Braves' four-game winning streak out of the All-Star break ended with a 13-1 loss on July 16 at Milwaukee, Atlanta is 11-13 (.458) in 24 games.

- The bullpen has one save, four blown saves, and a 7.44 ERA (62 ER/75.0 IP) over this stretch...The team's one save is by RHP Josh Tomlin.
- The bullpen is unscored upon in just four of those games...They have allowed an opponents' OPS of .913 with 17 home runs and a batting average on balls in play of .341.

STARTERS: RHP Mike Soroka tossed 7.0 scoreless innings last night, his fourth start this season of at latest that length with no earned runs allowed....That total is tied for the third most in baseball...Only Los Angeles' Hyun-Jin Ryu (7) and Houston's Zack Greinke (5) have more.

- Over the last eight games, a Braves starter has allowed more than three earned runs just one time, with Dallas Keuchel surrendering eight on August 8 here in Miami.
- Today's starter, Mike Foltynewicz, went 5.1 innings and allowed three runs, earned, in a 12-7 win at Minnesota in his only turn during this stretch.

LOOKING FOR 30/30: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. swiped two bases in the ninth inning last night, giving him 28 this season, and leaving him two shy of the fifth 30 home run/30 stolen base season in Braves franchise history.

- Acuña Jr. is also looking to become the second player in baseball history to have at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season prior to his 22nd birthday...The only player to do so was Mike Trout, who had 30 home runs and 49 stolen bases as a 20-year-old in 2012.
- Only three Braves have gone 30/30 at any age, with OF Ron Gant doing it last in 1990 and 1991.
- OF Hank Aaron was the first to do so, accomplishing the feat in 1963, while OF Dale Murphy also did it in 1983.

30/30 BY TEAM GAME: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. stands two stolen bases away from a 30/30 season, and today is team game No. 120...The quickest a Braves player has ever recorded a 30/30 season is team game No. 149, set by Ron Gant in 1991...The quickest major leaguer to accomplish the feat in the modern era was Cincinnati's Eric Davis, who needed just 105 team games and 90 personal games in 1987.

Gant needed 154 games for his first 30/30 season in 1990...Hank Aaron used 160 team games for the first 30/30 season in Braves history, while Dale Murphy accomplished the feat in 153 team games during the 1983 season.

LATE RUNS: The Braves scored all six of their runs last night in the eighth and ninth innings, giving them a MLB-high 230 runs in the seventh inning or later this season...They also have 71 home runs in these late innings, and that total is the most in the majors.

The Braves have allowed 203 runs in these innings, one of eight teams in the majors to have allowed at least 200 such runs.

ALBIES HITS: 2B Ozzie Albies collected two more hits last night, giving him 21 in 10 games this month... Over his last five games, Albies is hitting .625 (15-for-24) with two doubles, two triples and three home runs.

Since going a season worst-tying 0-for-5 on July 17 at Milwaukee, Albies is hitting .368 (35-for-95) with a .674 slugging percentage and a .412 on-base percentage.

PINCH-HIT HOME RUNS: UTIL Johan Camargo hit a 0-1 pitch out to right field last night for his third pinch-hit home run of the season... Only Pittsburgh's Jose Osuna has more this year (5).

- Tyler Austin and Raimel Tapia also have three... Camargo is the 15th player in Braves history to hit three or more pinch-hit home runs in a season... Butch Nieman hit a franchise-record five in 1945.
- Brooks Conrad is the only player to do so in multiple years...He hit three in both 2010 and 2011.

Today's Game

- Faces Miami for the first time this season, and for the 12th time (11th start) in his career...Is 5-2 with a 3.12 ERA (20 ER/57.2 IP) over his first 11 games.
 - Pitched against them three times last season, going 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP)...Allowed one earned run in 11.0 total innings (0.82 ERA) here at Marlins Park.
 - In his last seven starts against Miami dating to May 12, 2017, is 4-2 with a 1.87 ERA (9 ER/43.1 IP) and a .208 opponents' average...Atlanta is 5-2 in his starts.
- ★ Last started on August 6 at Minnesota and allowed five hits (two homers) and three runs in 5.1 innings.
 - All three runs scored in the sixth inning, after Atlanta sent 10 men to the plate and scored six runs in the top of the frame...Allowed just four baserunners through the first five innings.
 - Struck out seven batters, all of which were swining...Four of the seven came on his slider, on which he got 10 swinging strikes on the game.
- Makes his second start with Atlanta since being recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 5.
 - Made six starts with the Stripers following his option, and went 4-0 with a 2.67 ERA (10 ER/33.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts...Opponents batted .254/.299/.325 against him.
- Did not allow a home run during his stint with Gwinnett, tossing 33.2 homerless innings.
 - Allowed 16 home runs in 11 starts for Atlanta, for a career high 2.43 home runs per 9.0 innings.
 - Among pitchers to make at least 11 starts this season, Foltynewicz's 2.43 HR/9.0 IP is the third-highest mark in the majors...Only David Hess (3.08) and Drew Smyly (2.60) have a higher rate.

2019 Recap

- Started for Atlanta in Washington, 6/22, and allowed a career high-tying eight runs over 4.0 innings... Was optioned to Gwinnett postgame.
 - ${\cal A}$ In his previous six starts, had gone 2-2 with a 3.97 ERA.
- ✓ Made back-to-back starts against Pittsburgh, 6/6 and 6/11, and combined to allowed 11 hits and seven runs over 11.0 innings...Atlanta split the two games, losing the first, 6-1, before a 7-5 win in the second.
 - ✓ Started against the same opponent in consecutive turns for the fourth time in
 his career...Is 2-1 with a 3.16 ERA (9 ER/25.2 IP) in the first game, and 1-2
 with a 4.35 ERA (10 ER/20.2 IP) in the second.
- ★ Earned his first win of the season, 5/24 at STL, after allowing five hits and one unearned run over 6.0 innings.
 - ✓ The win stopped a seven-game losing streak for the Braves in Foltynewicz's starts, dating to his final regular-season start of 2018...Atlanta lost each of Foltynewicz's two playoff starts last season, and his first five turns this year.
- ★ Started, 5/14 vs. STL, for his 100th career start, all of which have come for Atlanta.
 - ⚠ Became the 20th pitcher to make 100 starts for the Braves since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Of the 20 pitchers to make 100 such starts, Foltynewicz's 8.61 SO/9.0 IP at the time were most, and he stood as one of just two starters to strike out at least eight batters per 9.0 innings for Atlanta... Tommy Hanson made 108 starts for the Braves, and fanned 8.39 batters per 9.0 innings.
- Went 6.0+ innings in his season debut, 4/27 vs. COL, and allowed six hits and four runs with a walk and five strikeouts...Two of the four runs scored before he recorded an out in the seventh.
- ✓ Was activated off the 10-day injured list, 4/27, and made his first major league start
 of the season.. Missed Atlanta's first 25 games.
 - Placed on the injured list with a right elbow bone spur on March 28, retroactive to March 25...Marked his third career trip to the injured list...Missed from June 4 - June 30, 2016 (right elbow soreness), and from June 13 - June 25, 2018 (right triceps tightness).

- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save...Recorded his second blown save on 8/10 at MIA in five appearances since joining Atlanta.
- Acquired from Detroit on July 31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...Prior to joining the Braves ranked fourth in the American League with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball to San Diego's Kirby Yates among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.
- Finished tied for fourth in the league with 32 saves in 2018,

- Went 0-2 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in 38 games out of the bullpen for Texas this season with 43 strikeouts and just four walks.
- Before joining Atlanta, had a rate of 0.95 BB/9 which ranked fifth best among qualifying relievers in the majors.
- Was in his second season with the Rangers, joining Texas as a free agent in December of 2017... He spent the previous two years in Japan from 2015-2017, while also playing for Colorado and New York (AL).

- Acquired from San Francisco in exchange for RHP's Dan Winkler and Tristan Beck on July 31...Was 4-2 with a 3.50 ERA (18 ER/46.1 IP) in 43 appearances out of the San Francisco pen.
- Has converted 183 saves over an 11-year major league career, seventh most among all active pitchers. Among qualified active relievers, his 85.1 (183-for-215) career save percentage is fifth best in the majors.
