THE TWINS: Have gone 2-5 through seven games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Houston, 0-3 at New York-AL and 0-1 at Pittsburgh...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three at PNC Park against the Pirates...after tomorrow afternoon's roadtrip finale in Pittsburgh, the Twins will travel home for a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Rockies (Monday-Wednesday), four against the A's (Thursday-Sunday) and three against the Rays (June 18-20).

☞ The Twins have lost four consecutive games, marking the fourth time this season with four straight Ls...their season-long for a losing streak is seven, done from May 14-20...only one season under Rocco Baldelli have the Twins recorded three five-plus game losing streaks in a season, that coming in 2021, when they lost a season-long five straight three times.

☞ The Twins have gone 11-7-2 in series play this season, going 5-4-0 at home and 6-3-2 on the road...since April 22, they have gone 10-3-0 in series play.

NOT SO JOLLY ROGER: The Twins were shut out by the Pirates last night at PNC Park, losing by a score of 3-0, suffering their fourth shutout of the season...Joe Ryan (4-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on just two hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...Griffin Jax pitched 1.0 inning of relief and allowed one run, snapping his scoreless inning streak at eight games, allowing a run for the first time since May 10 at Toronto...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Trevor Larnach, Carlos Correa, Jose Miranda and Byron Buxton...Minnesota went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

TWINS AND BUCS: The Twins are 25-18 all-time against the Pirates, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 8-5 at PNC Park (2006-24) and 7-5 at Target Field (2015-23)...the Twins have won nine of their last 14 games vs. Pittsburgh, dating back to April of 2018...Twins last win in this ballpark came on August 5, 2020.

☞ Alex Kirilloff was born in Pittsburgh and attended Plum Senior High School, approximately 18 miles northeast of PNC Park...he grew up a fan of all Pittsburgh professional sports teams, his favorite Pirate being Andrew McCutchen.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 4-5 in Interleague Play this season...they played a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2), a three-game series at Washington (2-1) and have gone 0-1 at Pittsburgh this weekend...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Rockies at Target Field from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Trevor Larnach has four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, a .621 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS in 18 games against the NL since the start of last season.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with one triple, three home runs, five RBI, seven walks and a 1.099 OPS in nine games against NL opponents this season.

ROYCE ROLLS THE ROAD: In 33 career road games, Royce Lewis is hitting .374 (46-for-123) with three doubles, 12 home runs, 34 RBI, a .691 slugging percentage and a 1.129 OPS...in his last 17 road games, dating back to August 23, 2023, he has slashed .381/.458/.803 (1.262 OPS) with nine home runs and 23 RBI.

☞ Entering this series, since that August 23, 2023 date, Royce has homered in every road series he has appeared:

BY COMPARISON: Byron Buxton homered in 10 consecutive road series from June 3-August 14, 2022...he and Miguel Sanó (September 16-June 2017) hold the club record.

CARLOS ACROSS AMERICA: Carlos Correa has reached safely in 15 of his last 17 road games, posting a .352 on-base percentage, a .508 slugging percentage and an .860 OPS in that span...over the last full year, since June 8, 2023, he has slashed .275/.357/.475 in 66 road games, with 14 doubles, 11 home runs, 38 RBI and 30 walks...his .357 on-base percentage in that span ranks 12th in the AL, his .833 OPS ranks 14th and his .475 slugging ranks 15th.

MIRANDA WATCH!: Over his last 35 games, dating back to April 25, Jose Miranda is hitting .303 (37-for-122) with eight doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBI, a .333 on-base percentage, a .508 slugging percentage and an .842 OPS...on the road, in that span, he is slashing .323/.353/.569 (.922 OPS) with 11 RBI in 19 games.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Trevor Larnach has a .640 slugging percentage since May 21, 12th-best in the AL.
- ☞ The Twins have committed just 24 errors on the season, the fewest in baseball...additionally, they rank sixth in baseball in defensive runs above average at 11.3.
- ☞ Minnesota has seen the second-fewest fastballs in baseball at 4,647...Cleveland has seen the fewest at 4,637.
- ☞ Twins have an OPS of .467 in 0-2 counts, the sixth-best in baseball.
- ☞ Jhoan Duran has appeared just once on this trip (Sunday at Houston)...he enters today 10-for-10 in save opportunities, one of two relievers in baseball with a save percentage of 100% (min. 10 opps), joined by San Diego's Robert Suarez (17-for-17).

MIC DROPS: Pittsburgh related notes on Bally Sports analysts Glen Perkins and Trevor Plouffe: ☞ Perk earned his third career save in this ballpark on June 20, 2012, in his 176th career game...that save was roughly the time that Perk transitioned to the club's official closer, going on to save 117 more games and finish with 120 for his career.

☞ Plouffe played in nine career games against the Pirates, hitting .346 (9-for-26) with a 1.010 OPS...he homered once in this ballpark, on May 19, 2015, off Francisco Liriano...the next day he drew three walks, one of three times in his career to walk three times in a game.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2013, Joe Mauer hit his 100th career home run during a 4-3 victory at Washington, a fifth-inning solo shot off Gio Gonzalez...21 players in Twins history (since 1961) have hit 100 home runs as a Twin...Glen Perkins saved that game with a scoreless 11th inning...Trevor Plouffe did not appear and was on the IL with a strained left calf.

HOUSTON HOMECOMING: Last pitched June 2 at Houston, opposite Hunter Brown, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 victory...allowed three runs on three hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed second-inning solo home run to Victor Caratini and third-inning two-run shot to Alex Bregman...was pulled after striking out Chas McCormick to begin the fifth.
 🌀 Induced a season-high 12 whiffs on 35 swings (34.3%)...ranks in MLB's 15th percentile with a 20.1 percent whiff rate.
 🌀 Allowed three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Houston went 2-for-3 on those swings, including the Caratini (105.2 mph) and Bregman (102.0 mph) home runs...ranks in MLB's 54th percentile with a 37.9 percent hard-hit rate.
 🌀 Twins are 7-2 in Woods Richardson's nine starts this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 28 vs. Kansas City, opposite Cole Ragans, and earned the win in Minnesota's 4-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...stranded a runner on third base in the third...allowed both runs in the fifth, but stranded a runner on third and preserved Minnesota's 3-2 lead.
 🌀 Induced 10 whiffs on 39 swings (25.6%).
 🌀 Allowed just three hard-hit balls; Kansas City went 1-for-3 with a double on those swings.

ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT: Has never faced Pittsburgh or any active Pirates hitters...has made two career Interleague appearances, both vs. Washington; has posted a 4.82 ERA (9.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts in those games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making seventh road start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.49 ERA (28.1 IP, 11 ER), seven walks and 18 strikeouts on the road, compared to 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks and 18 strikeouts in three home starts...has allowed a .252 (27-for-107) batting average and .710 OPS on the road, compared to .190 (11-for-58) BAA and .462 OPS at home.
 🌀 Has allowed four home runs, all on the road.
 🌀 Owns a 1.20 WHIP on the road, 0.94 at home.
