RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game home-stand with the second game of a three-game series against the defending National League Champion Arizona Diamondbacks tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals snapped a four-game losing skid last night by erasing a 3-0 deficit and walking off the Dbacks in the 9th inning ... The Cardinals play 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (14-7) and 2.0 games behind Pittsburgh (12-11) for 4th place.

GO-HOME GORMAN: Nolan Gorman sent Redbirds fans home happy last night with his walkoff two-run blast in the 9th inning for his first career walk-off home run and RBI (also against his childhood team).

- Gorman is the first Cardinal since 1900 to break a 0-for-19+ slump with a walkoff home run ... The last MLB player to break an 0-for-19+ skid with a walkoff homer was Blue Jays 1B **Edwin Encarnación** (0-for-23 in 2016 vs. Orioles). - *Elias*

- The last Cardinals second baseman to record a walkoff RBI was **Kolten Wong** (walk) on Aug. 26, 2020 vs. Royals, while Wong was also the last Cardinals second baseman with a walkoff homer (June 2, 2018 vs. Pirates off Richard Rodríguez).

IT'S WHACKING DAY: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals .614 win percentage (108-68) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent, the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents, and the highest by any team against the last four expansion teams (Rockies, Marlins, Rays, Diamondbacks). **RAZING ARIZONA:** St. Louis' .638 home winning pct. (37-21) vs. the Diamondbacks is tied for its 4th-best at Busch Stadium III (2006-present).

FINEST IN THE FIELD: The Cardinals .989 fielding percentage is tied for the 4th-highest in MLB (Atlanta leads at .994).

- The Cardinals rank 2nd in MLB in both double plays turned defensively (27) and groundball double plays induced by pitchers (26), trailing only Oakland (30 & 26) ... **Paul Goldschmidt** leads MLB with 25 double plays.

- 3B **Nolan Arenado** leads MLB third baseman in MLB in Outs Above Average (4), T-4th among all players behind 2B **Marcus Semien** (6), OF **Daulton Varsho** (6), and SS **Nick Ahmed** (5). - *Baseball Savant*

THE MAN WITH THE GOLDEN GUN: Since joining St. Louis in 2019, **Paul Goldschmidt** has gone yard 10 times against his former team, his most against any non-NL Central opponent over that timespan ... Goldy is the all-time Chase Field home run leader (105) and ranks 3rd in Busch Stadium III history with 75 blasts.

BASES TAKEN: St. Louis leads Major League Baseball with 44 bases taken (extra bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks, and defensive indifference), while the Diamondbacks are 2nd with 37.

PRODUCTIVE OUTS: The Cardinals and Diamondbacks co-lead MLB in productive outs with 33 (fly balls, grounders, or bunts to advance runners) ... **Brendan Donovan**, **Harold Ramírez**, and **Fernando Tatis Jr.** share the MLB lead with seven productive outs ... St. Louis leads MLB in bunt hits (5) and sacrifice flies (12), and co-leads MLB in sacrifice bunts (6) with the White Sox.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 23, 1999): 25 years ago today, **Fernando Tatis** becomes the only player in Major League history to hit two grand slams in the same inning, going yard both times off Dodgers starter **Chan Ho Park** in an 11-run third inning at Dodger Stadium ... The third baseman's eight RBI in one inning also breaks the old record of six.

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt was selected by Arizona in the 8th round of the 2009 MLB Draft...played eight seasons with the Dbacks (2011-18), hitting .297/.398/.532 with 209 home runs and 710 RBI...selected to six All-Star squads (2013-18)...won four Silver Sluggers (2013, '15, '17-18) and three Gold Gloves (2013, '15, '17)...acquired by St. Louis from Arizona for **Carson Kelly**, **Luke Weaver**, **Andrew Young**, and the 2019 Cardinals Compensation Round B selection (Dec. 5, 2018).

Nolan Arenado made his MLB debut vs. the Dbacks (April 28, 2013 at Chase Field)...Signed his letter of intent to play college baseball at Arizona State University before drafted by the Rockies.

Nolan Gorman was born in Phoenix...graduated from Sandra Day O'Connor High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before drafted by the Cardinals.

Dbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Dbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft...played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Keynan Middleton pitched in 18 games for the Diamondbacks in 2022.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)...served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

Brandon Crawford resides in Scottsdale, Ari.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Arizona.

Jordan Montgomery pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2022-23).

Matthew Liberatore was born in Peoria, Ari...graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before drafted by the Rays.

Randal Grichuk played parts of his first four MLB seasons in St. Louis (2014-17)...originally joined the Cardinals via trade with the Angels, packaged with **Peter Bourjos** in exchange for **David Freese** and **Fernando Salas** (Nov. 22, 2013).

Turner Ward played two seasons (1999-2000) and spent eight years coaching in the Dbacks organization, serving as AA-Mobile Hitting Coach (2008-10) and Manager (2011-12), and Arizona Asst. Hitting Coach (2013) & Hitting Coach (2014-15)...Turner's son, **Tucker Ward**, was selected by Arizona in the 40th round of the 2015 MLB Draft and pitched three seasons in the Arizona organization (2015-17).

Brandon Allen played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the Dbacks...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Made)...singled off **Brian Moehler** for first career hit.

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league organization before traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Dbacks Pitching Coach **Brent Strom** spent six seasons (2008-13) with the Cardinals organization as minor league pitching instructor (2008-11) and pitching coordinator (2012-13).

John Mozeliak attended the Univ. of Arizona before graduating from the Univ. of Colorado at Boulder.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** graduated from Arizona State University.

Dbacks Player & Media Relations Coordinator **Kat Ritter** previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Dbacks Pitching Strategist **Dan Haren** was selected by St. Louis in the 2nd rd. of the 2001 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons with the Cardinals (2003-04).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Making his fifth start of the 2024 season today and second against the Diamondbacks this season in only the 24th game. Last faced Arizona on April 12 at Chase Field.
- Ranks 7th among National League left-handed pitchers with a 3.60 ERA.
- Ranks T-4th among Major League pitchers in GDP/9 IP (1.80) trailing only Joe Musgrove (2.22), Chris Bassitt (2.01) and Martin Perez (1.82).
- Leads Cardinals starting pitchers in run support average (7.20) and ranks T-10th among all MLB pitchers.
- Had a 5-game win streak from last season snapped in his last start at OAK (4/17) allowing a season-high five runs in a 6-3 loss..
- Surpassed 900 career innings with his fifth out at OAK (4/17) becoming the 20th active left-handed pitcher with 900 or more innings pitched.
- Has held left-handed batters to 4-for-17 mark (.235 BA) with the only XBH being a ground-rule double by **Shohei Ohtani** at LAD (3/31).
- Has allowed nine runs (6 ER) over his last two starts after holding his opposition to two runs over his first two starts.
- Is 3-5 with a 5.55 ERA in 12 career April starts (58.1 IP/36 ER) over his three years with the Cardinals.
- Made his first start of the season against the Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball in Los Angeles on 3/31 and received a no decision after departing with a 4-2 lead in the 6th.

LAST TIME OUT

- Received his first loss of the season, snapping a five-game win streak dating back to 2023. Allowed two runs in the 3rd inning and three more in the 5th inning before departing trailing 5-3.
- Surpassed 900 career innings after his 5th out becoming the 20th active left-handed pitcher to eclipse that mark.

2023 SEASON

- Made 25 appearances (17 starts) between the starting rotation and bullpen in 2023
- Limited left-handed batters to a .215/.295/.304 slashline (17-79) with three extra-base hits (two home runs and double).
- Recorded a season-high 17.0 scoreless innings streak from July 20-August 5), longest by a Cardinal pitcher in 2023.
- Opened season making 10 starts in the rotation, starting 0-6 with a 5.72 ERA (50.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts. Received 16 runs of support while St. Louis was 2-8 in those games.
- Moved to the bullpen in late May, and made eight relief appearances, logging a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts and .224 average against.
- Allowed runs in only three of eight relief appearances, while working 2.0+ IP in four outings.
- As a starter, went 4-6 with a 4.04 ERA (89.0 IP) in 17 starts.
- Pitched 5.0 innings or more in 13-of-17 starts (four quality).
- Hurled career-high 3.1 scoreless innings in relief (3.1) twice, garnering 10 scoreless outs, in London vs. Cubs (6/24) and vs. Astros (6/29).
- Returned to the starting rotation on July 9, finishing his season 4-0 with a 1.86 ERA (8 ER/38.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts in his final seven starts. Held his opposition to two runs or fewer in six of starts, including one run or fewer in five.
- Over that seven-start span from July 9-Aug. 12, ranked among MLB leaders in wins (T-2nd), innings (T-4th), ERA (3rd), average against (.190, T-7th), opponent OPS (.537), WHIP (0.88, 5th), BR/9 (7.91, 3rd), and FIP (2.85, 4th).
- Missed the final 44 games of season due to a left lat strain.

- Makes his 3rd career start vs. the Diamondbacks as a member of the Cardinals and his second in the last 11 days. His first five starts/appearances were as a member of the New York Mets.
- Received a no decision in his first start vs. Arizona (4/12) this season, allowing four runs (one earned) on eight hits in a game the Cardinals won 9-6, after leading 6-0 and tied 6-6. Three unearned runs came due to a fielding error he made contributing to three unearned runs.
- Of his six home runs surrendered to the Diamondbacks in his career, two were to current teammate Paul Goldschmidt. One in each of his first two career starts in 2016.

CAREER

- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations.
- Missed 102 games on the Injured List in 2022 with a left shoulder impingement (5/23-7/16) and strained left knee (7/24-9/16). Was activated from his second stint in mid-September and was added to the bullpen where he made five appearances.
- Prior to the 7/23/22 start at Cincinnati, Matz had missed approx. two months with a left shoulder impingement.
- Has landed on the Injured List 11 times over his Major League career, missing time in every season except for 2021 in which he missed time for a positive COVID-19 test.
- In 2021, tied for the American League lead with 14 wins among left-handed pitchers.
